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Features of your Hyundai



1.0 Arms (x2)

The arms are one of the 4 main limbs of your Hyundai, they have muscles which help lift, pull and push.

1.1 Hands (x2)

Fingers are part of your Hyundai's hands, they are the source of dexterity and are pivotal in grip and communication in some cases.

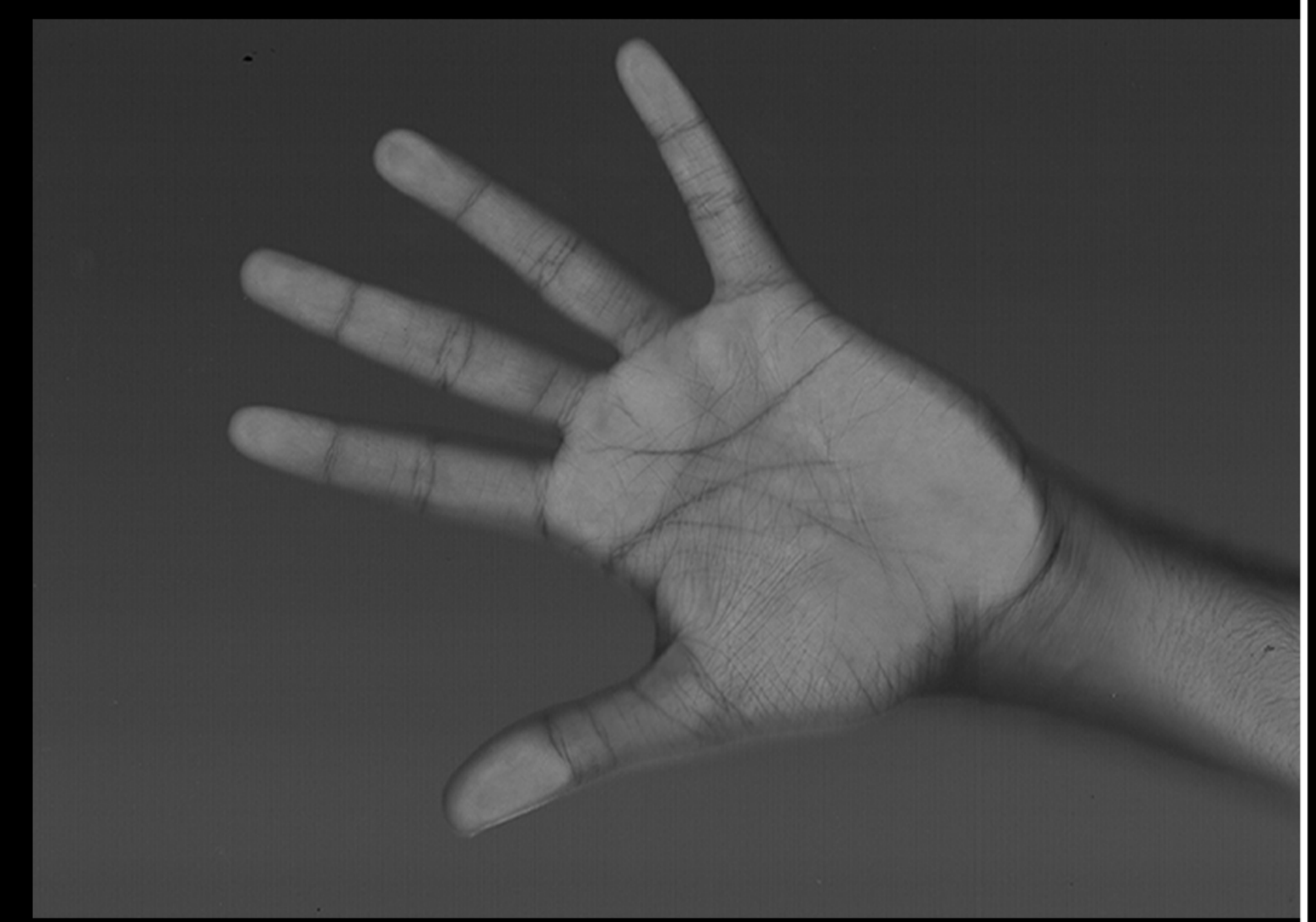

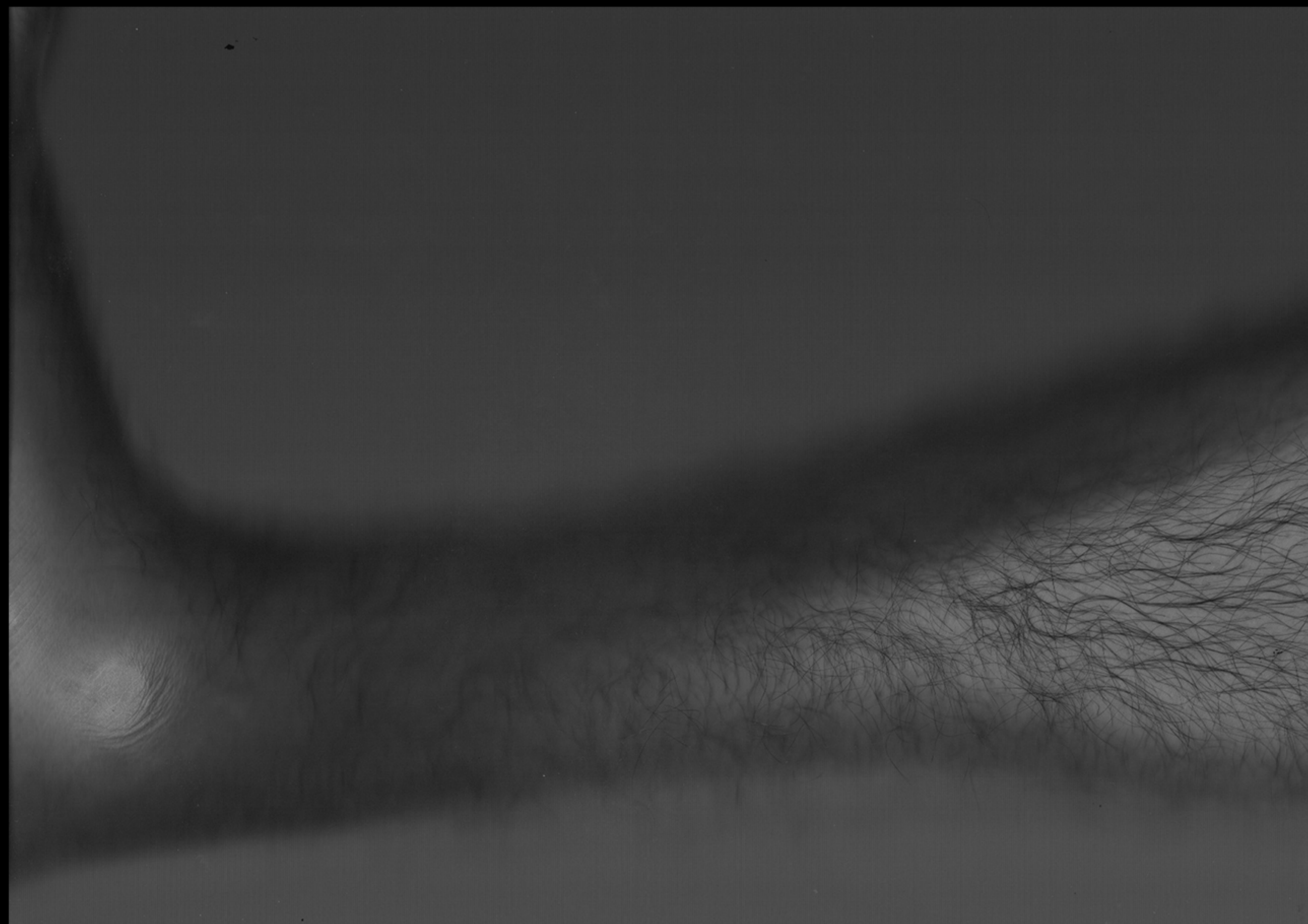


2.0 Legs (x2)

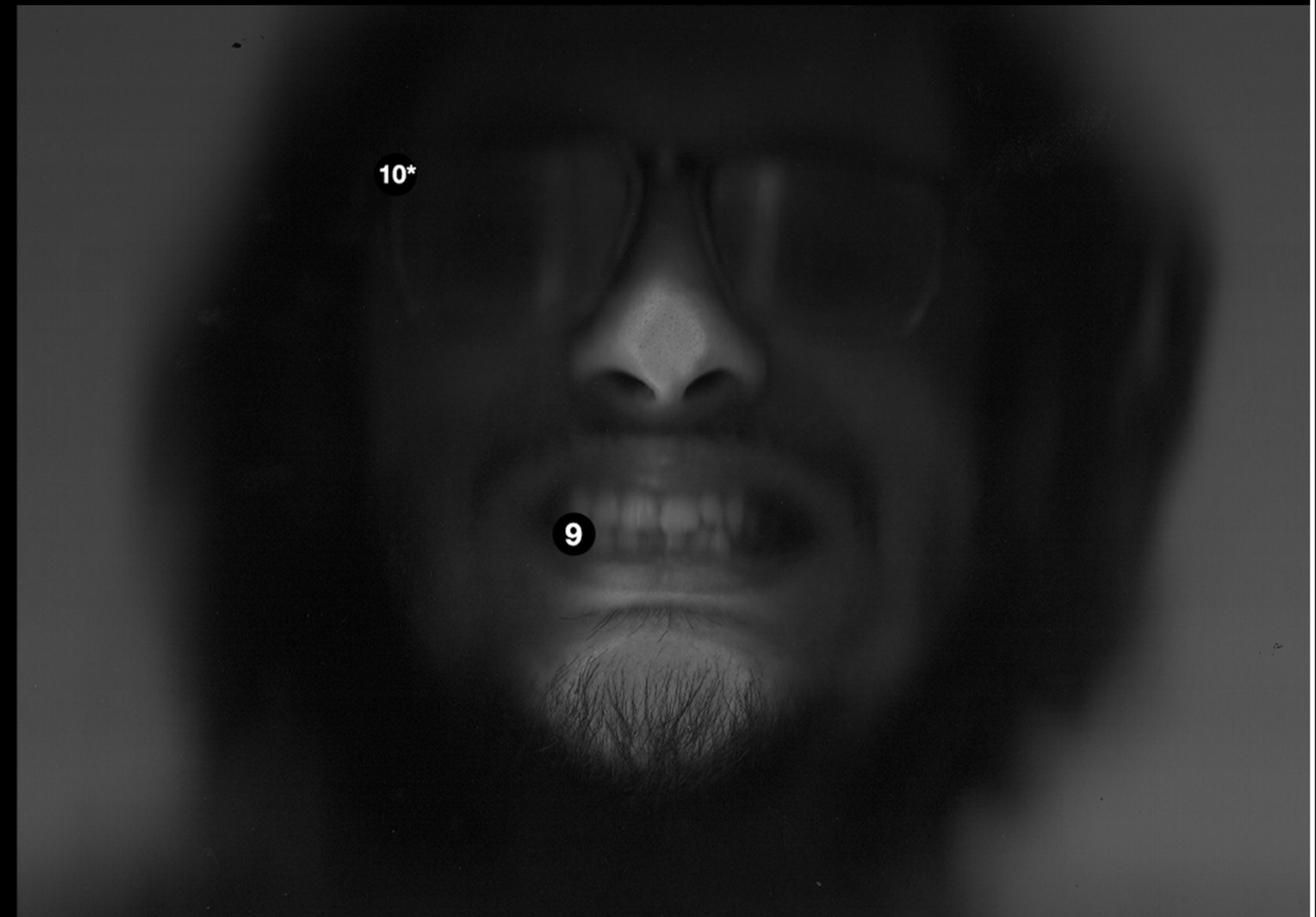
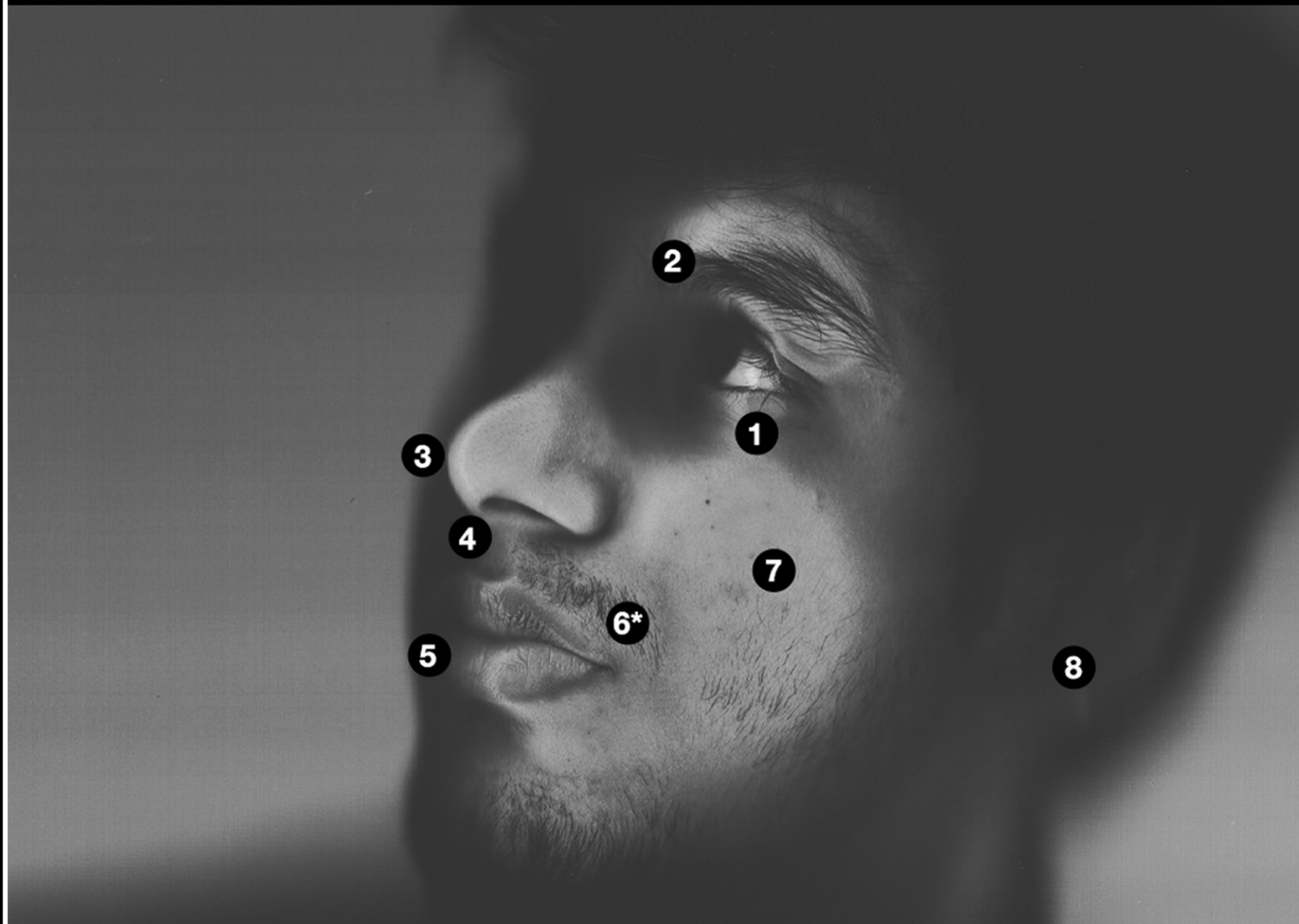

