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## Classic Cars & Classic Drives Self-guided Map of Mulholland Drive

In Los Angeles, cars are not just transportation, they're embedded in the city's DNA. The "car scene" in LA is legendary and it begs to be experienced! This brochure maps some thrilling drives designed to suit your mood; from carving the canyons along famous Mulholland Drive to basking in "all things car" at The Petersen Automotive Museum, a "must" destination for all car enthusiasts!

Need a turbo boost? Take a Porsche up to 100 mph (legally) on a 4-mile track at the Porsche Experience Center!

Mulholland's picture perfect drive was named after William Mulholland, a somewhat controversial engineer who designed the Los Angeles Aqueduct. Did you know LA had an Aqueduct? Yes, it brought water south to the city from the Owens Valley and turned what was once a desert into a garden. The drive splits into two routes: Old Town Hollywood and Calabasas to Malibu. Uber or rent a car and set off on your "LA Car Culture" adventure. Bragging rights acquired upon completion!



### Trip 1 Old Town Hollywood:

Take this gorgeous 25-mile canyon drive from Hollywood to Encino. Along the way, check out the Hollywood Gates, Hollywood Sign, Homes of the Rich and Famous and maybe take a hike at the end of your journey!

Begin your drive at the "101 Coffee Shop" (featured in the movie "Swingers"), fuel up for the drive and enjoy amazing views of the city, the valley and the beach...

Points of Interest: 101 Coffee Shop Hollywood Sign Gangster Bugsy's Tower Celebrity Homes Upper Canyonback Trailhead

### Trip 2 Snake Run to Malibu:

Take a plunge into the canyons; go a little past Hollywood and start your adventure at Cafe Olé and grab a cup of joe! On the stretch to Malibu, stop at The Rock Store, a classic biker's cafe and hangout. Then drive through the famous Snake Turn...Who knows, the paparazzi may snap your pic as you come around the bend... Continue onwards to Malibu and take in spectacular views of the ocean.


Before heading home, be sure to stop for a bite at Neptune's Net, a famous restaurant where local classic car and motorcycle aficionados meet.

## The Petersen Automotive Museum



Angelenos are obsessed with the automobile. Cars and LA go hand in hand like peanut butter and jelly. To many, a car is just transport, but to us, it's a passion. The Petersen Automotive Museum has celebrated this passion since 1994.

Located on the corner of Fairfax Avenue and Wilshire Boulevard, the Museum underwent an extensive \$90M renovation in 2015. The exterior now features a stainless steel ribbon made of 100 tons of steel, assembled in 308 sections. 25 supports and 140,000 stainless steel screws hold it together. The Museum's interior spaces are configured to accommodate changing exhibits and are designed to encourage repeat visits. Boasting over 100,000 square feet of exhibition space, the Petersen Museum is a "must see" during an LA visit.






