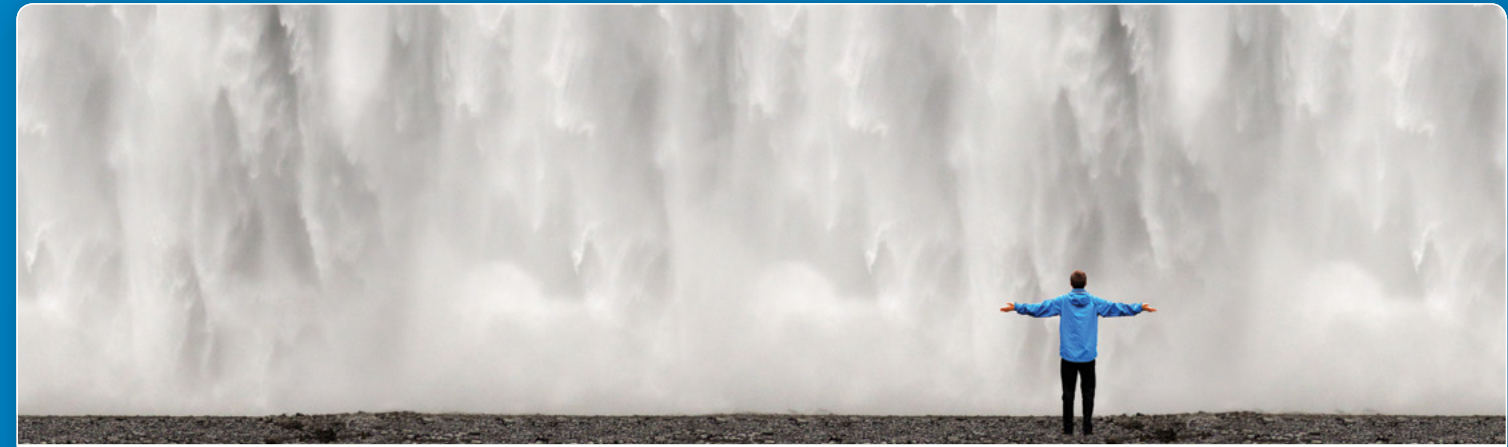
future generations visiting Iceland. A few of the objectives are to treat nature with respect, guarantee safety of tourists, respect workers' rights and to have a positive effect on the local community.

