
















White Valley Ski Area

Okutone Snow Park








Oze-Iwakura Ski Resort


Snow Park Oze Tokura







Karuizawa Snow Park




Kusatsu Onsen Ski Resort

Yakimanju


Yakimanju is a hearty, traditional snack. The manju (soft wheat buns) are coated in a sweet and salty miso sauce and grilled over an open flame. It's the soul food of Gunma.



Mizusawa Udon

A local specialty of Ikaho Onsen, Mizusawa Udon is one of Japan's three famous types of udon noodles, characterized by a firm texture and glossy appearance.