3.0 Facial Features

3.1 Eyes (x2)

The eyes are one of the 5 main senses, they help your Hyundai see the world and make sense of it. A very sensitive organ.

3.2 Eyebrows (x2)

The eyebrows help divert sweat and water away from the eyes, they also play a key role in facial expressions.

3.3 Nose

The nose helps your Hyundai breathe and smell distinct smells.

3.4 Nostrils (x2)

The nostrils are openings in the nose which help suck in air and smells.

Should be cleaned regularly.

3.5 Lips (x2)

The lips help close the front opening of your Hyundai and keep its contents air tight and spill proof.

3.6. Facial hair (If Installed)

This is one of the aesthetic options you can choose while configuring your Hyundai, it gives a matured and older look to the product.

3.7 Cheek (x2)

The cheeks of your Hyundai helps in chewing and in facial expressions.

3.8 Ear (x2)

The ears help you Hyundai hear and sense auditory stimuli.
Should be cleaned regularly

3.9 Teeth (x32)

The teeth help you Hyundai chew its food and break it into smaller parts, helping in digestion.

3.10 Visual Aid (If Installed)

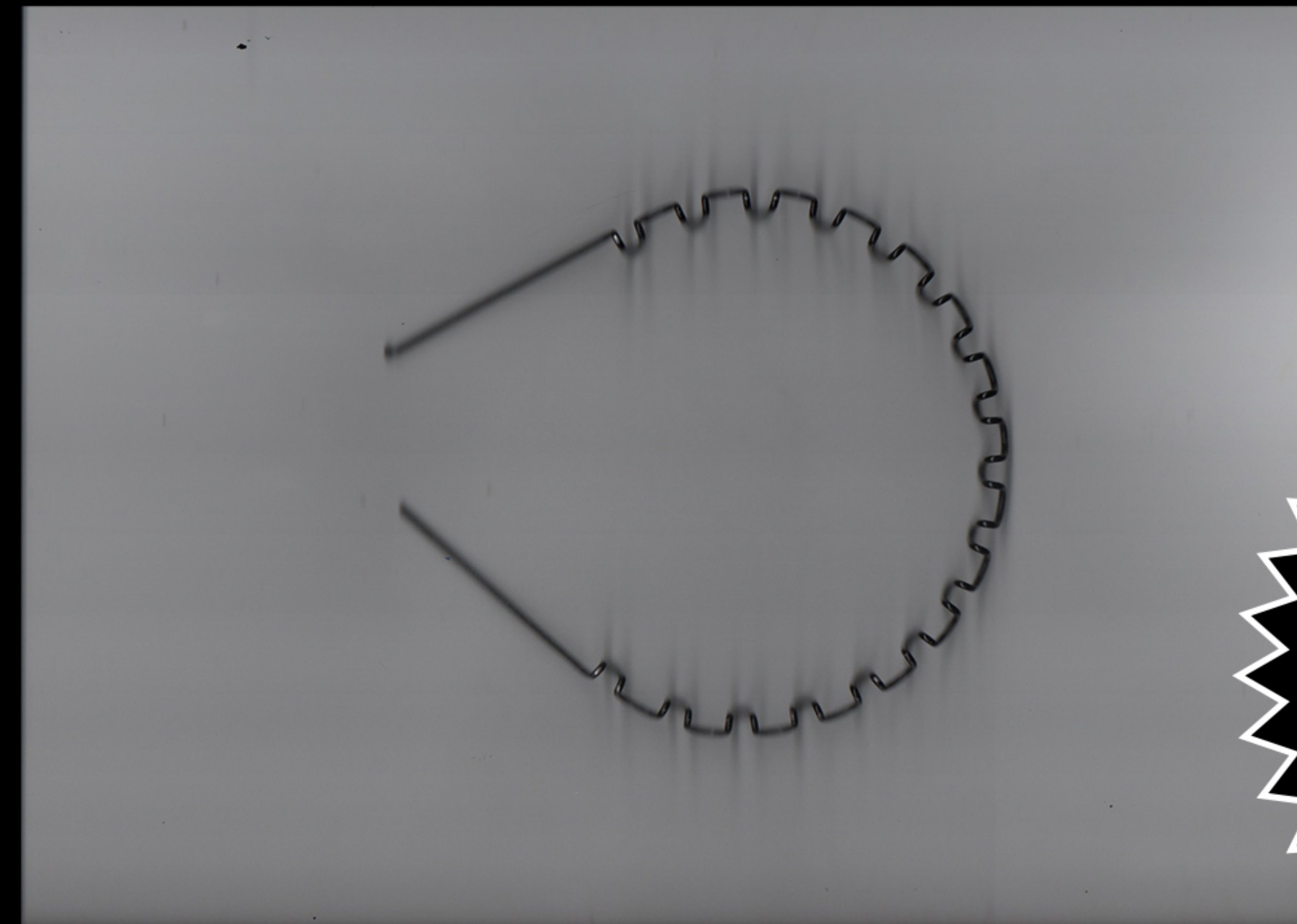

Brushing your Hyundai's Teeth

By using a toothbrush and toothpaste you can clean your Hyundai's teeth to a great extent, make sure to get all the corners and ensure a round motion throughout. Ensure an adequate amount of toothpaste and don't forget to rinse the teeth before embarking on this procedure.

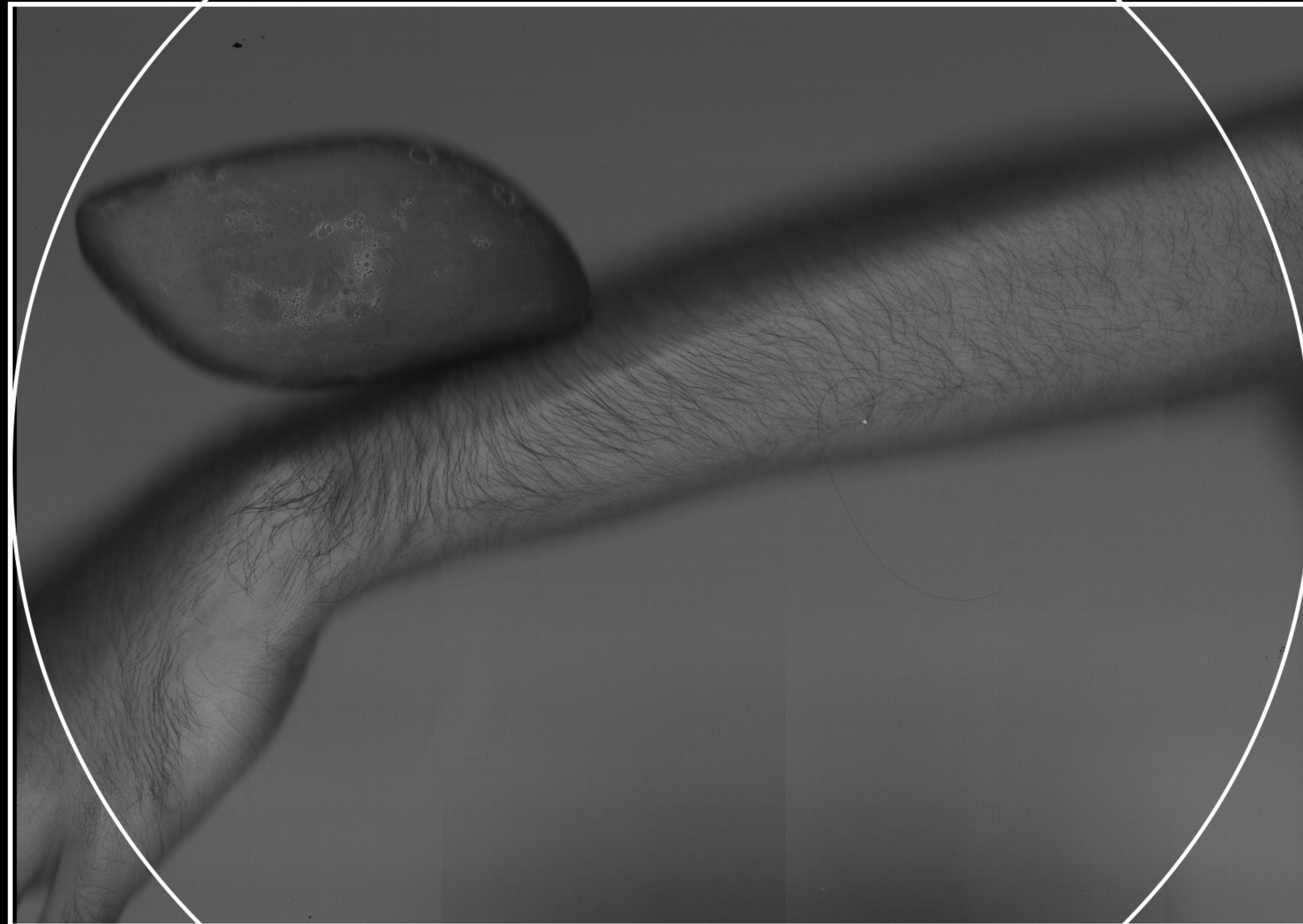

Hydrating you Hyundai

Dehydration is a severe problem that affects the functioning of your Hyundai. Ensure regular topups of water. It is recommender to fill 3L of fresh water per day.

