The perimeter of Rectangle A is 42cm.



What is the width of Rectangle A?

The answer is **8cm**. To calculate the perimeter of a 2D shape, you add up the lengths of all its sides. The two lengths of the rectangle give a total of 26cm. If we take this away from the total perimeter, we are left with 16cm. Halve this value to get the width of the rectangle.


