LETTER FROM THE CHAIRMAN

I believe that this bringing together of cultures is what sets us apart, both in terms of the character of our creative output and the strength of our business today. From the beginning, Stellar Works has benefited from the strategy and dynamism of Japanese operations management, the high-end craftsmanship of French furniture making and the technical proficiency of our Shanghai production team.

Our role as a preserver of the past extends beyond our production methods. The most obvious example would be our vintage lines, which keep the iconic designs of 20th -century greats, such as Vilhelm Wolhert and Carlo Forcolini, in production, with a few material updates appropriate to the modern day. But Stellar Works' signature collections, too, could not exist without the aesthetic histories they pay tribute to. Look over our contemporary furniture ranges and you see glimpses of design movements from across the 20th century – a touch of Bauhaus crafted functionality or the refined simplicity of mid-century Scandinavian – often seamlessly fused into the classic forms and patterns of the Asian creative tradition.

Designs and designers like these are the creative heart of our company. Without exception, they have an instinctive understanding of the Stellar Works mission and a talent for drawing and combining creative inspiration and craft technique from multiple places and periods. It would be only too easy to end up with a product that didn't work – a clash of cultures or a conceptual mismatch – but Stellar Works' designers have a gift for harmony: they create furniture that is both an extension of an existing tradition and the expression of a new one. We have chosen this path between the old and the new because I believe good design is timeless design. A particular style of furniture may be all the rage for a while, but if it looks tired after a decade, it's not good design – it's a passing trend. Stellar Works aims to be timeless. I would like to think that 100 years from now, our pieces will still be as contemporary and resonant as they are today and, moreover, that Stellar Works will still be crafting quality furniture that is Asian in inspiration, cross-cultural in design and international in its scope.

Founded in 2003 by Australian architect Craig Bassam and American creative director Scott Fellows, the studio practices a philosophy of "total design", a multidisciplinary approach to design and architecture that considers form and the whole environment at

In addition to numerous designs under their namesake label, BassamFellows has created furniture pieces for some of the world's most recognizable brands such as Herman Miller, Geiger, Starbucks Reserve Roastery, Bally and McGuire.



Jens Risom

Jens Risom (1916–2016) was an iconic Danish-American furniture designer who pioneered the widespread popularity of contemporary American design in the mid-century period.

As part of a celebrated Danish trio with Hans J. Wegner and Børge Mogensen, Jens Risom graduated from The School of Arts and Crafts in Copenhagen in 1937. He emigrated to New York In 1939, and after success designing the majority of Hans Knoll's first furniture collection, he established his own design company. Jens Risom Design Inc. grew to be one of the three largest furniture companies in America, with offices spanning to Argentina, England and Australia. His designs continue to inspire many today and his legacy remains strongly present in the design world.



Michele De Lucchi

'Architect. Michele De Lucchi was a prominent figure in movements like Alchimia and Memphis.

He has designed furniture for the most known Italian and European companies. For Olivetti he has been Director of Design from 1988 to 2002. He realized architectural projects in Italy and abroad, including cultural, corporate, industrial and residential buildings. For Deutsche Bank, Deutsche Bundesbahn, Enel, Poste Italiane, Hera, Intesa Sanpaolo, UniCredit and at other Italian and foreign banks he has designed working environments and corporate image. He developed important hospitality projects in Tbilisi (Georgia), Beijing (China), Rokko-san (Japan) and various part of Italy. He has planned buildings for museums as the Triennale di Milano, the Palazzo delle Esposizioni in Rome, the Neues Museum in Berlin and the Gallerie d'Italia in Milan.

In 2000 he was appointed Officer of Italian Republic by President Ciampi. In 2001 he has been nominated Professor at the IUAV in Venice. In 2006 he received the Honorary Doctorate from Kingston University. In 2008 he has been nominated Professor at the Design Faculty of the Politecnico of Milan and Member of the Accademia Nazionale di San Luca in Rome. During 2018 Michele De Lucchi was editor in chief of the new "Domus" magazine.

Michele De Lucchi is founder and member of AMDL CIRCLE, a multidisciplinary group of thinkers and innovators. Since 2018, AMDL CIRCLE focuses on Earth Stations, future sharing architectures that combine technological development with humanist principles.