Signs of Dehydration: Lightheadedness, Dry mouth, fatigue

Hyundai recommends fresh and clean water which is purified through an RO Filter.

WARNING : Ingestion of contaminated water may lead to occurence of water-borne diseases like Cholera.

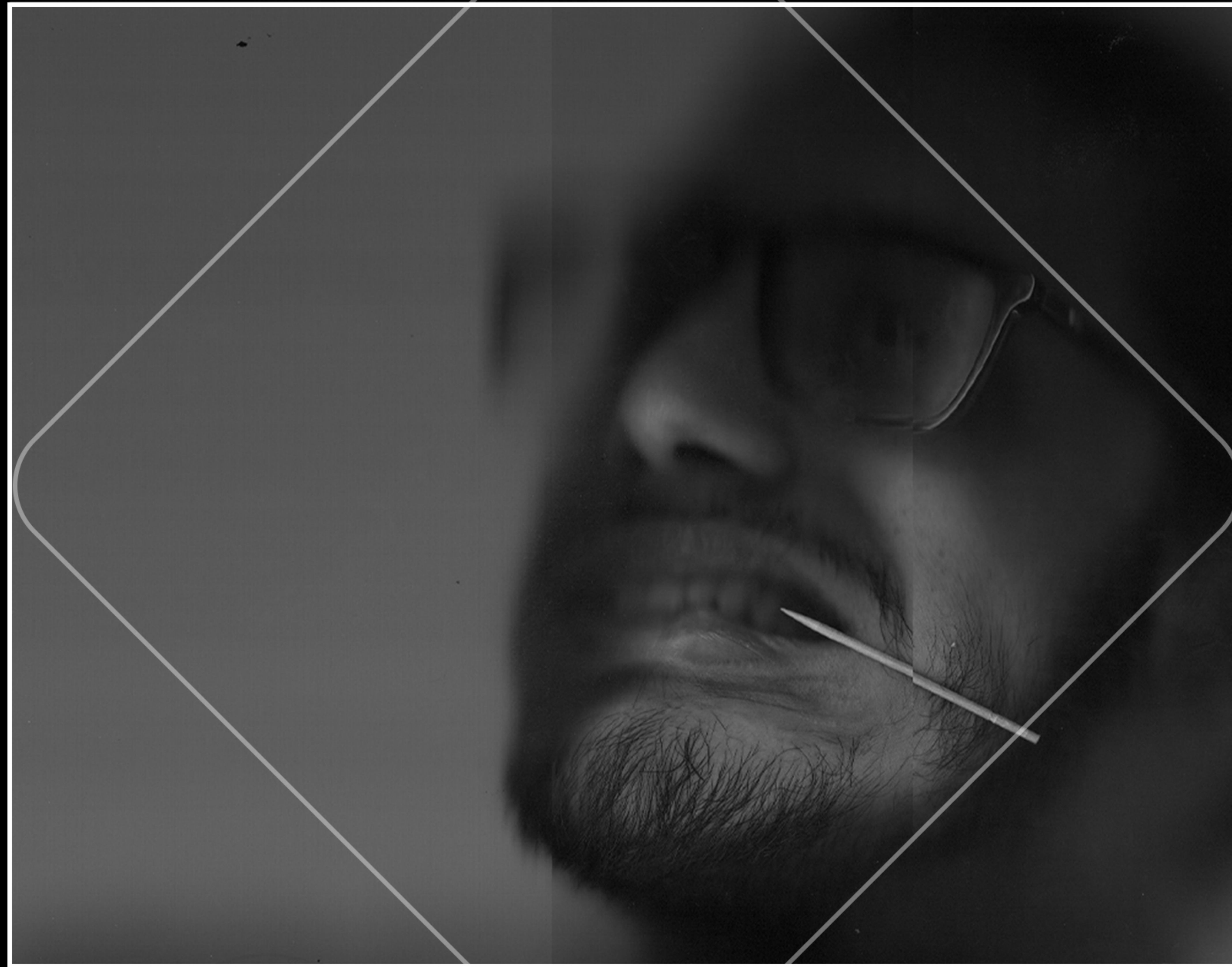

There might be morsels on your Hyundai's teeth after food ingestion. To avoid social embarrassment, it is recommended to remove these morsels with the help of a tooth pick.

