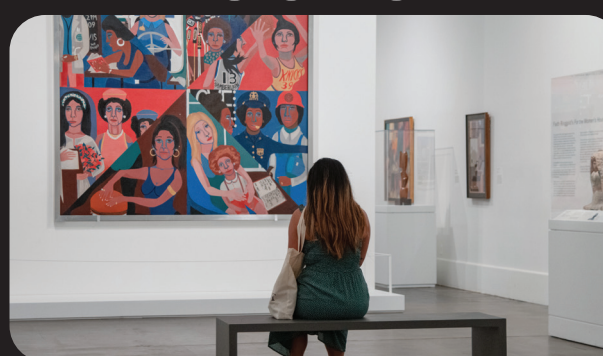

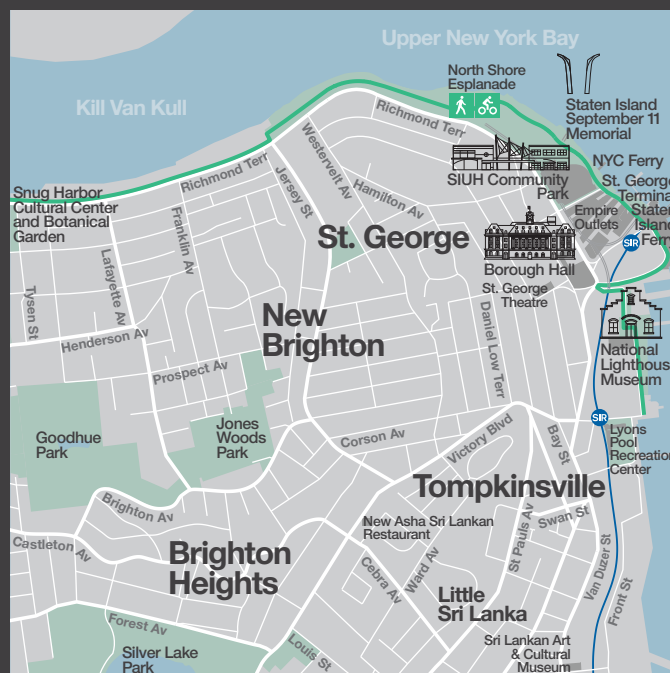

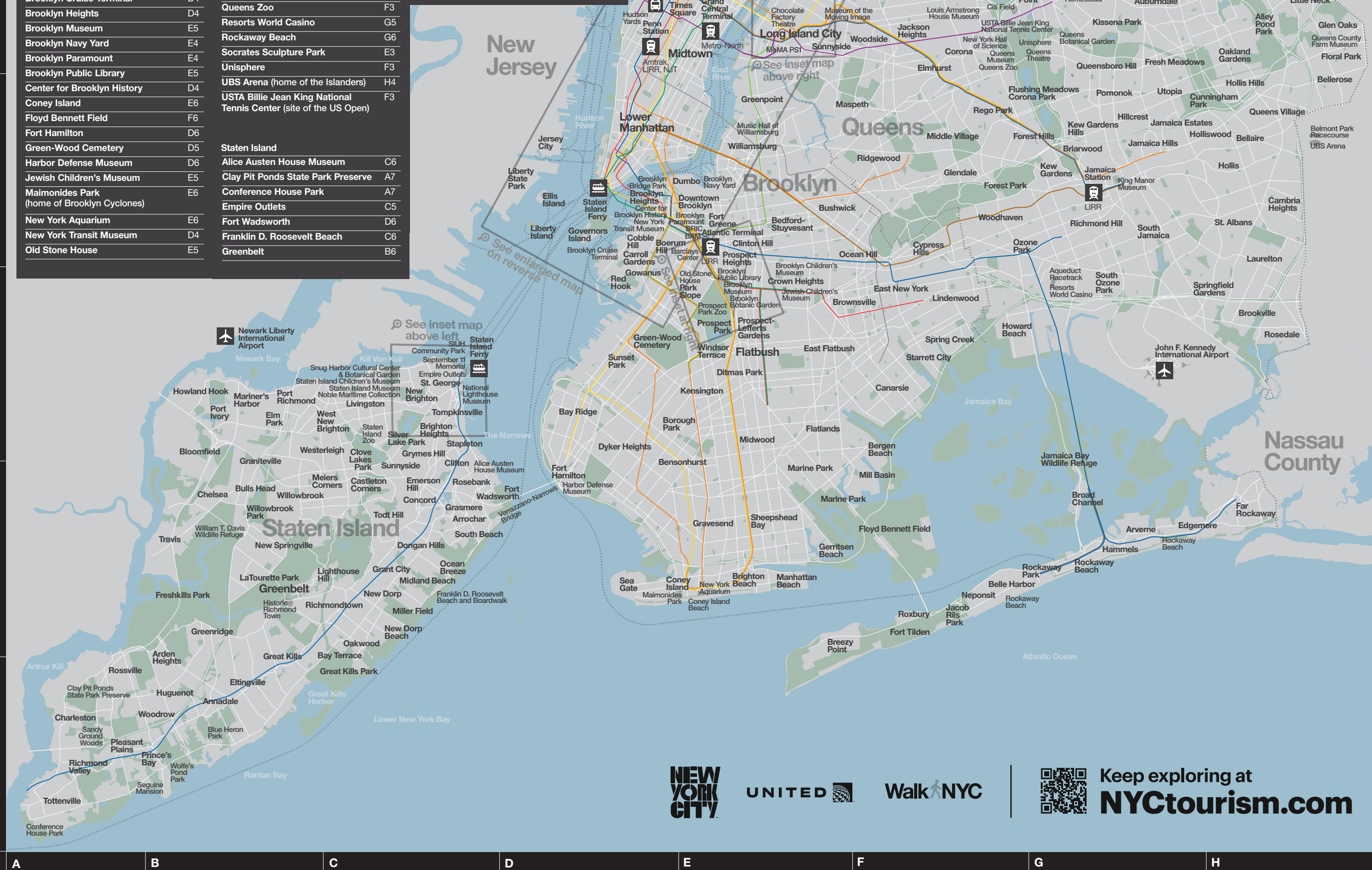

Getting around

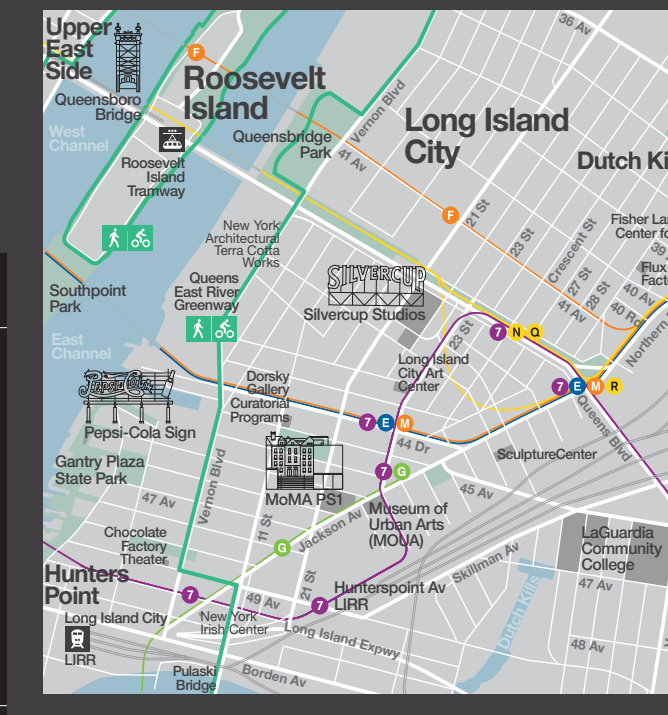
See the City from NYC Ferry—a fun waterway transit network that costs \$4 for a single ride. The Staten Island Ferry is free and operates 24/7.
