This includes a foundation of transparent, meaningful relationships with all our stakeholders to meet or exceed their expectations and to work together in addressing common sustainability challenges.

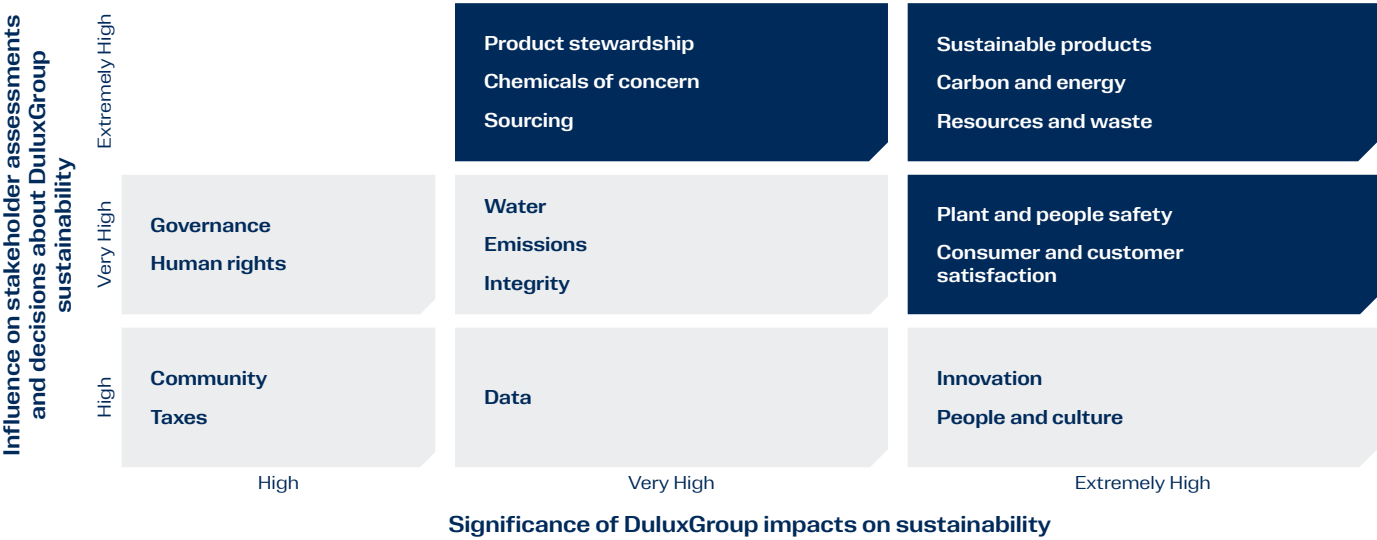
## Materiality

## What is Green Star?

The Green Star rating system is the only recognised voluntary standard in Australia for evaluating the quality of buildings, communities, and homes in terms of their design, construction, and operations. By using different Green Star ratings tools, assets can be certified based on their performance level. Green Star certification provides a clear description of the asset’s attributes in language that is widely accepted within the industry.