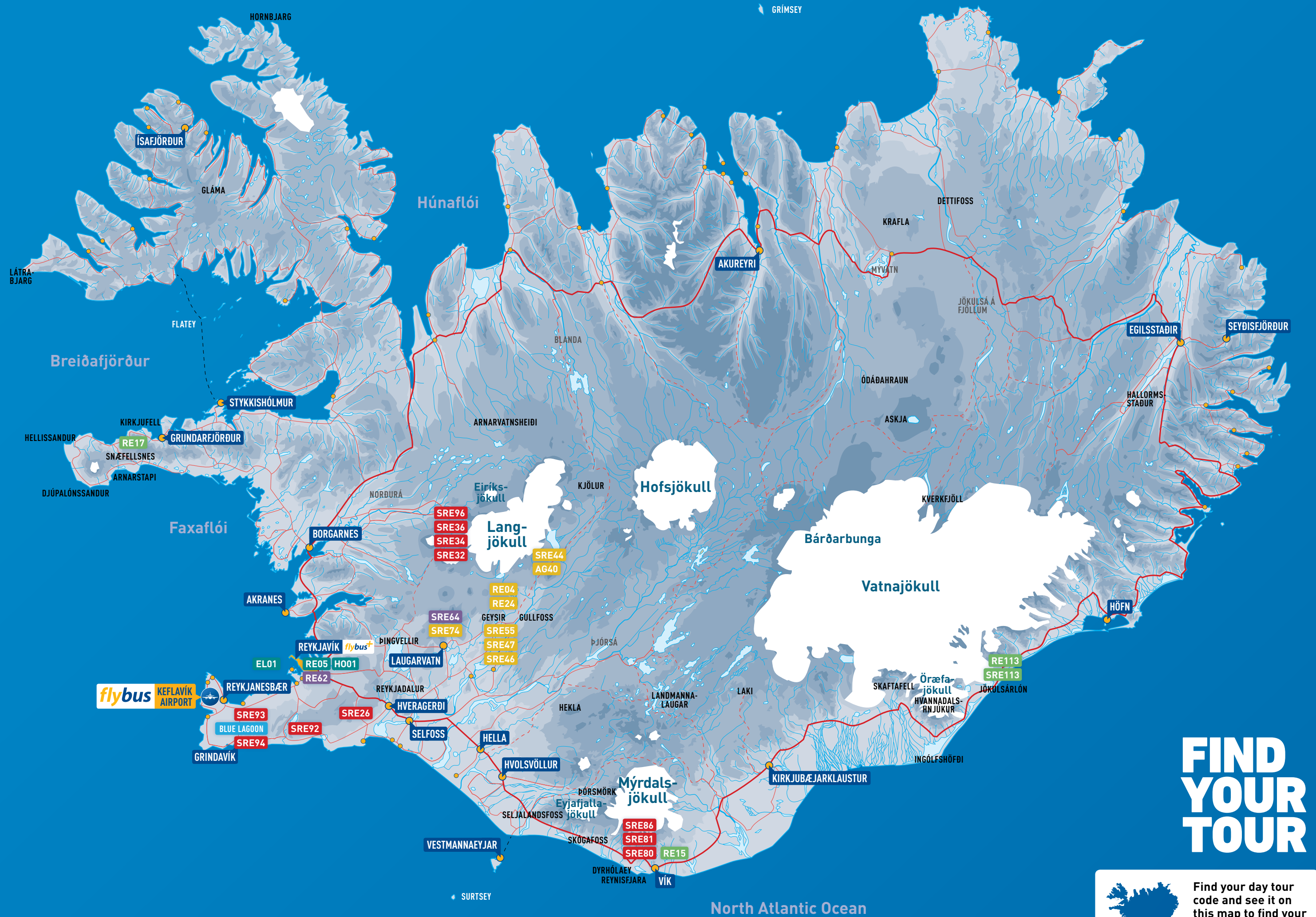

The Flybus, known for its efficient and reliable connections, is coordinated with all arriving and departing flights, around the clock, holidays included. The Flybus departs from Reykjavik's main bus terminal, BSÍ. We additionally offer pick up or drop off at designated bus stops, and at selected hotels and guesthouses in Reykjavik at specific times during the day, at an extra cost.

In addition to the regular Flybus, Reykjavik Excursions offers passengers to or from the airport the option of stopping at the Blue Lagoon. The Blue Lagoon, a deliciously warm pool of powder-blue water rich in minerals and renowned for its healing properties is one of Iceland's best-known attractions. As it is located close to Keflavik International Airport, many passengers opt to visit the Blue Lagoon either on arrival or departure from the country or even during a stop-over. The Golden Circle includes a few of Iceland's most stunning sites; Þingvellir, Gullfoss and Geysir.

Þingvellir National Park is a historical and geological wonder where the American and Eurasian tectonic plates pull the country apart at a rate of a few centimetres per year. At Geysir geothermal area, we will see the hot spring Strokkur shoot a column of water high up into the air every 4-8 minutes.

Gullfoss waterfall is a two-step waterfall filled with melt water from Langjökull glacier and tumbles into a deep crevice.

Additionally, we visit the Friðheimar greenhouse where we learn about the magic behind growing delicious, pesticide-free tomatoes with the aid of geothermal heat which Iceland has in abundance.

