Welcome to the 2024 Calgary Stampede Parade presented by Suncor! Since 1912, the Stampede Parade has served as the official kickoff of The Greatest Outdoor Show on Earth, and it is an iconic part of Calgary's cultural identity. This year we are honoured to welcome actor Owen Crow Shoe as our 2024 Parade Marshal.

Owen's acting career began right here in Alberta on the set of the Oscar winning film, The Revenant. Since then, his roles have taken him across the country and around the world, including to California where his latest movie, Dream, is being filmed. Before he returns to the silver screen, Owen is kicking off Stampede by leading more than 105 entries comprised of over 400 four-legged and close to 5,000 two-legged participants through the streets of Calgary.

Among the colourful floats, majestic horses and high-energy marching bands, you'll find two special participants in this year's Parade – Duane Mark, Stoney Nakoda Tipi Holder, and Lloyd Templeton, the 2024 Calgary Stampede Poster artist. This beautiful Poster offers a unique view of this historic Parade and depicts Duane riding in the foreground, with a diverse group of Parade participants and spectators making up the landscape.

We are also proud to continue our Parade partnership this year. Suncor has been a key partner of the Calgary Stampede for more than 15 years, and in 2023 they joined this tradition that brings our community together. I encourage everyone watching the Parade to take advantage of Parade to Park presented by Suncor, where you can go straight from the Parade to Stampede Park for free admission from 11 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.After you watch Owen lead the Parade, you can find him at the 2024 Calgary Stampede Powwow as a Master of Ceremonies. His voice will fill the Scotiabank Saddledome on July 7 and 8 from 1 to 6 p.m. as he announces competitors and guides the audience through two days of competition at this extraordinary event.

2024 has been an exciting year at Stampede Park. In May we opened the doors to Sam Centre, an immersive, year-round Stampede experience, sharing the grit and glory of Stampede's greatest stories. A month later, we welcomed guests to the new BMO Centre expansion at Stampede Park – Western Canada's largest convention centre. Our committee includes representatives from many different departments and agencies within the City of Calgary and the Province of Alberta who give of their time to ensure that parade fans can travel to and from the route efficiently, while safely enjoying the spectacle of the parade. It is truly a monumental effort that reflects the volunteer spirit that built this great city and is at the heart of the Calgary Stampede.

HISTORY OF THE STAMPEDE PARADE

THE CALGARY STAMPEDE PARADE, PRESENTED BY SUNCOR IS THE OFFICIAL KICK OFF TO THE GREATEST OUTDOOR SHOW ON EARTH!

The first Calgary Stampede Parade took place on September 2, 1912 (Labour Day). It was reported that eighty-thousand spectators attended – "only those who were in hospitals or jails missed the opportunity to review the wonderful procession …". There were an estimated 3,000 participants, along with horses, oxen, bulls and buffalo. By many accounts, the highlight was the indigenous representation, reported to include almost 2,000 representatives of Treaty 7.

Guy Weadick's vision for the Parade was not only to generate international attention for Calgary, and its grand exhibition, but to bring business and economy generally to the Canadian Northwest. Entries, or "sections" of the Parade, as it was in the first year, were to reflect events of historic importance, including the coming of the Hudson's Bay Co., the mining industry, whiskey traders and missionaries. The Royal Canadian Mounted Police had a prominent spot, and of course all manner of farmers and ranchers.

Anyone was welcome to join the march, so long as dressed in appropriate cowboy or cowgirl costume, and riders must have stock saddles only – "no flat saddles allowed".

The first Stampede Parade was just over 1 kilometer long, commencing on 6th Avenue at 9th Street and ending at 6th Avenue and 2nd Street. The current Parade route is approximately 5 kilometres in length. It takes almost two hours to pass any one point on the route. It would take the average person just over 6,300 steps to complete the entire route. The route is the same length as just over 25 Calgary Towers laid end-to-end (15,748 feet).

Parade Marshal OWEN CROW SHOE

The Calgary Stampede is honoured to announce that actor Owen Crow Shoe will lead the 2024 Stampede Parade as the Parade Marshal.

Crow Shoe is from the Piikani Nation and Blood Tribe of the Blackfoot Confederacy. His acting career started on the set of the Oscar winning film, The Revenant, where he worked as a stunt rider. Since then, his roles have taken him across the country and around the world, including to California where he's currently filming Dream.

This summer, Crow Shoe co-stars alongside the 2022 Parade Marshal, Kevin Costner, in the movie Horizon: An American Saga, but on July 5 he'll be returning home to southern Alberta to kick off Stampede 2024.

In addition to leading the Parade, Crow Shoe will be part of the 2024 Calgary Stampede Powwow as a Master of Ceremonies. His voice will fill the Saddledome on July 7th and 8th as he announces competitors and guides the audience through an extraordinary day of competition.

