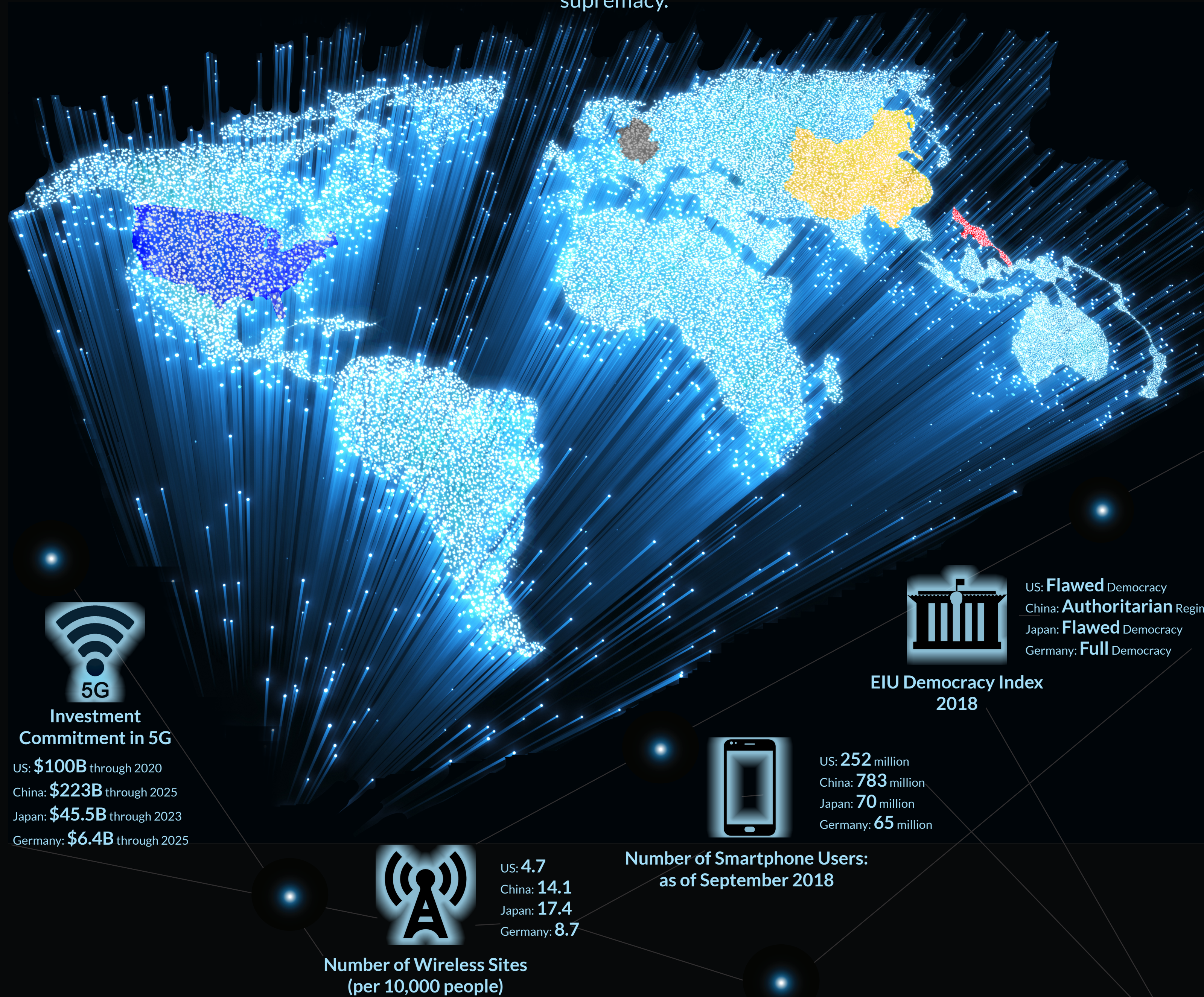


WHO WILL WIRE THE WORLD?
