De Viel Castel's illustration for the 111th anniversary mirrors the Carlton's characteristic symmetry and understated elegance. Meanwhile, a surrounding tapestry of dynamic colours and soft, rounded forms creates an intriguing contrast that brings the hotel's sense of harmony and warmth to the fore. "I wanted to emphasise the cosiness and warmth the Carlton radiates, even during the coldness of winter," explains the artist.

In this sense, de Viel Castel's illustration is not merely a work of art but an invitation to our guests to discover the hotel's rich history via new, colourful perspectives. Reopened after a redesign in December 2023, the Grand Restaurant at the Carlton Hotel is a hymn to nature and the culinary delights of the Engadin. Under the direction of Executive Chef Salvatore Frequente, guests enjoy a fusion of traditional influences and contemporary gourmet cuisine. Frequente's menu places a spotlight on wild ingredients from the surrounding forests – from sea buckthorn to juniper berries – in an authentic celebration of the region's diversity.

Conceived by Ticino designer Carlo Rampazzi, the interior uses earthy tones and large windows to mirror the surrounding landscape and complement the natural elegance of the space. It's a place where nature, fine dining and creativity come together in one extraordinary gastronomic experience.






Sustainability

Rewilding work was recently completed on the Bos-Cha lowland moor in the Lower Engadin – not far from the hotel – thanks to a joint initiative between us, the Pro Terra Engiadina Foundation and our environmental partner myclimate.
