



FORMAT

The UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup as part of the FISE Bazhong follows the rules as defined by the UCI. Please refer to the UCI rulebook for any question regarding the competition format.



^{*} Following the registration conditions (Part VI. Bis BMX Freestyle Competition, 6bis.9.002).

In case of schedule issues (for climatic reason or other), format and planning could be adapted. In case of a canceled phase, the results from the last completed phase will be considered as final results.

^{**} If less than 31 athletes registered then the semi final will not take place and the top 12 from Qualification will advanced to the Final.

COMPETITION JUDGING

CRITERIA

The performance of each rider is judged on overall impression including, but not limited to:

- Difficulty (refers to not only the tricks performed but also the placement
- of the tricks within the course and the combinations used),
- Height (amplitude of the tricks performed),
- Flow,
- Originality (tricks and lines) and versatility,
- Style,
- Progression,
- Variety of tricks (refers to a good mix of standard airs, rotations, grinds, ...),
- Risk factor.
- Landings,
- Use of the course,
- Execution.

The overall composition of the runs is most important as the judges evaluate the sequences of tricks, the amount of risk in the routine, and how the rider uses the course. The judges take errors such as falls and stops into consideration.

Regulations from the UCI rulebook

« Registration in the Men Elite and Women Elite categories for the UCI BMX Freestyle World Cup shall be done by pre-registration only. Once the pre- registration deadline has passed, no further entries shall be accepted. »

Part 6bis, Chapter IX: 6bis.9.002

« The organizer is not allowed to accept any entries after the riders' confirmation deadline found in the Technical Guide. The Commissaire appointed to supervise the Competition shall rule in the event of a dispute.

Ignorance of the provisions of the Technical Guide or of the competition schedule shall not be admitted as an excuse by any rider or other license holder. »

Part 6bis, Chapter III: 6bis.3.004

« No further entries shall be accepted following the end of riders' confirmation. Likewise, any riders who entered but did not attend riders' confirmation, shall be removed from the list of entries and not allowed to start. »

Part 6bis, Chapter VI: Riders Confirmation, 6bis.3.017

REGISTRATION HURRICANE REGULATION

Participants agree to unconditionally transfer their image rights to SAS HURRICANE and the FISE association, which are free to use them for an indefinite period.

By signing the registration forms, each participant gives authorization to SAS Hurricane and the FISE association, organizer of the event, as well as to all their partners:

- To film and/or photograph all of its performances (sports or not),
- To use its image and the said content produced, whether for commercial purposes and/or promotional,
- To reproduce, exploit and distribute, whatever the medium, the content produced.

The participant grants this authorization from the day of registration for the competition and for a period of 10 years for the whole world, free of charge. The participant agrees not to request any remuneration or financial compensation from SAS Hurricane or from the FISE association and their partners.

We remind participants that as part of their registration and their participation, SAS HURRICANE collects personal data, necessary for the running and promotion of the Festival.

Pursuant to the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016 and Law No. 78-17 of January 6, 1978 known as "Informatique et Libertés" amended and updated, Participants concerned by the processing of personal data may exercise their rights (access, rectification, erasure and portability of data after their death) by contacting:

Licence

A valid cycling license, as defined in Part I of the UCI Regulations will be required and must be presented at riders confirmation to check their identity. An identity card or passport is also mandatory.

Once all the terms of the registration are completed, the organization will give riders a wristband allowing them to enter the competition area. It is imperative that all the riders keep their band throughout the event, otherwise the access to the park will be denied.

A rider whose license could not be verified and whose status as a non- suspended license holder cannot be established in any other manner may not start and may not figure in the classification of the event. »

UCI Rules Book - Part 6bis, Chapter VI: Riders Confirmation, 6bis.3.017

Entry in the competition implies agreement with the event schedule, regulations and all provisions of the Technical Guide.

· Riders eligibility

50 points on rider's name at the UCI Individual Ranking are required before the Ranking Deadline (29th August 2023) to register. Rankings : www.uci.org

It is important that the 31-12-2022 UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup ranking is used to determine the Top 50 riders who are free to enter even if they do not currently have the 50 UCI points.

In case a Park rider does not have 50 or more points his/her registration will be refused. In case a national federation does not presently have any riders with 50 or more points as of the ranking deadline for any particular event, that federation nevertheless has the right to enter a single rider for the category in question. In this case, it is up to the national federation to choose which rider is entered, if any.

Exceptions:

- Riders ranked in the top 50 of the final UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup ranking of the season prior (2022) may enter if they do not presently have 50 or more points as of the ranking deadline for any particular event in the season following.
- In case a national federation does not presently have any riders with 50 or more points as of the ranking deadline for any particular event, that federation nevertheless has the right to enter a single rider for the category in question.
- * Rider needs to have 50 UCI ranking points to his/her name on that day.
