Ultraman: Rising Mask

- ☐ Printable stencil templates
- ☐ Hot glue or craft glue
- ☐ Hole punch
- ☐ Cardstock
- ☐ Blue cellophane
- ☐ String
- ☐ Pencil
- ☐ Silver paint
- ☐ Paintbrush
- ☐ Scissors



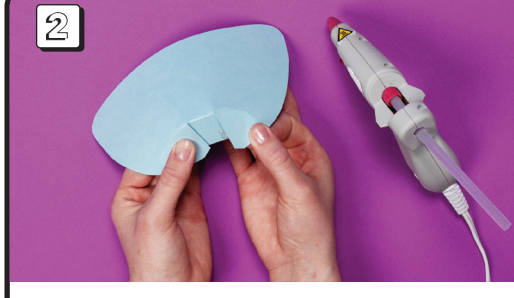
Ask an adult to help you with this project



Get the mask templates before starting this craft!



1 Let's use piece A to make the top of the mask! One at a time, slightly overlap and glue the sections between each of the 5 slits to give your mask a 3D shape!



2 Let's use piece B to make the bottom of the mask! Fold along the solid line to create a tab. To make the chin, pull the two sections on either side of the tab toward each other, then glue them to the tab.



3 Taking pieces A and B, adjust the mask to fit the length of your face. Glue the front of B to the back of A.



4 Punch holes in piece A for the strings, then tie off each end.



5 Let's use pieces F and G to make the ears! Make a loop with each piece by gluing their points together. Then, glue them to either side of the mask.



6 Let's use pieces C, D, and E to make the fin! After folding the tabs on E, glue C to one side and D to the other.



7 Let's add some details! Glue the fin down the center of piece A. Glue the mouth (piece H) to piece B.



Paint your new mask silver!



9 Once your mask is dry, cut out two 3-by-3-inch squares of blue cellophane and glue them to the back of the eye holes.
