






Fig.1. Bolinder.




Fig.2. Kesseler et Sohn.




Fig.3. Sigl.




Fig.4. At'r de Darmstad.




Fig.5. Borrosch et Eichmann.




Fig.6. Houget et Teston.




Fig.7. Enthoven.




Fig.8. Fowler.




Fig.9. Warral.




Fig.10. Malo-Allen.




Fig.11. Tuxford.




Fig.12. Gargan.




Fig.13. Dankerque.




Fig.14. Brisse et Thierry.







FOOT-SPOOL MAKING.




Has to make twelve pairs of shoes for 1s. 6d. Has the upper supplied, cuts out the sides
