Policies

Promotional Materials

All promotional materials which use the CCM logo or Chinese Canadian Museum name or branding must be approved prior to publication and/or display.

Exhibition and Art

The renter and guests must adhere to all guidelines provided by CCM to ensure the protection and preservation of exhibitions and artifacts.

Decoration

Any decoration or wall mounting must be approved by the museum.

Clean Up

The renter is responsible for leaving the venue in the same pristine condition as it was provided. Any damages or excessive cleaning required after the event will be invoiced to the renter.

Smoking and Vaping

Smoking and vaping is strictly prohibited within the museum premises, including the rooftop.

Early Setup

Early set up is only available for designated areas and times.

- If early set up is required one day prior to the event, an additional fee of 25% is required.
- If early set up is required on the day of the event, an additional fee of 10% is required.

Noise

Live music or amplified sound must be approved in advance and is subject to additional fees.

Outside Catering

Approved catering vendors are preferred (CCM to provide a list). All alcoholic beverages must be served by a licensed bartender. Any non-preferred vendors must be approved by the Venue.

Overtime

All events must adhere to the designated rental time slot specified in the rental agreement. Additional charges will apply for events that exceed the agreed-upon duration. Overtime rates are calculated at 1.5 times the regular hourly rate.

Payment

Deposit

Once the date is confirmed, a deposit of 15% of the rental fee is required to hold the spot and can be paid by cash, cheque, EFT or major credit card.

If a deposit is paid by cheque, the rental agreement is not valid until the cheque has cleared.

Payment Deadline

The balance of the rental and any other amounts owing under the agreement are due five business days prior to the event.

Additional Charge

Any additional charges incurred during or after the event are due when invoiced.

Cancellation

- If made 60 days prior to the event, the full deposit will be refunded.
- If made less than 60 days but at least 30 days prior to the event, half of the deposit will be refunded.
- If made less than 30 days prior to the event, the full amount of the deposit will be charged.

Event Insurance

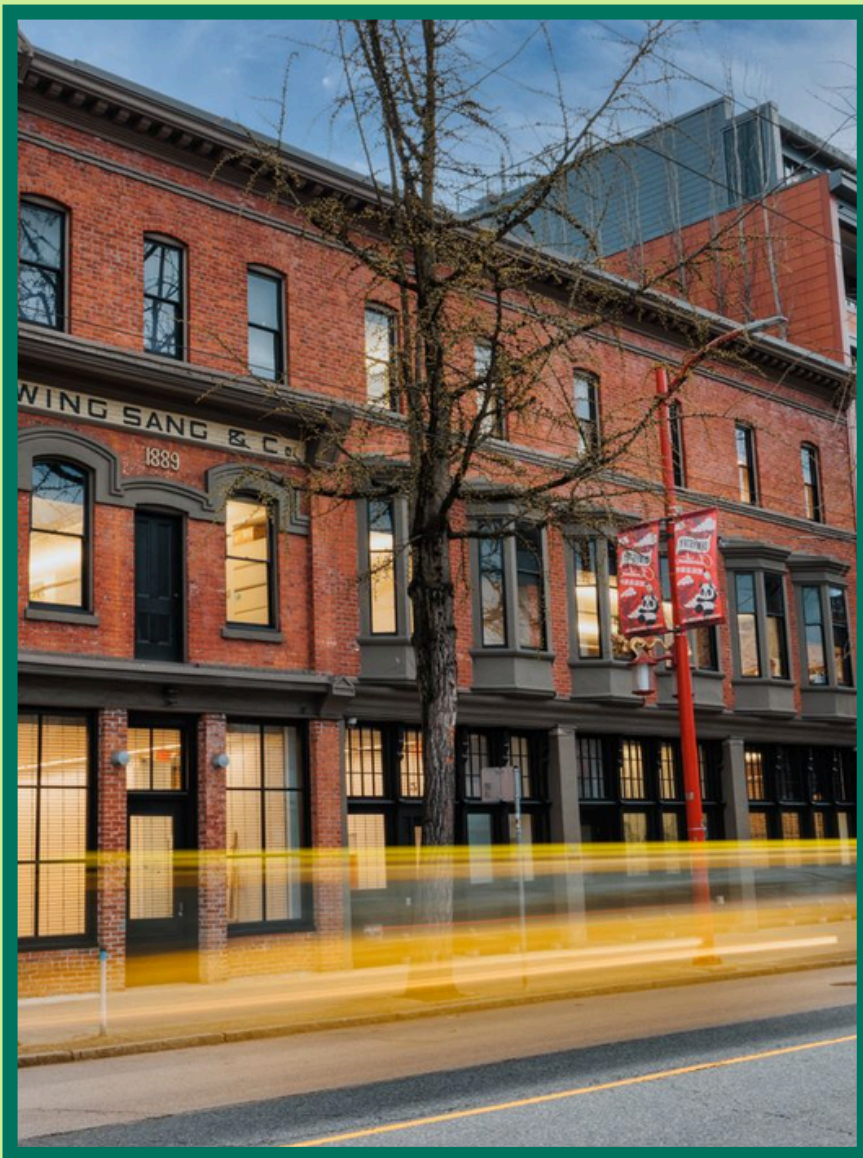
A provincial certificated event insurance is mandatory. Liability coverage of \$2,000,000 is required for non-alcohol events, and \$5,000,000 for alcohol-involved events.

Security Deposit

For events where there is a risk of damage to the premises, a security deposit of \$2,000 may be required.

Taxes

All rates and fees are subject to venue rental taxes.
