- Multi-colored felt
- Scissors
- Hot glue or craft glue

- Needle & colored thread

Reuse old clothes to decorate your puppet






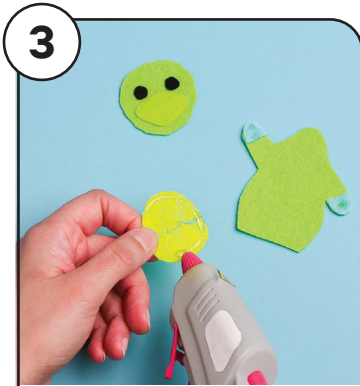

 Let's get started! Using the stencils of your favorite Wonderoos character, cut out two body pieces and two head pieces. For Teshi, you'll also need two shell pieces. Tip: Trace the stencils onto the felt with a paint marker for easier cutting.




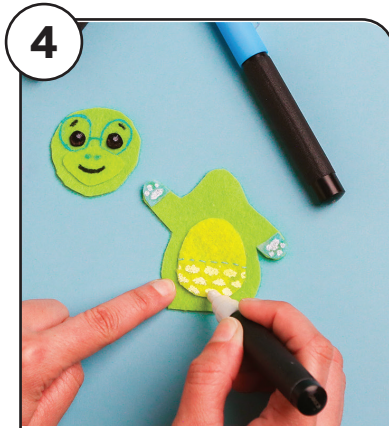

 Cut out your character's detail pieces, like their eyes, nose, belly, and paws.

 Glue the felt details onto one head piece and one body piece.

Use fabric markers or paint for smaller details, like the mouth and eyebrows.



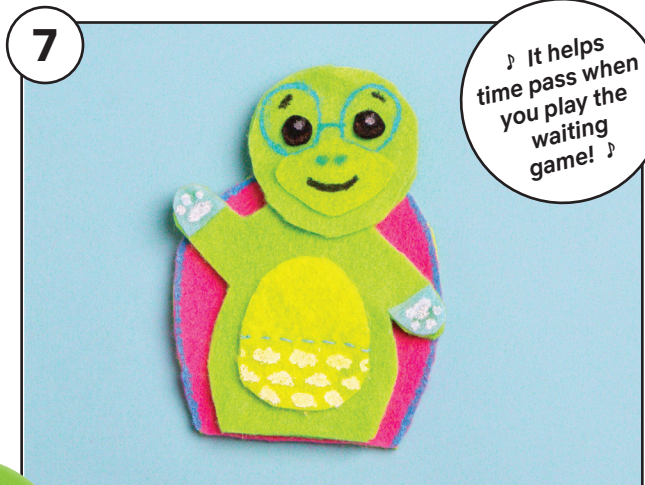

 Let's turn your character into a puppet! Grab a body piece and put glue along all the edges except the bottom. If your character has a tail, glue it down. Now, attach the front of your character to the back, leaving a pocket for your finger.

Glue the back head piece to the head and neck, then attach the front piece.

♪ It helps time pass when you play the waiting game! ♪

You're all done! Wait until the glue is completely dry before playing with your new Wonderoos finger puppet. This usually takes a few minutes, so be patient! :)

Little T

Step 1: Let's make Little T! Cut out his pieces and glue them all together.

Step 2: Use your fabric marker or paint to make his buttons, mouth, and eyes. You can also use googly eyes.

Glue two ends of a little strip of felt to Little T's back so Teshi can hold him up!