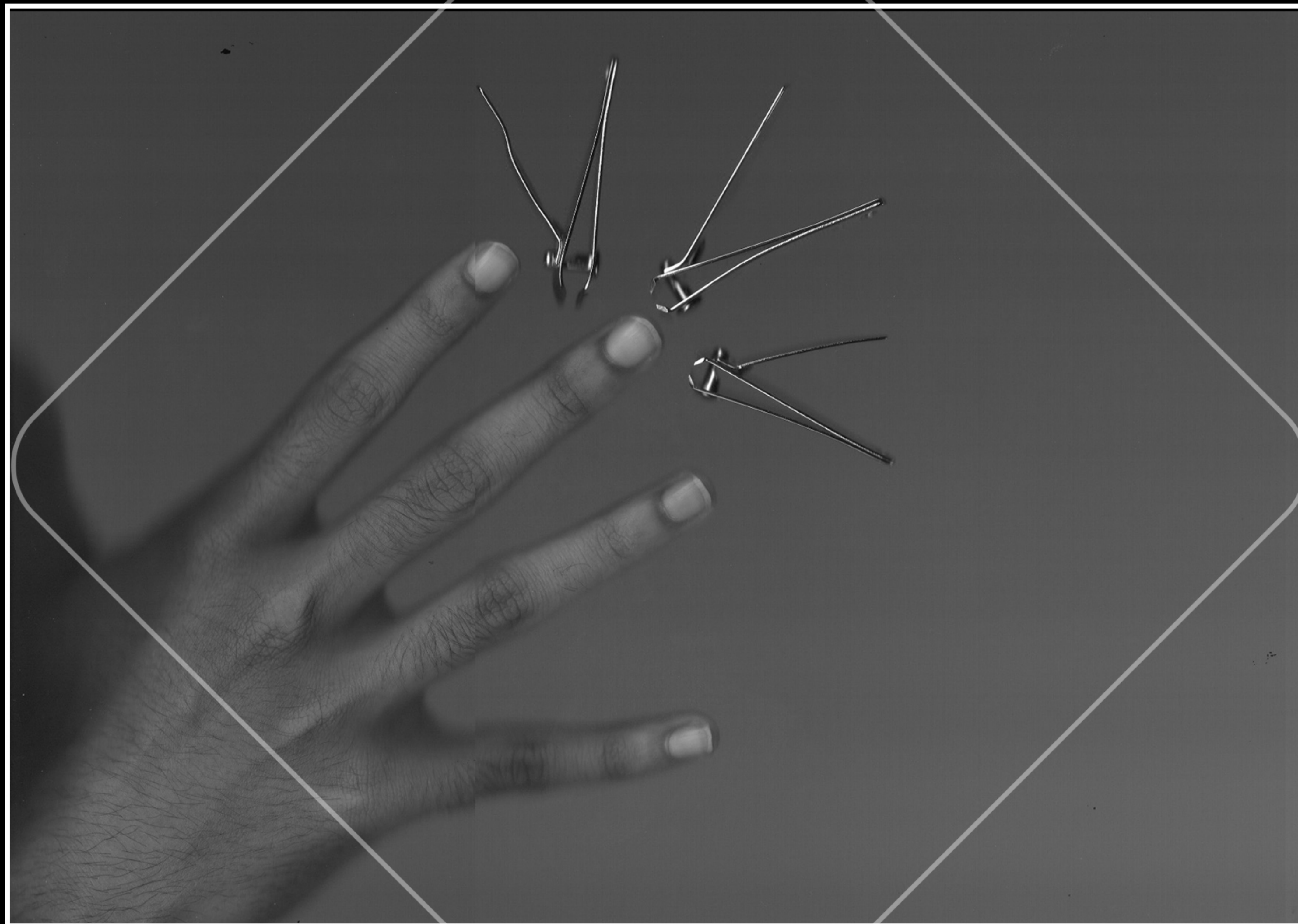
Hyundai recommends a wooden toothpick available in general stores.

