Golden Circle & The Lava Tunnel

Begin the day witnessing the inner works of a volcanic eruption while walking the path of lava that flowed thousands of years ago. The lava tunnel is one of the biggest caves in Iceland and gets up to 30 metres wide and 10 metres high. The fantastic range of colours of the tunnel walls is caused by different mineral types of rocks and the lava tube ceiling has caved in near the entrance, creating beautiful columns of light.

The next part of the tour takes you to three of Iceland's most stunning sights; Gullfoss waterfall, Geysir geothermal area and the famous Þingvellir National Park.

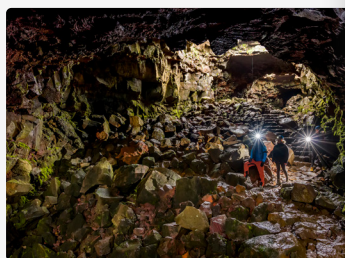

South Coast & DC-3 Plane Wreck Black Beach ATV Adventure

On this fun, adventurous tour, we will experience different landscapes of all kinds. We head to the south towards Mýrdalsjökull glacier and Katla, a dormant volcano. The ATV tour starts from our base camp, and it takes us down to the black lava sands, crossing some small rivers and onwards to the Sólheimasandur beach, where a famous DC-3 airplane wreck is, known from a Justin Bieber music video and a Bollywood film. From the black beach, we will enjoy the amazing view up to Mýrdalsjökull and along the south coast to Dyrhólaey promontory.

Additionally, after the ATV tour we will stop at the two scenic waterfalls, Skógafoss and Seljalandsfoss before returning to Reykjavík.

South Coast & Glacier Hiking

A glacier hike is a great way to experience Icelandic nature.

On our way to Sólheimajökull glacier, an outlet glacier from Mýrdalsjökull, Iceland's fourth largest glacier, we pass by Eyjafjallajökull volcano that erupted with a world famous bang in 2010.

Upon arrival at Sólheimajökull we get our crampons, harness and ice axe and start the hike. The total walking time is 2-2,5 hours which includes spending 1-1,5 hours hiking on the glacier.

We will learn more about the wonderland of ice sculptures, ridges, deep crevasses and why the glaciers are melting and disappearing. En route back to Reykjavík we stop at the striking waterfalls, Skógafoss and Seljalandsfoss.

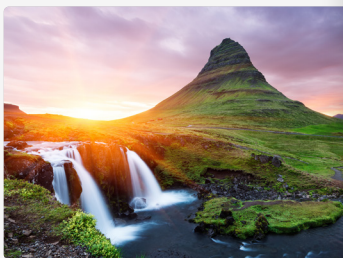


Wonders of Snæfellsnes National Park

En route we stop at the small fishing village Arnarstapi, at Hellnar, a former trading post, and at Djúpalónssandur beach, before passing by the iconic Kirkjufell mountain!

All this stunning landscape has captured the imagination of people all over the world, ever since Jules Verne wrote the famous science fiction novel "Journey to the Centre of the Earth", but the journey begins at Snæfellsjökull glacier.

Jökulsárlón Glacial Lagoon & Diamond Beach

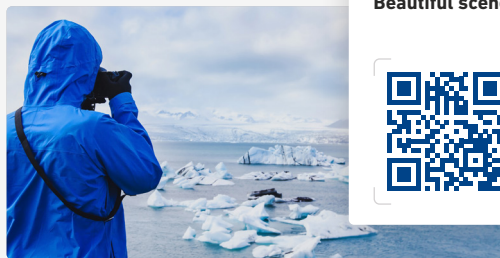
On this great tour to Jökulsárlón glacial lagoon, we drive along the south shore, one of Iceland's most scenic routes. Along the way we will see beautiful mountains, glaciers and beaches.

The highlight of the day is Jökulsárlón, with its enormous and ancient icebergs breaking off from Vatnajökull glacier - a sight you cannot miss! The lagoon covers 18 square kilometres (7 square miles) and reaches more than 248 metres (814 ft) at its deepest point.

Close by is the aptly named Diamond Beach, where beautiful icebergs decorate the black sands.

En route we will also stop at two stunning waterfalls, Skógafoss and Seljalandsfoss.

Langjökull Ice Cave Experience

- Into the Glacier

Visit a unique and remote man-made ice cave in Langjökull glacier, one of Iceland's largest and most spectacular glaciers. We begin the tour by driving to the lush Húsafell area with stops at Deildartunguhver, Europe's highest water flowing hot spring, and the beautiful waterfalls, Hraunfossar and Barnafoss. After a break in Húsafell, we head on up to Langjökull, partly in a specially modified glacier vehicle. It will almost take us to the top of the glacier, where we enter the magnificent cave. Going into the glacier is an unforgettable experience which takes place in one of the world's great wildernesses.

