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James O'Keefe founded Project Veritas and Project Veritas Action after he had pulled off some of the most consequential undercover journalism coups in a generation, so he could have an organization dedicated to reviving the craft of undercover journalism. These two organizations are non-profits dedicated to investigating corruption, dishonesty, waste and fraud in public institutions and the private sector.

The undercover journalism O'Keefe has pioneered at Project Veritas relies on the most modern digital and video technology infused with the legacy of the great investigative journalists of the past, such as Nellie Bly, Mike Wallace, Gunter Wallraff and Woodward and Bernstein.

Today, O'Keefe and Project Veritas and Project Veritas Action continue to seek the same opportunities that first motivated him as a Rutgers undergraduate philosophy major. At Rutgers, he founded an independent campus newspaper called *The Centurion*.

In 2007, O'Keefe and Lila Rose recorded Planned Parenthood staffers ready to accept a donation from O'Keefe would only be used to abort African-America children and working with Rose, pretending to be a pregnant 15-year-old, to conceal her age, so Planned Parenthood could abort her child without reporting to the police what would be a prima facie statutory rape case.

The ACORN Investigation

O'Keefe first walked on the national stage in 2009. At the suggestion of Hannah Giles, she and O'Keefe went into offices of ACORN, the Association of Community Organizations for Reform Now, purporting to be a pimp with his prostitute. Using a camera hidden in O'Keefe's necktie, they recorded the staffers in ACORN offices around the country explain to them

how to lie on tax and welfare forms, bury cash in a tin box underground and how to declare the underage Salvadoran females O'Keefe claimed to be trafficking into the U.S. to become prostitutes as his dependents.

Working with Andrew Breitbart, a friend and mentor to O'Keefe, he and Giles unleashed one of the biggest political scandals on Capitol Hill since the impeachment of President Bill Clinton, ten years prior. The series of videos from ACORN offices around the country led to the group's collapse, as it also lost federal contracts with agencies, such as the Census Bureau. As other reporters got involved, including The Wall Street Jour-



nal's John Fund and The American Spectator's Matthew Vadum, which led to the uncovering of more corruption. Ultimately, the House and Senate, both controlled by Democrats, voted to defund ACORN and President Barack Obama signed it into law.

In the following years, O'Keefe and Project Veritas journalists released investigative reports led to a reduction of federal funding to National Public Radio, as well as numerous NPR executives being fired and or retiring. Another investigation



into the private group Enroll America, led to its director getting fired and a series of congressional field hearings focused on fraud inside Obamacare navigator program.

Health and Human Services Secretary Kathleen Sebelius resigned April 10, 2014, three weeks after the Government Accountability Office documented her role in the raising money for Enroll America in her official capacity from organizations doing business with her department.

Heading into 2014 elections, O'Keefe launched investigations in four key battleground states to expose the hypocrisy of Senate candidates misleading voters: Phil Bredesen, Russ Feingold, Mark Udall and Allison Lundergan Grimes. All four Senate candidates lost at the ballot box.

In 2016, Project Veritas and Project Veritas Action released videos exposing key Democrats not only admitting voter fraud exists, but also showing how to successfully commit it on a massive scale. In New York City, Democratic Election Commissioner Alan Schulkin admitted on a hidden camera voter fraud was rampant in his city and it was allowed to flourish to the benefit of the Democratic Party. Additional videos released that year exposed consultants hired by the Democratic National Committee and Hillary Clinton's presidential campaign conspired to foment violence at rallies held by candidate Donald Trump's campaign. The investigation has been credited with exposing the dark side of the Clinton campaign's tactics.

O'Keefe turned his attention to the mainstream media in 2017 and the Project Veritas investigations into CNN became the No. 1 trending videos in the United States. This investigation exposed CNN's anti-Trump bias and raised serious questions about the news organization's credibility.

