Lilly brings the first insulin products to market

Lilly and Genentech sign deal to commercialize rDNA human insulin

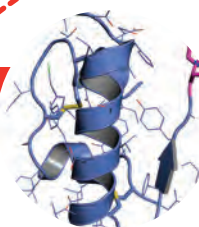


1982

Humalog® mealtime insulin is approved by regulators



1999

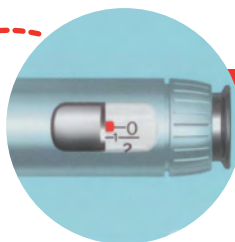
Lilly launches its first insulin pen

2000

Humalog® is indicated for use in children as young as 3 and for use in pumps

2007

Lilly launches the HumaPen®, which allows half-unit dosing



2008

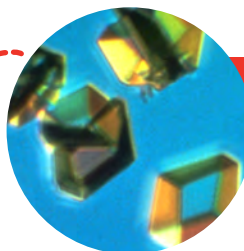
Lilly launches the lightweight and portable Humalog® Kwikpen®

2015

Basaglar®, part of the Lilly and Boehringer Ingelheim alliance, is the first follow-on insulin glargine treatment approved by the FDA

2016

Lilly introduces the Humulin® U-500 Kwikpen®, a highly concentrated insulin used to control high blood sugar in adults and children with diabetes