I grew up at the Calgary Stampede and never missed a year in my life, except 2011 when I was playing football in Kamloops. From spending time in Elbow River Camp singing and drumming, to participating in the Warrior Ride during the Stampede Rodeo Grand Entry, I've made a lot of memories and lifelong friendship at the Stampede.

My family has been part of the event since 1985 when my grandparents Earl and Allison Healy first set up their tipi in Elbow River Camp and I am proud to continue that tradition by leading the Parade and officially kicking off The Greatest Outdoor Show on Earth.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS AND HOW TO GET TO THE PARADE



Utilizing public transit, walking, or carpooling is the optimal way to get to the Parade route. If you must drive downtown, plan to arrive well before 7:30 a.m. (*when the roads close*) or park outside the closed area.

Parking restrictions on all roads on and adjacent to the Parade route will be in effect from 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 4 to approximately 3:00 p.m. on Friday, July 5. All roads in and out of downtown intersecting with the Parade route will be closed at 7:30am Friday July the 5th.

PARADE SEATING, SAFETY, AND ETIQUETTE

- More than 80% of the Parade route along 9th and 6th Avenues is available for free-of-charge seating on a first come, first served basis. It is best to arrive early to find optimal viewing spots.
- The Calgary Stampede Parade Committee does not provide seats.
- Parade operations require five full lanes of traffic: the center three for entries and the outer two lanes for Parade operations and emergency vehicle access.
- Do not cross the Parade route at any time.
- Keep a close eye on children.
- Portable water stations will be available along the route. Spectators are encouraged to bring re-fillable water bottles.
- To avoid heat related emergencies bring a broad brimmed hat, stay hydrated with water and wear a minimum SPF 30 sunscreen.
- Portable toilets will be available along the route.
- In case of rain, bring raingear, but try to leave umbrellas at home, as they may block the view of other spectators.
- Emergency Medical Services (EMS) will be onsite.

PARADE PRELUDE

BE SURE TO STAKE YOUR SPOT ON THE ROUTE EARLY AS YOU DON'T WANT TO MISS THE PARADE PRELUDE!

Once the parade route is cleared of traffic at about 7:45 am, these wonderful groups hit the parade route in static locations to perform for the gathering parade fans.

TRADITION HISTORY FACTS

The **2024 Stampede Poster** includes an iconic image of Parade marchers passing by the Calgary Tower.

In the foreground is Stoney Nakoda tipi holder, Duane Mark, riding a horse, which reflects the artist's celebration of the relationship between the Calgary Stampede and the First Nations people of Treaty 7 territory.

The artist is 22-year-old Calgarian, **Lloyd Templeton**, as the winner of the sixth Calgary Stampede Youth Poster Competition. The competition is one of Canada's largest educational art scholarships, aimed at preserving and promoting western heritage for future generations.

The Poster tradition began even before the first Parade in 1912, advertising in 1908 the Dominican Exhibition, Calgary, Alberta: "Western Canada's Greatest Fair". The 1912 Poster referred to the Stampede as "A Carnival of Cowboy Sports Open to the World", and included an image created by the famous western painter Charles Marion Russell. Posters have been produced consecutively every year since, evolving from being strictly a marketing tool to an icon of the event and the City of Calgary.

In 1999, the Stampede Poster archive was established. Until 2019, all but three posters were accounted for; 1930 was located in 2019 (donated by Darlene and Bill Mowatt - it had been hanging in their basement for more than 35 years). Now only 1922 and 1926 are outstanding.

THE CALGARY STAMPEDE PARADE IS THE SECOND LARGEST IN NORTH AMERICA after the Rose Bowl Parade held in Pasadena, California. With a live inperson audience of 300,000 OR MORE!

First Nations have played a prominent role in the Calgary Stampede since 1912 when 1,800 members of Treaty 7 led the Parade at the request of Stampede visionary, Guy Weadick.

Has it ever rained on a parade? Truth be told, it has. In 1951, "It rained – in sheets it rained. The temperature was 42 above and most of the marchers just about froze."

The largest horse train to drive in the parade was led in 1925 by Ralph 'Slim' Moorehouse. It was a **36-horse hitch** comprised of beautifully matched black Percherons. Slim had 6 outriders, to help steer and manage the train. He pulled 10 wagons of grain, competing for prowess in a time when the freight industry was being overhauled by the introduction of motorized vehicles. Approximately **2 tons of manure** will be deposited on the Parade route. Since 2001, the City of Calgary "Street Sweeper Critters" have been responsible for clearing the Parade route.

The Critters include: Chestnut the Horse, Barlow the Buffalo, Outlaw the Bull, and Daisy the Cow. The Stampede Critters will be joined by the "Men in Kilts" street sweepers.
