Set in the late 19th century during the Meiji period, as the age of the samurai approached its end, *Last Samurai Standing* takes place at the Tenryuji Temple in Kyoto. The film is directed by Keishi Otomo, who is known for his work on the live-action *Rurouni Kenshin* movies. Otomo skillfully brings to life the gorgeous world of this comic while capturing its dynamism and subtleties. Starring Ryoma Takeuchi and Keita Machida, the film follows the story of two dancers named Shinya. Takeuchi plays Shinya Suzuki, Japan's Latin dance champion, who is skilled enough to compete globally but remains fixated on domestic competitions. Machida plays Shinya Sugiki, the Japanese champion and second-ranked dancer in the world in the Standard Ballroom category, who invites Suzuki into the world of the 10Dance Competition.

As these two Shinyas — hailing from entirely different worlds with clashing personalities — form an unlikely duo, aiming to win the 10Dance Competition, they develop feelings for each other along the way.




BULLET TRAIN EXPLOSION
