1. Migration disrupts operations

2. Multichannel complexity gets worse

Different channels behave differently in your current setup. Some sync smoothly, while others require constant attention.

What this means:

- Whether you're managing 2-5 sales channels or scaling across 5+ global marketplaces, you spend a lot of time updating stock, fixing mismatches, and switching between systems. Some sales channels require manual updates, which steal time from strategizing.
- High-volume sellers who operate across global marketplaces face deeper consistency issues, since each channel may have different currencies, fees, and rules.

How Veeqo solves this:

- **Smart automation:** Set rules once to apply them across all channels automatically.

- Manual decisions raise shipping costs and increase the chance of fulfillment errors. Sellers who split inventory between their own locations and FBA often juggle multiple systems just to see what is available.
- Larger teams with several domestic or international locations need clear rules that show what each site is responsible for and how inventory should be positioned.

4. Warehouse operations don't scale

Your current workflows barely keep up during normal periods, and during peak season, everything breaks.

What this means:

- Your team is running around the warehouse with printouts in hand, seasonal workers take days to train, and everyone has their own way of doing things because the system doesn't enforce standardization.
- You want to onboard seasonal workers in hours instead of days, using standardized processes so anyone can step in and maintain quality.

The technical migration is simpler than you might expect. Because Veeqo has no order or user limits, you can take a gradual approach.

Start with shipping, then add inventory management and Profit Analyzer as you're ready.

How to migrate to Veeqo

Here's the complete step-by-step process:

1. Create your Veeqo account

- Visit the **Veeqo signup page**.
- **Register** using your email address or connect via Amazon.
- **Fill in required business details** (store name, monthly order volume, address, marketplace country).
- **Enter referral code**, if you have one, for extended Veeqo credits.

Amazon integration:

Connect your Amazon store in just a few clicks. Just choose “Continue with Amazon” if you already have an account in Amazon Seller Central. As part of Amazon, Veeqo provides trusted data security and Amazon account protection from late deliveries and negative feedback when you ship on time.



2. Connect your sales channels

- **Click to connect** your sales channels (Shopify, Amazon, Walmart, eBay, Etsy, etc.).
- **For Amazon:** Use "Continue with Amazon" for automatic one-click connection.
- **For other sales channels:** Enter your credentials and store URLs when prompted.
- **Veeqo automatically** begins importing your orders, listings, and inventory.

Amazon Shipping:

Now available in Amazon for your orders both on and off Amazon. Rate shop or buy Amazon Shipping labels, no separate connection required.

3. Set up your warehouses

- Add each physical location as a separate warehouse. You can also set up your physical stores as locations.
- Select which warehouse fulfills orders from each channel.
- Configure routing preferences for multiple locations.

Smart order routing:

Orders automatically route to your closest warehouse with available inventory, reducing shipping costs and delivery times.



4. Import your store's listings and inventory

- Select which ecommerce channels you're connecting to.
- Veeqo automatically imports listings and stock levels from your connected channels.
- Link products sold across multiple sales channels by SKU (recommended) or by title. Learn about [listings management](#).
- Review imported data for accuracy.

Real-time inventory sync:

Inventory updates happen instantly across all channels. Transfer stock between locations and see the changes reflected everywhere in real time

5. Set account synchronization preferences

- **Inventory control:** Decide whether Veeqo or your store should be the master of stock (who controls inventory levels).

8. Register your payment and billing info

- Add a credit card in the billing section to purchase shipping labels.
- Or choose to pay directly from your Amazon Seller Central balance (Amazon sellers).
- **Note:** You'll be charged per transaction initially. After a couple of weeks, you may receive a credit limit for batch processing.

Veeqo Credits:

Use Veeqo Credits you've earned to pay for your shipping labels. Amazon sellers can also pay directly from their Seller Central balance.

9. Activate your store connections

- **Review** all channel and inventory settings one final time.
- **Activate** your stores to begin live synchronization.
- **Veeqo starts syncing orders**, products, stock, and prices according to your preferences.

Important:

Orders continue flowing. There's no service interruption during activation.



10. Review and finalize

- Navigate to the listings section to review all imported listings.
- Update product statuses as needed (active, inactive, archived).
- Verify inventory levels match your physical stock for top-selling items.
- Ensure everything appears correct after migration.
