

PRECAUTIONARY CRITERIA

due to wind for large vehicles such as trucks and buses

Warning 1 Storm warning 20 m/s. Gusts can reach 26 - 29 m/s.		
20 m/s	Fully loaded trucks and buses with very good seat utilization and luggage.	Light trucks with no, small or light cargo as well as empty or semi-empty buses.
DRY & WET Surface	Drive carefully. Winds can seriously affect the car.	Carefully study the conditions ahead because gusts can even blow the car off the road.
SLIPPERY Surface	Study the conditions ahead because gusts can even blow the car off the road. Recommended to put chains on the wheels.	Trucks shall be chained. Buses must be on good studded tires and chains must be placed on their wheels if possible.

Warning 2 Storm warning 24 m/s. Gusts can reach 30 - 35 m/s.		
24 m/s	Fully loaded trucks and buses with very good seat utilization and luggage	Light trucks with no, small or light cargo as well as empty or semi-empty buses.
DRY & WET Surface	Carefully study the conditions ahead. Stop and wait if you suspect that the weather is getting worse or the wind is increasing. Drive below the speed limit.	It is not recommended to continue driving where gusts are common. Drive below the speed limit. Turn the vehicle into the wind if you notice a gust and stop.
SLIPPERY Surface	Keep a slow speed. Chains must be placed on the wheels of trucks. Buses must be on studded tires and chains must be put on if possible.	Unconditional stop!

Warning 3 Storm warning 28 m/s. Gusts can exceed 35 m/s.		
28 m/s	Fully loaded trucks and buses with very good seat utilization and luggage	Light trucks with no, small or light cargo as well as empty or semi-empty buses.
DRY & WET Surface	Unconditional stop!	Unconditional stop!
SLIPPERY Surface	Unconditional stop!	Unconditional stop!
