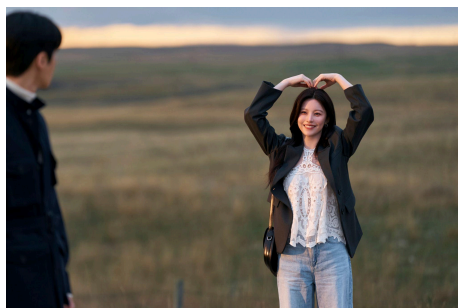

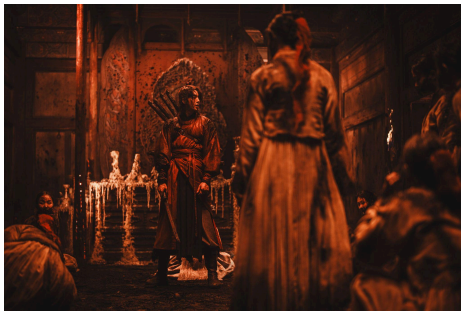


Take a Hike!

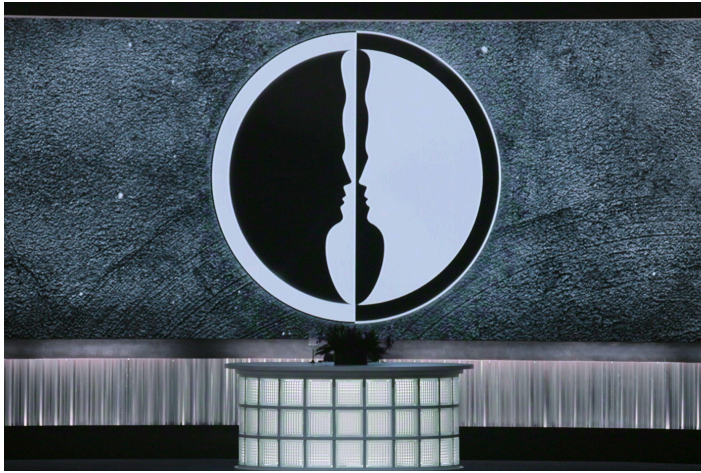


The Scandal
