

Perfection on a plate



Under the direction of Executive
Chef Marco Campanella, gourmet
restaurant La Brezza is where creative
flair meets exceptional culinary
craftsmanship. Diners are whisked on
a journey of flavours of a kind they've
never experienced before. Campanella's
mission is as simple as it is revolutionary:
to never allow boredom to creep onto
a plate. It's one he accomplishes with
flair: his creative, bold creations are
a continual source of inspiration and
surprise.

After being named 'Discovery of the Year' in 2019, Campanella's quest for culinary perfection was soon rewarded with his first Michelin star. He was named 'Hotel Chef of the Year' in the Bilanz hotel rankings for 2020 and cooked to his way to a second Michelin star for gourmet restaurant La Brezza in 2022. Today, these two Michelin stars and 18 GaultMillau points stand as a testament to Campanella's inimitable flair.

But what sets his culinary style apart from the crowd? Campanella has always drawn inspiration from fresh, regional and seasonal ingredients – and in the spirit of our Moving Mountains philosophy, he's now turning his sights to plant-based cuisine. "For me, taste is important above all else – including, or especially, with plant-based menus," he says. "I try to incorporate as many flavours as possible into the dishes: sweet and sour, smoky and salty, all in a way that surprises and intrigues."


Moving Mountains *Immersion in nature*


