Choi Woo-shik (*Our Beloved Summer*, *A Killer Paradox*) plays Ko Gyeom, a movie-lover who starts out as an extra actor and becomes a film critic. In true melodramatic fashion, the name “Kim Mubee” — a name that sounds like the movies he loves so much — catches his attention. Park Bo-young (*A Daily Dose of Sunshine*, *Concrete Utopia*) takes on the role of Kim Mubee, who begins working in the industry with mixed feelings that stem from her father’s immense love for movies. When Life Gives You Tangerines follows the adventures of Ae-sun, “the remarkable rebel,” and Gwan-sik, nicknamed “unyielding iron,” through four vibrant seasons on Jeju Island. The series’ Korean title pays homage to the Jeju dialect, translating to “thank you for your hard work,” and reflects both the Jeju island setting and the unforgettable, heartfelt life stories of Ae-sun and Gwan-sik. Many are anticipating the coming together of actors IU and Park Bo-gum, screenwriter Lim Sang-choon (*When the Camellia Blooms*), and director Kim Won-suk (*Misaeng: Incomplete Life*, *Signal*). IU (*My Mister*, *Hotel del Luna*, *Broker*, *Dream*) takes on the lead role of Ae-sun, a determined rebel born and raised in Jeju who continuously defies her fate. Park Bo-gum (*Record of Youth*, *Wonderland*, *Seobok*, *Let Me Fly*) plays Gwan-sik, a steadfast man who expresses himself through actions rather than words, facing life with unwavering diligence. The older versions of these characters are played by Moon So-ri (*Queenmaker*, *RACE*) and Park Hae-joon (*The 8 Show*, *The World of the Married*).

Revelations

On Netflix Q1 2025 | Film

A pastor is convinced that a divine revelation has called him to punish the person guilty of a missing persons case, while a police detective assigned to the case is haunted by her dead sister's shadow. Director Yeon Sang-ho, known for posing sharp questions about human nature through his work, explores the fine lines between religion and humanity, faith and beliefs, and good and evil in *Revelations*. Ryu Jun-yeol (*The 8 Show*, *The Night Owl*) plays the divinely guided pastor Min-chan. When Yang-rae visits his church, Min-chan receives a divine message that Yang-rae is the one who kidnapped his son, prompting Min-chan to seek retribution. Ryu delivers an intense portrayal of a man of devout faith caught in a harsh reality. Yeon-hui, the police detective who investigates Yang-rae and follows the suspicious pastor, is played by Shin Hyun-been (*Reborn Rich*, *Hospital Playlist*). Tormented by the shadow of her dead sister who was a victim of a heinous crime, Yeon-hui pursues the case despite her personal struggles. Director Yeon Sang-ho's *Revelations* is another collaboration with writer Choi Gyu-seok after *Hellbound*, with Alfonso Cuarón, the acclaimed director of *Roma* and *Gravity*, serving as executive producer.

In this noir action drama, Gi-jun, who severed his own Achilles tendon to leave the world of organized crime, returns 11 years later to investigate and avenge his brother Gi-seok's death. So Ji-sub stars as Gi-jun, marking his return to the noir actioner genre 11 years after *A Company Man*. Lee Jun-hyuk (*Love Scout*, *Dongjae*, *the Good or the Bastard*) makes a special appearance as Gi-jun's younger brother, Gi-seok. After his older brother's departure, Gi-seok helped the organization Juun grow into a successful business and became its executive director. His mysterious death sets off the chain of events that follow. Huh Joon-ho (*Bloodhounds*, *Kingdom*) and An Kil-kang (*Watcher*, *Tale of the Nine Tailed 1938*) portray Lee Ju-un, the leader of Juun, and Gu Bong-san, the leader of the rival organization Bongsan respectively. Gong Myoung (*Killing Romance*, *Extreme Job*) plays Jun-mo, Bongsan's heir, while Choo Young-woo (*The Trauma Code: Heroes on Call*, *The Tale of Lady Ok*) steps into the role of Geum-son, the son of Juun's leader and a prosecutor with unknown ambitions. Tiger Lee (*The Roundup: No Way Out*) plays Sim Seong-won, the head of N-Clean, an entity that tidies up loose ends after the crime organizations. Cho Han-cheul (*Gyeongseong Creature*) plays Seong-cheol, the right-hand man to boss Lee Ju-un. Cha Seung-won (*Uprising*) makes a special appearance as Mr. Kim, a mysterious figure behind the coexistence of the two organizations.

In Netflix Korea's first original animated film, astronaut Nan-young and musician Je-i embark on the longest-ever long-distance relationship — one that bridges Earth and Mars. Kim Tae-ri (*Twenty-Five Twenty-One*, *Space Sweepers*) takes on her first voice-acting role as scientist Nan-young. Determined to trace her mother's steps to Mars after her failed return to Earth, Nan-young is selected for the 4th Mars exploration project in 2050. Je-i, voiced by rising star Hong Kyung (*Hear Me: Our Summer*, *Weak Hero Class 1*), is a musician who also repairs retro audio equipment. After their first encounter, an old turntable that Nan-young inherited from her mother brings them together again by fate, sparking a wistful, sweet romance that transcends the distance between Earth and Mars. Beginning with the return of Hongrang as a grown man after his disappearance as a child, this period mystery romance depicts the unbreakable relationships between characters, each with their own secrets and desires. Lee Jae-wook (*Alchemy of Souls*, *Search WWW*) plays Hongrang, who comes back after 12 years with no childhood memory. Cho Bo-ah (*Destined with You*, *Tale of the Nine Tailed*) plays Cho Bo-ah, Hongrang's stepsister who relentlessly searches for him. Jung Ga-ram (*The Interest of Love*, *Love Alarm*) plays Mu-jin, the merchant family's adopted son who is threatened by Hongrang's return, especially as Hongrang stirs Jae-yi's feelings. Uhm Ji-won (*Little Women*) plays Min Yeon-ui, the lady of the house with a twisted motherly love who stops at nothing to get her lost son back. Park Byung-eun (*The Bequeathed*) plays Sim Yeol-guk, the head of the merchant business who makes difficult decisions to fulfill his ambitions.

Wall to Wall

On Netflix Q3 2025 | Film

A man who invested everything he has to secure his own place, an 84-square-meter apartment, is plagued by unidentified noises coming from the other units in this mystery thriller. 84 square meters, which is also the Korean title of the film, refers to the most common, average-sized apartment for Koreans, and symbolizes the harsh housing realities they face today. The lead character Woo-seong is played by Kang Ha-neul, who has portrayed relatable young men of diverse characters and temperament in *Squid Game* Season 2 and *When the Camellia Blooms*. Woo-seong, a thirty-something working professional, maxes out his savings, investments, loans and even the equity in his mother's garlic field to secure his lifetime dream of having his own place, but the reality he faces is harsh with high interest payment obligations. The noises from the other units and run-ins with the neighbors grate on his nerves even more, and Kang realistically portrays the precarious emotional landscape of this stressed-out young man. Eun-hwa, the president of the residents association who wants to keep peace in the building complex, is played by Yeom Hye-ran, who delivered compelling performances in *The Glory*, *Mask Girl*, and *When the Camellia Blooms*. Jin-ho, the man who lives above Woo-seong and sets out together to find the origins of the noise, is played by Seo Hyun-woo, who has portrayed genre-crossing, unique characters in works such as *Decision to Leave* and *My Name Is Loh Kiwan*. Anticipation is growing for *Wall to Wall*, director Kim Tae-joon's second project to once again create a thriller set in realistic, everyday situations, following his successful debut with *Unlocked*.