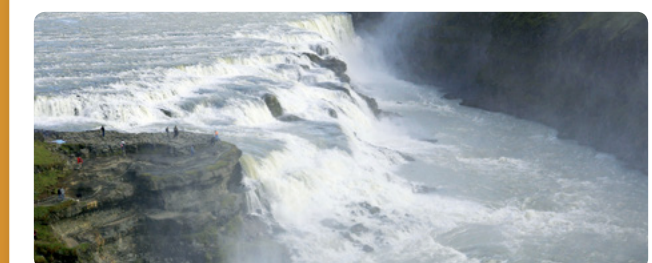

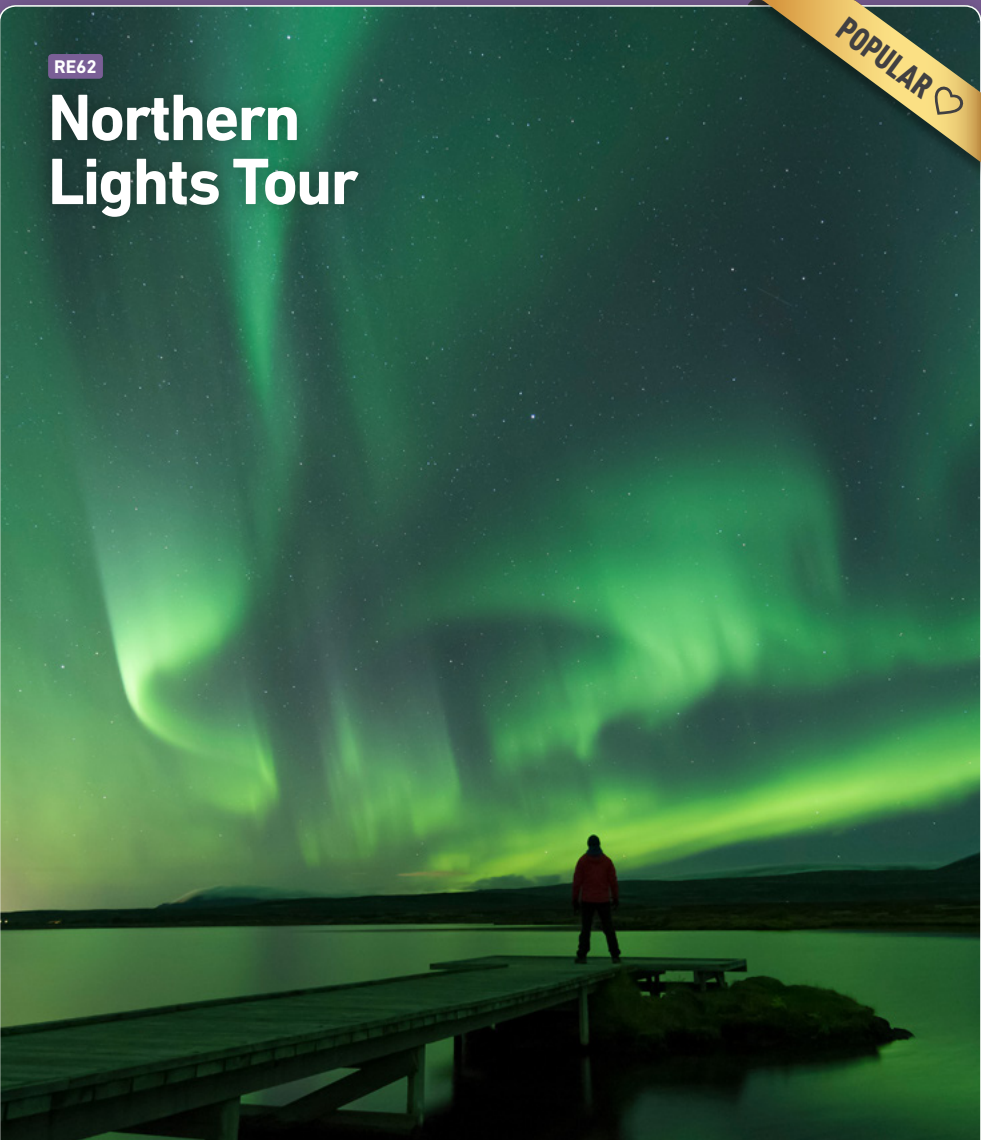

The northern lights are caused by the interaction of particles from the sun with the upper atmosphere near the North Pole. That creates this wonderful light effect, known as the aurora borealis.
