



Now it's time for a puggy-licious breakfast! "Eat up," says her brother. "Today's a big day!"




Finally, it's time to go to school.

Let's Make It StoryBots Pencil Holder





Put a drop of glue at the top and bottom of the can and wrap the can with yarn.

Use glue as needed to hold the yarn in place.

Supplies

Green Yarn
Green Craft Foam
Tall Tin Can
2 Bottle Caps
Orange Pipe Cleaners
2 Googly Eyes
Scissors and Glue

Ask an adult to help you cut.




Add a drop of glue on the back of each googly eye and place each eye inside a bottle cap.



Place a drop of glue on the back of the bottle caps, then place the two bottle caps at the top of the can.



Cut two strips of craft foam to make eyebrows and glue each eyebrow (at a slanted angle) to the bottle caps.



Put a drop of glue on the back of the can and attach a pipe cleaner. Wrap the pipe cleaner around the can, bending the front ends to make arms.





























charlie's What comes next in each sequence?

When you breathe in, your nose sends messages to your brain. And your brain tells you what you're smelling!



1 slice of toast


Mashed avocado

6 green apple sticks


1 slice of toast