Imagine standing on an ice cap reaching 200 metres below your feet!

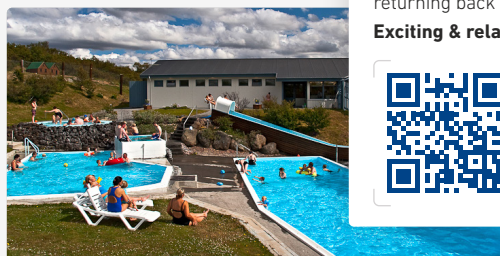


Lava Cave & Geothermal Adventure

On this tour we visit Iceland's largest natural lava cave, located in West Iceland. We drive through the beautiful Borgarfjörður towards a beautiful area named Húsafell. On the way we will stop at the highest water flowing hot spring in Europe, Deildartunguhver, and two magnificent waterfalls; Hraunfossar and Barnafoss.

After a stop in Húsafell, we head to the stunning Viðgelmir cave (148.000 m³) which is one of the largest natural lava caves in the world. There we start an adventurous walk down to the colourful cave and learn about its history and geological uniqueness dating all the way back to the Viking age. Following the cave adventure, we relax at the geothermal pool at Húsafell before returning back to Reykjavík.

Volcanic Wonders of Reykjanes Geopark

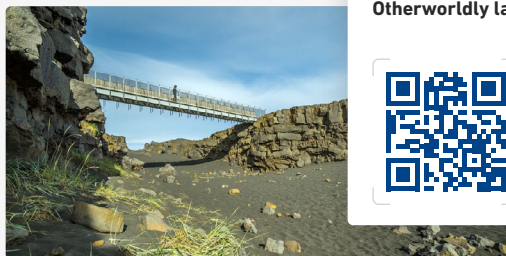
Reykjanes Geopark is located on a peninsula divided between two continents. This unique place is located on the drift zone between the North American and Eurasian continental plates, making it a true volcanic wonder!

We start the day by exploring one of the most iconic features of the landscape, the boiling mud pools of Seltún. Next up on our adventure is the Fagradalsfjall volcano, and its surrounding lava fields. After the volcano hike, we stop by the bridge between continents, where you can walk between the continental plates that divide the peninsula. Finally, we stop by the largest mud pool in Iceland, Gunnahver, where you can feel the ground shake from the enormous power released from the boiling water and steam.

Whale Watching from Reykjavík

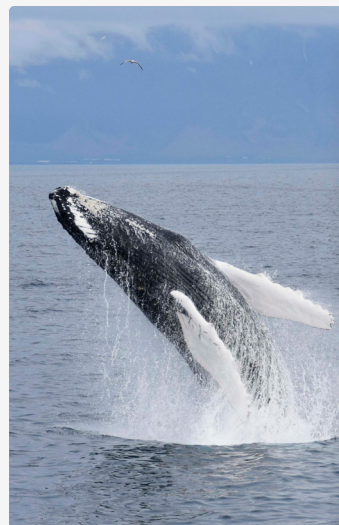

Puffin Express from Reykjavík

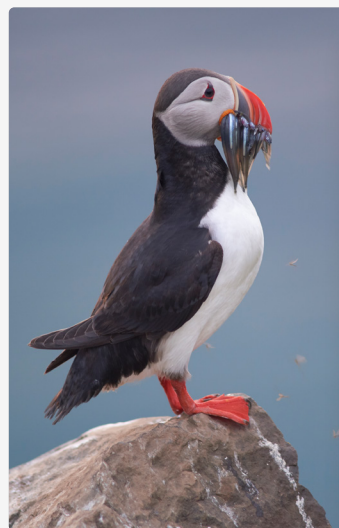
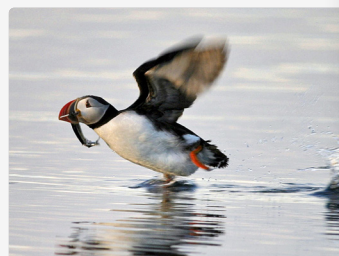
On this tour we sail out to Kollafjörður fjord on a charming old oak boat, "Skúlaskeld" which is especially designed to sail as close as possible to the islands, due to the boat's shallow draught. The islands, Akurey and Lundey, are both well-known colonies for puffins and other seabirds such as northern fulmars, seagulls, arctic terns and black guillemots, only to name a few.

Puffins return to the same site to breed and nest year after year. While sailing, the guide will provide some interesting information about history and biology of birdlife. When approaching the islands the engine is turned off so passengers can observe the birds in their natural habitat and enjoy this unique sight.
