## Bach MS Orchestra – 4:00 p.m. Amanda Musser, Conductor



AMANDA MUSSER graduated from Texas Christian University in 1975 and began a teaching career in Arlington, Texas that spanned 34 years until her retirement in 2009. During that time the Bailey Junior High Orchestra won numerous awards, including an invitation to perform in Washington DC in 1997, and its selection as the Texas Music Educators Association Honor Orchestra of the state in 1995. Throughout her teaching career, Mrs. Musser worked with more than 30 student teachers from area universities, many from TCU. Many of her former students are orchestra directors in the DFW area and all over the state. In May 2019, Mrs. Musser completed her 10th and final year at TCU as Adjunct Professor of Music Education and Supervisor of Student Teachers. She now spends her time mentoring orchestra teachers for both FWISD and Arlington ISD. In 2010, she joined the artistic staff as conductor of the Junior String Orchestra in the Fort Worth Youth Orchestra organization. She is a member of TMEA, TODA, TMAA, a charter member of Mu Omicron and is a frequent judge and clinician throughout Texas and the South. Finally, in February 2018, Texas Orchestra Directors Association named Mrs. Musser as their 2018 Orchestra Director of the Year, a great honor from her peers! Mrs. Musser resides in Arlington, married to retired band director Steve Musser, and is mother of two grown sons and grandmother to Wesley, Libbey, Hunter, William and Davis. Of all her many jobs in "retirement", this is her favorite!

Daniel performs equally as a violinist and violist, serving as Assistant Principal Viola with the Austin Opera. Outside of teaching and performing, Daniel enjoys spending time with his husband Jerry and their son Liam who is embarking on his journey as a Suzuki cello student.

A graduate of Baylor University with a degree in Music Education, **JULIE BLACKSTOCK** is currently in her 27<sup>th</sup> year of teaching and her eleventh year as the Director of Orchestras at Liberty High School in Frisco, Texas. Prior to teaching at Liberty, Ms. Blackstock taught in the Carrollton/Farmers Branch Independent School District for sixteen years, twelve of those at Creekview High School. Under her direction, the orchestras in both districts consistently received top awards and honors, including regularly being finalists of the TMEA Honor String and Full Orchestra competitions. The Symphony Orchestra at Liberty High School was also invited to perform at the Midwest International Band and Orchestra Clinic in Chicago in December 2015. Ms. Blackstock has also been a frequent adjudicator and clinician for UIL, Solo/Ensemble contests, festivals, and All-Region, All-District, and All-State Orchestras throughout Texas, Arkansas, Washington, Oregon, Utah, and Georgia. She also served as an instructor/conductor at the Baylor University Summer Music Camp for 20 years. Currently Vice-President of TMEA Region 24, Ms. Blackstock is proud of her memberships in the Texas Music Educators Association, Texas Orchestra Directors Association, Texas Music Adjudicators Association, Mu Omicron, and is honored to be a member of Who's Who Among American High School Teachers. For six years she served as Orchestra Lead for Frisco ISD, developing curriculum and staff development, facilitating Professional Learning Committees, and mentoring teachers. Ms. Blackstock is passionate about sharing intimate musical moments and modeling vulnerability through music. One of her core beliefs and philosophies is to create a safe environment in the

musical classroom where all students find a place to belong, connect, and express themselves. Cultivating relationships this way is one of her greatest strengths. In a fast-paced society, she believes making music together helps students be aware of and appreciate the world around them. In her free time, Ms. Blackstock enjoys spending her time reading, tending her flowers and vegetables, watching and feeding birds, and traveling on road trips whenever she can, alongside her cat Little Susie.

### Philharmonic HS Orchestra – 5:30 p.m. William Waag, Conductor



WILLIAM WAAG has conducted the Santa Fe Youth Symphony since 2014 and also serves as the Santa Fe Symphony's Associate Artistic Director of Youth Programs. As of 2024, William is also the Principal Conductor of the Santa Fe Community Orchestra, and the Los Alamos Symphony Orchestra. A passionate music educator, he also works regularly as a guest clinician in music classrooms in New Mexico, and beyond. As a guest conductor, William has lead the Santa Fe Symphony, the Albuquerque Philharmonic, Seattle Rock Orchestra, Santa Fe Community Orchestra, Los Alamos Symphony, Mobile Symphony Youth Orchestra, El Paso Symphony Youth Orchestra, Albuquerque Youth Symphony, and All-Region Honor Orchestras in Texas, Alabama, and New Mexico. William has held a variety of conducting and teaching positions at elementary, middle, and high schools, colleges, public and private institutions, and four states across the western United States. He has led wind and jazz ensembles, symphony orchestras, drumlines, classes in music education, music theory, music for students with special needs, and pre-school music. Above all, William's deepest passion is for conducting youth symphonies and leading young musicians' exploration of the symphonic world. Previously with youth orchestras in Washington and Alaska, William is elated to be leading both youth and adult symphonies in New Mexico. William received a MM in Orchestral Conducting from Central Washington University, and a BM in Music Education from Boise State University. Originally from Boise, he lived in Washington state and Anchorage before moving to Santa Fe. A Pacific-Northwesterner at heart, William loves exploring and climbing mountains in all seasons and traveling the highways slowly in his 1972 Volkswagen bus.

# Symphony HS Orchestra - 6:00 p.m. Tammy Yi, Conductor



DR. TAMMY S. YI is a distinguished first-generation Korean American conductor and music education scholar from Los Angeles, CA. She currently serves as the Director of Music Education and professor at Chapman University, where she is also the founding director of Mariachi Panteras and the orchestra conductor for the Los Angeles Philharmonic's Youth Orchestra Los Angeles (YOLA). Additionally, Dr. Yi teaches graduate courses in music performance research and pedagogy at the Colburn Conservatory of Music. Dr. Yi's career embodies her unwavering commitment to transformative social activism through music and the performing arts in service of young people. She frequently conducts El Sistema orchestras internationally, as well as local school orchestras and state honor ensembles, using orchestra education as a powerful tool for social empowerment. Her work as an international conductor has taken her to some of the world's most esteemed venues, including Walt Disney Concert Hall, the Hollywood Bowl, Teatro Mayor, Carnegie Hall, and more. She has conducted and collaborated with renowned artists such as Gustavo Dudamel, Nina Shekhar, Ray Chen, the Juilliard Orchestra, the Los Angeles Philharmonic, the National Children's Symphony Orchestra of Venezuela, and Janet Jackson, solidifying her reputation as a versatile and influential orchestral leader. Dr. Yi's extensive conducting experience spans both professional and youth orchestras, with significant engagements in South Korea, Thailand, South America, Europe, and across the U.S., including performances with the Texas All-State, California, Tennessee, New York,

and Nevada orchestras. Beyond her artistic accomplishments, Dr. Yi plays a crucial role in advancing the field of music education. She mentors pre-K–12 music educators, leads professional development sessions for teaching artists, trains aspiring conductors, and develops comprehensive music curricula for the Los Angeles Philharmonic. By integrating pedagogy with performance, Dr. Yi bridges the realms of artistic excellence and social change, illustrating the transformative potential of music in both educational and performance contexts. Her work is grounded in the conviction that music includes BIPOC voices, culturally responsive pedagogy, and social justice to cultivate artists, performers, and musicians who can contribute meaningfully to music society. Through this holistic and inclusive approach, Dr. Yi continues to shape the next generation of musicians and educators, fostering a culture of inclusion, innovation, and intellectual growth within the performing arts.
