



Easily accessible, the campus is located at the heart of the UK's road and rail network, with 90% of the population less than 4 hours away.





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
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

Birmingham Precision Medicine Centre (BPMC) will support the pharmaceutical and biotech industry to reduce costs and speed up the process of clinical translation of drug development. Soon to be based at No. 1 Birmingham Health Innovation Campus, BPMC offers a commercially-focused, innovative, end-to-end clinical and academic partnership for the delivery of precision medicine – underpinned by clinical expertise and academic research excellence.

BPMC enables:

- Bespoke retrospective and prospective sample collection and release systems with cutting-edge molecular pathology
- Comprehensive patient immunephenotyping with access to CyTOF,

- digital imaging, metabolomics and transcriptomic analysis
- Comprehensive trial design and delivery using latest design methodologies at industry standard
- Access to internationally-leading expertise in patient-reported outcomes
- Evolving design and evaluation methodologies to support outcomesbased approvals.

Within BPMC, the Industry Trials Hub provides the highest levels of clinical quality management in regulatory-standard trials development, delivery and analysis for complex, precision trials. This will enable both detailed analysis and evidence of the molecular-biological outcomes of new drugs –

and trial data will be curated to provide an ICH e6 GCP 'fit for filing' package, offering accelerated progress to market. Similarly, BPMC Diagnostics offers identification of novel disease prognostic and diagnostic biomarkers and development and validation of companion diagnostics. Through match-making technologies with clinicians, BPMC Diagnostics can accelerate patient stratification and recruitment into clinical trials, delivering to ISO and GCP standards.

The campus will offer a world leading health technologies facility, fully connected to the regional health ecosystem, suitable for the ambitious life science companies of tomorrow.





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