Just days before the 2017 Presidential inauguration, O'Keefe and Project Veritas reporters infiltrated the Antifa-linked DisruptJ20 movement to conduct an undercover investigation at Washington's Comet pizzeria, where the agitators plotted how to violently disrupt President-elect Donald Trump swearing in a planning meeting. After viewing the footage, O'Keefe turned it over to the FBI, the Secret Service and the capital's Metropolitan Police Department, which led to the arrest of Scott Charney, Paul Kuhn, and Colin Dunn, charged with conspiracy to commit an assault.

The team kept up the investigative pressure in the 2018 Senate races by helping retire incumbent Democratic senators in Missouri, North Dakota and Indiana. Undercover journalists captured one candidate admitting that she had "a bunch of Republican voters" at home, but the she and Obama "essentially have the same views," and the "people just can't know that." As a result, his team was credited with helping maintain the conservative balance of power in the U.S. Senate.

In 2019, O'Keefe launched the Project Veritas "Be Brave. Do Something" campaign. The campaign's focus is to recruit insiders at organizations who will come forward to Project Veritas and choose to become vehicles of change, catalysts for citizen empowerment and have the will to inspire moral courage. These groundbreaking investigations into social media giants,

Pinterest, Google and Facebook exposed practices, such as Facebook's "deboosting" of users, posts and comments.

One of the insiders, a Pinterest software engineer, Eric Cochran, came forward with evidence that Pinterest targeted posts by the pro-life organization LiveAction, led by Lila Rose.

Another revelation was when Google engineers were recorded revealing Google's not so hidden agenda in "Algorithmic fairness", news blacklists and "human raters," once again, the findings were so compelling that O'Keefe gave the footage to the Department of Justice, along with more than 950 pages of leaked documents.

On Capitol Hill, the investigations led to House and Senate hearings, where lawmakers grilled social media executives the contrast between the public statements and the Project Veritas findings. It was a direct result of these Project Veritas investigations, which reveals the practice of shutting down a user's



access to their online community without notice that the term "shadow banning" entered the lexicon.

The success of the social media investigations forced mainstream media outlets to cover O'Keefe and Project Veritas and it led to non-mainstream media outlets to conduct their own investigations. Even social media celebrities came forward with their own experiences of being shadow banned, suspended or even deplatformed from social media communities, where they had experienced great success. This social media awakening culminated with President Donald Trump calling a July 11, 2019 "Social Media Summit" in the White House's East Room. In the middle of his prepared remarks, the president caught sight of O'Keefe and saluted him for his impact.

"[Gesturing at James O'Keefe] there he is, stand up please! How good... what a great job. Somebody said he's controversial. He's not controversial, he's truthful. He's truthful. That was a great job. That was one of many. Thank you very much." – President Trump at the White House. July 11th, 2019.

One of O'Keefe's most recent impactful investigations was ABC News anchor Amy Robach telling people in the studio, but off-camera, that her bosses at ABC News spiked her expose of pedophile Jeffrey Epstein. The "Good Morning America" anchor told her studio crew her report would have also implicated President Bill Clinton and she doubts Epstein took his own life. The Robach video was viewed and shared by tens of millions of viewers around the world as America's mainstream media and international media outlets could not ignore this scoop.





"The cops are gonna be the ones that are getting f*cking beaten in Milwaukee. They're gonna call up the National Guard for that sh*t. I promise you that."

They are also recorded brushing off the human rights atrocities committed by the Soviet Union and planning violence as a back-up plan depending on the outcome of Sanders' election effort. 

[Iowa City, Iowa] An Elizabeth Warren Presidential Campaign Field Organizer, Angel Alicea, was secretly recorded admitting to his frustrations of extreme political correctness taking place within the Warren Campaign.

Angel Alicea, who works out of the Warren Campaign Iowa office, says that although he cares about transgender people, Democrats are losing elections for prioritizing gender pronouns over economic issues.