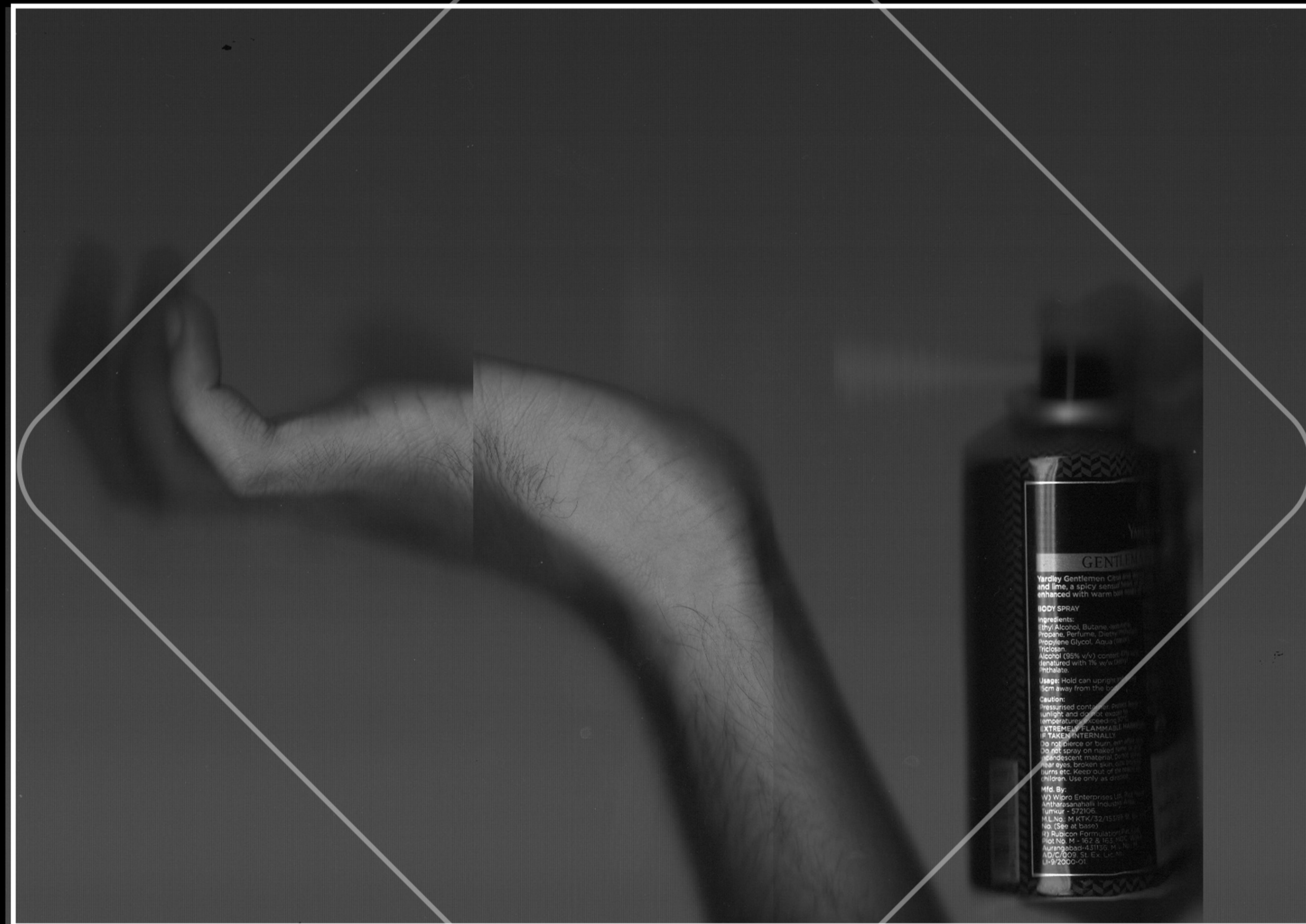

If Your Hyundai Overheats

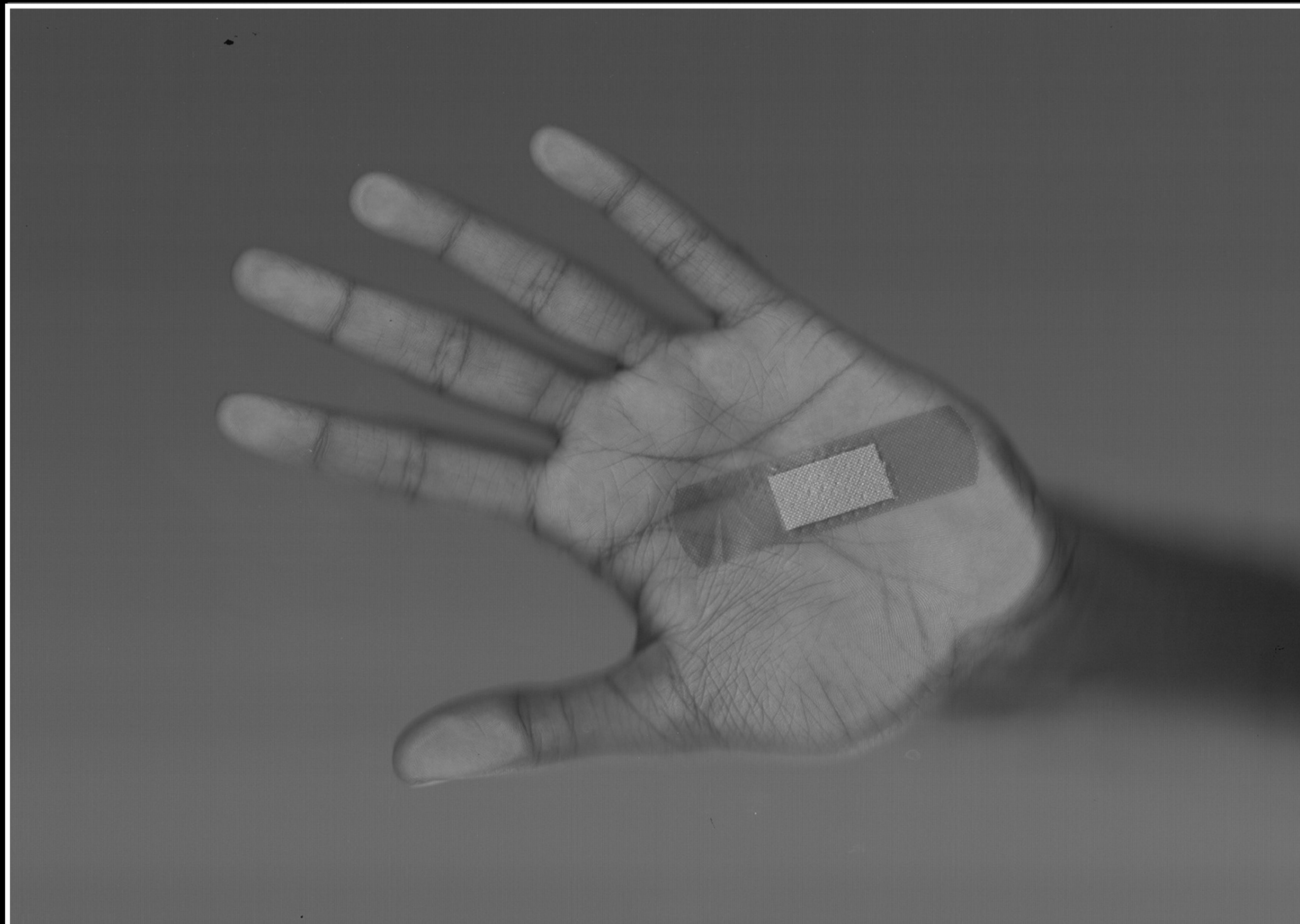

In the unfortunate event that your Hyundai is abducted, please inform the nearest police station. Kindly keep the insurance papers handy and please try to stay calm.

