# RANDOLPH H. DEER SPECIAL EVENTS PAVILION

This stunning ballroom boasts walls of two-story windows, providing dramatic views of the renowned Newfields garden. Decorated in rich, natural colors, this large space features a striking oval skylight, has direct parking access, the charming Bluestone patio around The Garden Entrance and Sutphin Fountain, a private coat room, and separate foyer which makes it perfect for large receptions.

# PULLIAM FAMILY GREAT HALL

The Pulliam Family Great Hall is located in the heart of the Indianapolis Museum of Art at Newfields. It is surrounded by permanent gallery spaces, special exhibition space, and offers a clear view of some of the most notable contemporary art in the IMA Collection, including Sol Lewitt's *Wall Drawing No. 652*, Robert Indiana's iconic *LOVE* sculpture, and Fletcher Benton's monumental contemporary sculpture. This beautifully lit hall provides an intimate experience with art in a grand and flexible setting.

# RICHARD D. WOOD FORMAL GARDEN

The magnificent and historic Oldfields estate was designed in the 1920s by the famous landscape architecture firm, Olmsted Brothers. This stunning outdoor venue is adjacent to Lilly House and features a fountain, arbors, and lush plantings which offers the perfect romantic backdrop. Ceremonies in this space are limited to 1.5 hours.

# THE TOBIAS THEATER

The Tobias T features 530-tiered theater seats, including a balcony. Digital and 35mm projection with Dolby surround sound are available for use. Before or after your event, linger in the lobby decorated with high-style furniture and outfitted with a festive bar. This space is ideal for live performances, concerts, film screenings, annual meetings, and formal presentations. Light thematic concessions are available for purchase through the Culinary Arts Department at Newfields.