Project Veritas Action Fund's undercover journalists secretly recorded Alicea's statements on multiple occasions where he vents about other campaign staff members singling him out for being a heterosexual male in the office and not having gender pronouns in his Twitter bio description. The recordings give insight into the conflicts among Warren staffers, how they view the current political landscape, and how they prioritize certain campaign policies over others.

Angel Alicea believes that Elizabeth Warren and the Democratic Party are misguided when it comes to the American people's priorities. He also thinks that his fellow Warren Campaign staffers are part of the problem:

ANGEL ALICEA: "At the end of the day if we're gonna prioritize pronouns over making sure people have a decent

standard of living, that's wrong."

JOURNALIST: "Yeah, you're right."

ANGEL ALICEA: "And when you come from where I come from, no one gives a f**k about a G** d**n pronoun. People want to know how to create a job."

"On the surface, he tries to portray himself as left of moderate, so that all the Georgians, not us Georgians, but all the rednecks and all that stuff will be like, 'oh, he's kind of cool," said Dino Nguyen, a self-professed progressive looking forward to a career in Georgia politics.

"If John was running as a progressive within like the 5th District of Georgia, which is all-black, that's the one that John Lewis, the Civil Rights activist, was running for, he could win that, pretty much a landslide, but he wants to go for senator," Nguyen said.

"You have to appeal to the whole state. Our whole state isn't progressive. It's more moderate, right?" he said.

Nguyen said to our undercover journalist that despite this strategy, the journalist should be confident to spread the word. "You can spread that to your other progressive friends but keep this on low key."

Georgia voters are not ready for new ideas, he said.

"Jon is genuine to a certain point, but he can't show his true self 100 percent of the time, so that's the tough part about campaigning in purple or red states,

because the people here are not open minded," he said. "There is maybe 40 percent that are, or 45 percent--the rest are a different breed or a different kind."

Dino Nguyen: "He has to win this election. He is not going to win the



election as a progressive, and that's basically it. At a certain point we have to wait for the boomers to die off."

Journalist: "Do you think like the Georgians are stupid enough to—"

Nguyen: "Yeah. You can spread that to your other progressive friends but keep this on low key, but he's not so far to the left that I'm not cool with it. But deep down, he's low key progressive. It's some-

thing that keeps you pumped up, especially because I know he's going to win. We know he's going to win, right? He's going to do what it takes to help us out. And then it's going to take the rest of the states as well, because change doesn't happen with just one person."

[COVINGTON, K.Y. – SEPTEMBER 16, 2020] The U.S. Senate campaign for Kentucky Democrat Amy McGrath was caught on hidden camera sharing conflicting viewpoints, imploring staff to appear "more moderate" and neglecting to correct voters who may otherwise vote for Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell even if "its not true."

Footage released today by Project Veritas Action Fund (PVAF), a not for profit investigative journalist organization, shows Abby Cox, Northern Kentucky Field Organizer for McGrath "off the



clock" and emphasizing how McGrath has to appear to be supportive of President Trump, and Pro-life even though her personal views are in complete contradiction.

"It's not that she [McGrath] like supports him [Trump], but in order to like do this thing we're trying to do, that's sorta what's required," said Cox. "The way we need to do it (win the election) is not by like talking about policy."

Recent polls suggest the Bluegrass State which elected a Democratic governor in 2019 was in play for McGrath. However, the state has received mixed messaging from the candidate, her campaign and website.

"I have to wonder, how much integrity does McGrath and her campaign have if they "selectively edit out" all of the actual policies that will be enacted once elected?" asked James O'Keefe, Founder and CEO of PVAF.

[Westchester County, N.Y.—Oct. 8, 2020] Project Veritas Action Fund journalists exposed conflicted campaign staffers working to elect retired Navy Capt. Mark Kelly to the US Senate representing Arizona.