OEO Studio was founded in 2003 and is based in Copenhagen, Denmark, with a project office in Tokyo. OEO Studio has created award-winning designs for a broad spectre of discerning clients, from furniture and interiors for Michelin-starred restaurants to aspirational objects that have earned their place in the permanent collections of the Victoria and Albert Museum in London, at the Cooper Hewitt Smithsonian Design Museum in New York and at the Musée des Arts Décoratifs in Paris.

The deep armrest acts as a soft side table for a book, a pair of glasses or a telephone.

Even though The Atelier Sofa has a clean and sophisticated look, - it is meant to be very functional and easy to maintain, - it has removable covers, which can be dry cleaned if needed. The soft and plump cushions can be moved around to enhance malleable comfort sitting or lounging.

Aya is an onomatopoeia – a word that mimics a phonetical sound. A poetic name as soft and sophisticated as the design itself. The collection design language is an elaboration of the encounter between Asian and Scandinavian design.

Aya is minimal yet highly complex and every detail has been careful orchestrated, from the small wooden joints and angles to the stitching and seating comfort.

The elegant light wooden frame is deeply inspired by Asian culture and design, and effortlessly carries the soft and embracing shell and seat.

The result is a full range of Aya furniture for the perfect dining and socialising setting. Comfort and sturdy durability lie at its core, which is complimented by the elegant appearance. The first Aya collection drop comprises a fully upholstered dining chair with armrest, a dining chair without armrests, and two dimensions of dining tables: 1,800 cm and 2,400 cm in length. The design of the tables mirrors the structure and details of the chair frame.

The Historic Safari Chair is an almost naïve, sturdy, simple geometric structure - with added hard and soft components to secure softness and flexibility. With attention to this vocabulary, The Journey Chair is our modern interpretation - letting comfort, modern lifestyle and behavior be the center of attention. We wanted the chair to be versatile in use and look, embedding a balance between the rustic and a more refined, modern approach into the design.The soft arch under the seat cushion compliments the strong, masculine silhouette of the chair - and enhances a lighter, sophisticated look. The thicker seat cushion and the soft back, secures a great and comfortable experience while seated. Exposed details of darkened brass reveal and celebrate the simplicity of how the chair is assembled.

The Journey chair is obvious to use for all kinds of Dining, but can also be used as a residential office chair, as well as for meetings and conference.

Pagoda is a collection of chairs inspired by the classic café chairs of 19th century Vienna. The chair is supremely light and compact with a structure that has been reduced to its very essence. The chair consists of only six pieces – delivering good craftsmanship and efficiency while allowing multiple material configurations. The chair's circular seat stems from rationalization while symbolizing the "Way of Nature" or "oneness" in Chinese culture. Cantilevered arms and back subtly reference Pagoda gates, giving the chair its personality while also eliminating the need for an arm and armless version.

Stellar Works reissued the C140 in its original caned back version as well the upholstered C142, which has an upholstered back. The chairs come in a choice Walnut. For the upholstery, Stellar works have selected Hallingdal 65 from Kvadrat, designed by mid-century Danish designer iconic Nanna Ditzel, in a choice of 457 (yellow), 547 (orange) 850 (blue).

The Iconic C140 chair was used in the White House under President Lyndon B. Johnson's administration and Johnson was photographed sitting in it signing the Civil Rights Act in 1964 and the Highway Beautification Act in 1965.

This year, Stellar Works is adding new important pieces to its existing collection of Jens Risom designs. Originating from his mid-century heydays, the six new models are prime examples of Risom's aesthetics and proof of the enduring quality of his timeless work.

The design of the $M\bar{u}n$ light series marries Asian design sensibilities with a timeless aesthetic, and targets both consumer and contract markets. The design ethos behind $M\bar{u}n$ is playful, analogue and sculptural. A distillation of the essential elements of form and function. $M\bar{u}n$, the Japanese word for moon, takes shape in the form of a desk lamp, two types of floor lamps, pendants in s, m and large and a rechargeable lantern that can be used both indoor and outdoor.

For the design of $M\bar{u}n$, OEO Studio drew inspiration from analogue experiences and the poetry of rituals. The design of $M\bar{u}n$ is compelling and minimalitic, with a subtle sophisticated appearance - almost mystical as the movement of the tide as the Moon orbits earth.