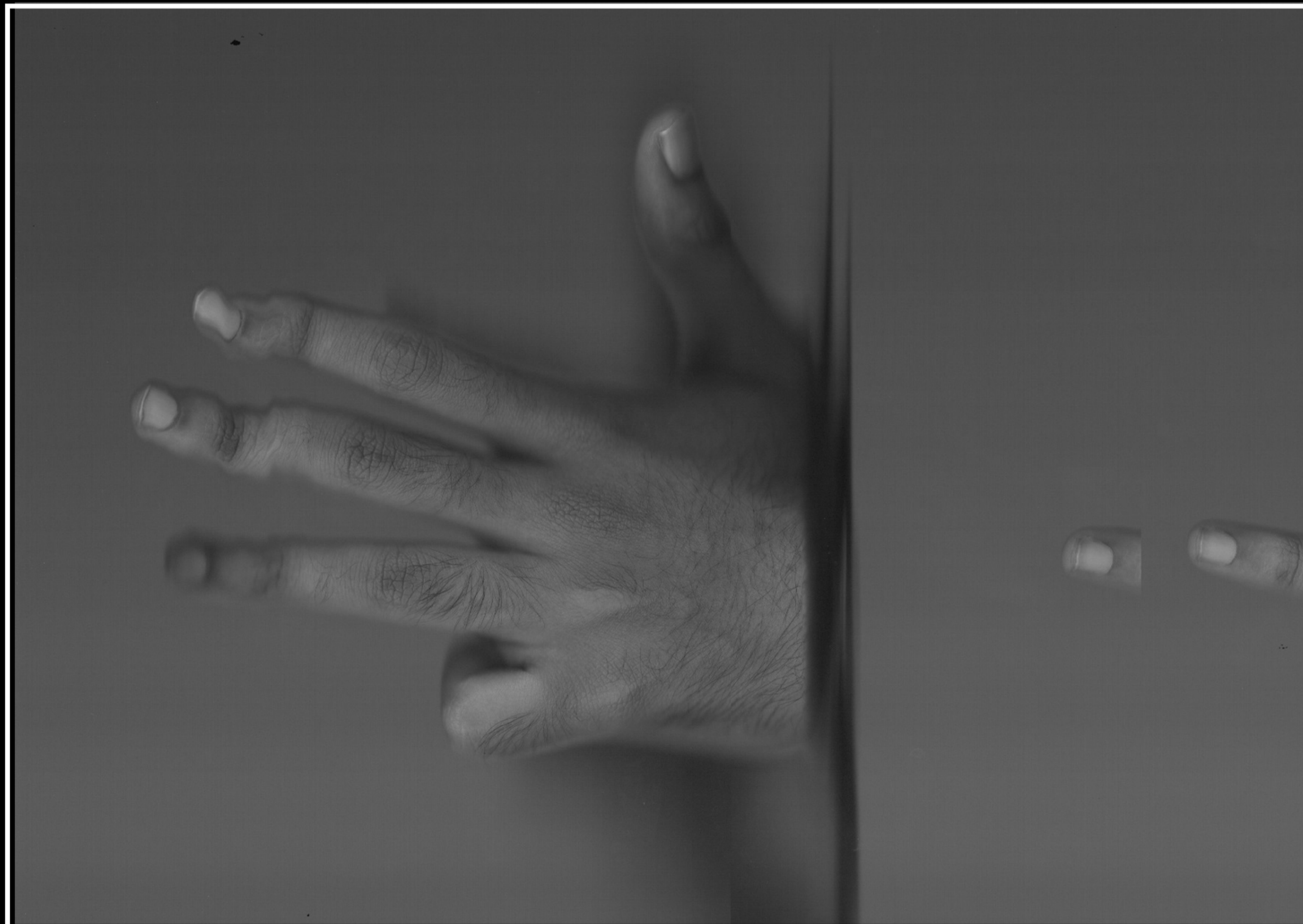
Hyundai provides Abduction and Kidnapping insurance for a monthly premium. Visit your nearest dealer for more details.

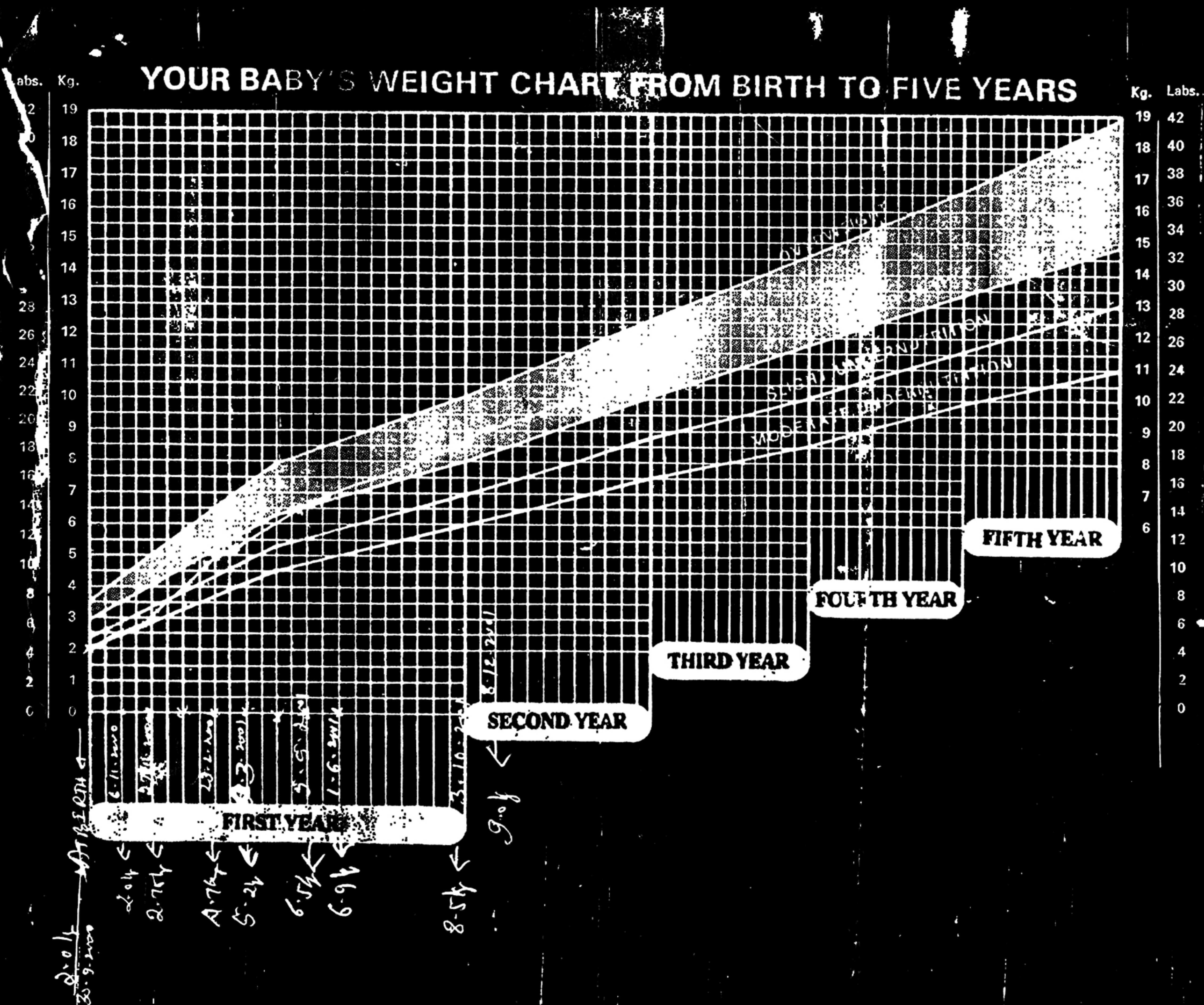