Another operative working to elect the retired astronaut turned Democratic senatorial candidate is Alan Bederka, a data manager for Everytown for Gun Safety who told a Project Veritas Action Fund journalist it is Kelly's strategy to downplay his true gun control agenda.

"[Kelly] just doesn't make it a main focal point of his campaign," Bederka said. "I mean, I work in politics. I'm used to people being liars."

Kelly is not in a position to change the opinion of Arizona voters on gun rights, so the strategy is to de-emphasize his gun control agenda—until he gets into the Senate, he said. "There's a higher probability of being able to enact the kind of legislation you're hoping to see get in an enacted."

Bederka said one of things Kelly wants to enact into law is a ban on so-called assault weapons.

Alan Bederka: "Things like an assault weapons ban, which would be freakin' lovely."

Journalist: "Does Mark Kelly support that?"

Bederka: "Oh yeah, absolutely.

Bederka said the ban Kelly wants is far more extreme that anything posted by his campaign.

Alan Bederka: "[Kelly's] probably in favor of a general assault weapon ban and what that would mean is no more ing about how Americans are so stupid like; can we just trick them?"

Alan Bederka: "You can, but you got to remember that there are other people trying to trick them to thinking the opposite way at the same time. You got to beat their propagandists. That's the problem.

Journalist: How do we do that? Bederka: "I arrest them."

Bederka also described how his organization, Everytown for Gun Safety, uses press releases to coordinate with other committees to circumvent federal election law—and how if the National Rifle Association found out about the coordination it would be catastrophic.

"Even the staffers are kind of confused, like we want him to come full force out, but the problem is this is such

"Yeah. even if it's not the fullest extent of like complete gun ban, he still wants to do something substantial and that would be assault weapons and universal background checks," Carpio said.

"[Kelly] wants to get those Republicans that don't trust Trump anymore, and one

of their main issues is guns," said Carpio to a Project Veritas Action Fund undercover journalist.

"I don't think he's fully like being out there saying like, I want like a full gun control type measure," she said. "I think it's because he just wants to get elected first and then he wants to go further."

Carpio said the problem is that Kelly

cannot get elected if he emphasized his full gun control agenda.

"Arizona is very Republican state in general, like a red state and I know, actually right now it's purple technically, but I just think he wants to get those Independents," she said.

[DENVER—Oct. 15, 2020] Senate campaign staffers for former Colorado governor John W. Hickenlooper Jr. told a Project Veritas Action Fund journalist they are confused about the Democrat's stand on fracking.

Maisha Fields, a senior advisor to the Hickenlooper's Senate campaign, acknowledged the conflict in the former governor's fracking position in a conversation with an undercover journalist.

Journalist: "It's, again, don't get me wrong, [Hickenlooper] has my vote, but I just wish he would denounce fracking."

Maisha Fields: "Yeah-"

Journalist: "That is my biggest thing. I don't understand why it's necessary, I guess."

Fields: "Policy is about baby steps, because no one wants to, no one, we are a country where although we say we want change, we can only really accept change incrementally and so that is why it's so difficult. It's not like he wants that same thing—but, realistically is every-

body gonna vote for that? No. Will they vote for that eventually? Yes."

Another campaign staffer Quinn Egan told the Project Veritas Action Fund journalist that she is also confused.

"Honestly, I have no idea. It's like, I don't know, because it's so contradictory. Like, I don't know," said Egan, who is a political fellow with Hickenlooper's Senate campaign.

"Like what else can you do, you're like, eh, I think



you're lying but, like you know I'd still, I'm not---like what's worse?" she asked. "Something that he's wishy washy on or voting for Cory Gardner? It's sh*tty that we have to decide that, but like, still it's like the two-party system at its finest."

"I don't think he fundamentally opposes fracking," Egan said. "He's said before that he like thinks it should still continue."

James O'Keefe, the founder and CEO of the Project Veritas Action Fund, said, "If the staffers are confused about Hickenlooper's position on fracking, then it should not be a shock if the voters are confused."