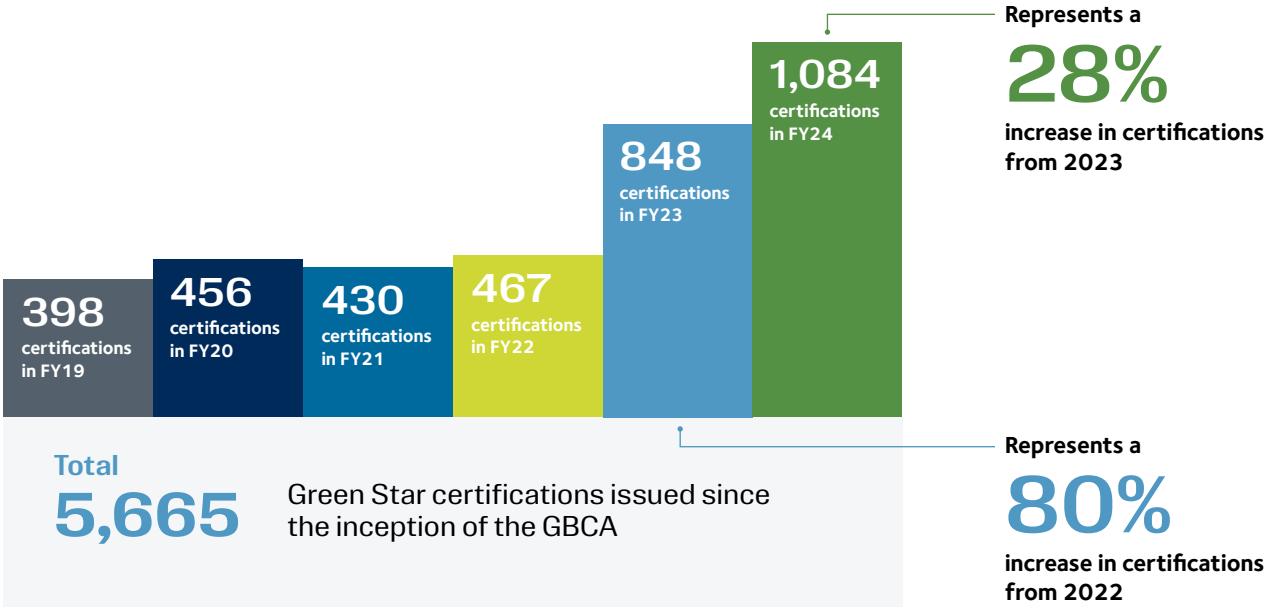

## Rating Tools on the horizon – Green Star Future Focus

In 2018, GBCA introduced Future Focus, an initiative aimed at updating the suite of Green Star Rating Tools to align with the future trends and challenges of the Australian construction sector.

Through extensive engagement with numerous experts and organisations, the program led to noteworthy revisions in the Green Star rating system. These revisions encompass a broader framework, heightened emphasis on social aspects, more stringent criteria for the highest rating, and an enhanced focus on carbon emission reduction.

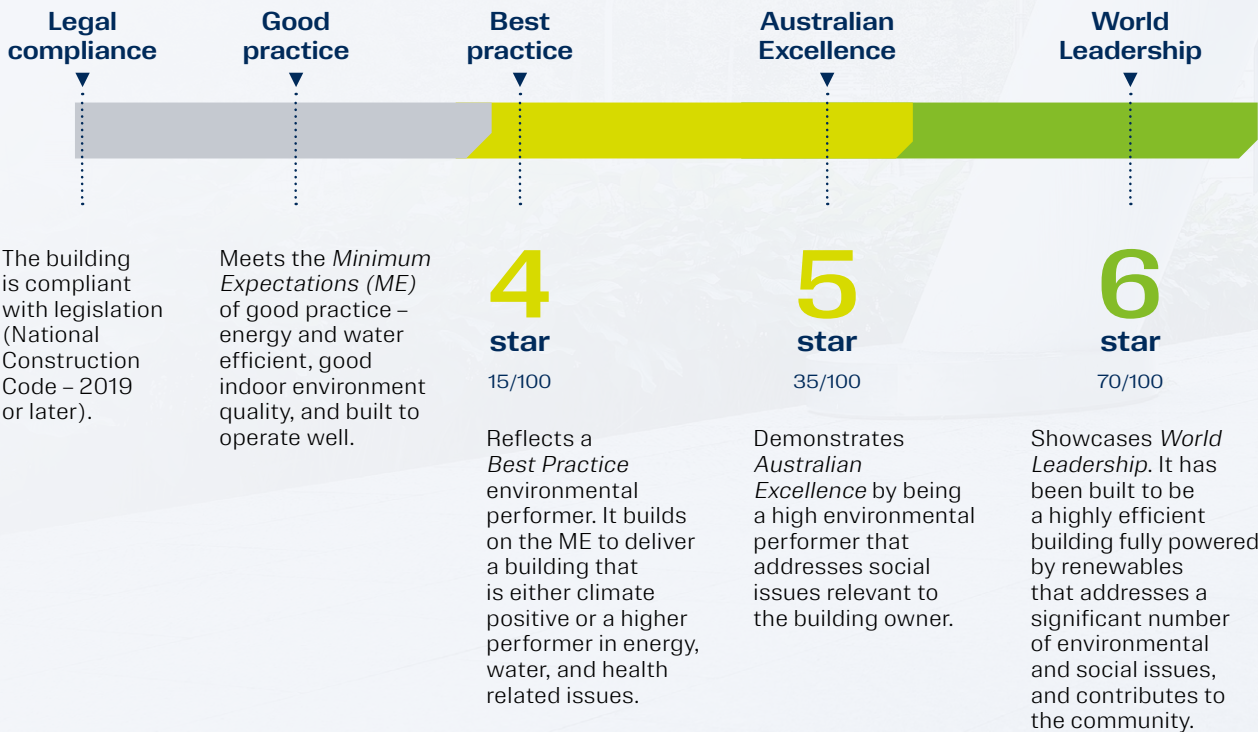
## Timeline overview



## Green Star Buildings Rating Scale

The Green Star rating is determined by comparing the percentage of available points achieved out of the 100 total available points.

The rating scale shown below details the percentage thresholds for the Star ratings awarded.



## Green Star Buildings – Categories and Credits

Green Star Buildings features **eight categories** representing the issues that will define the next decade of the built environment.

These categories enable owners and developers to act on the areas of sustainability that matter most, future proofing a building for the long term.

Each category contains **multiple credits**. A credit addresses an outcome that improves or has the potential to improve a project's sustainability performance.

Once all credits are assessed, the total number of points achieved is tallied, and the project is certified as either a 4, 5, or 6 Star rating.

✔ **Note:** The credits in bold and marked with a blue tick are those that Dulux and other brands can offer either product or other solution support toward achieving points.

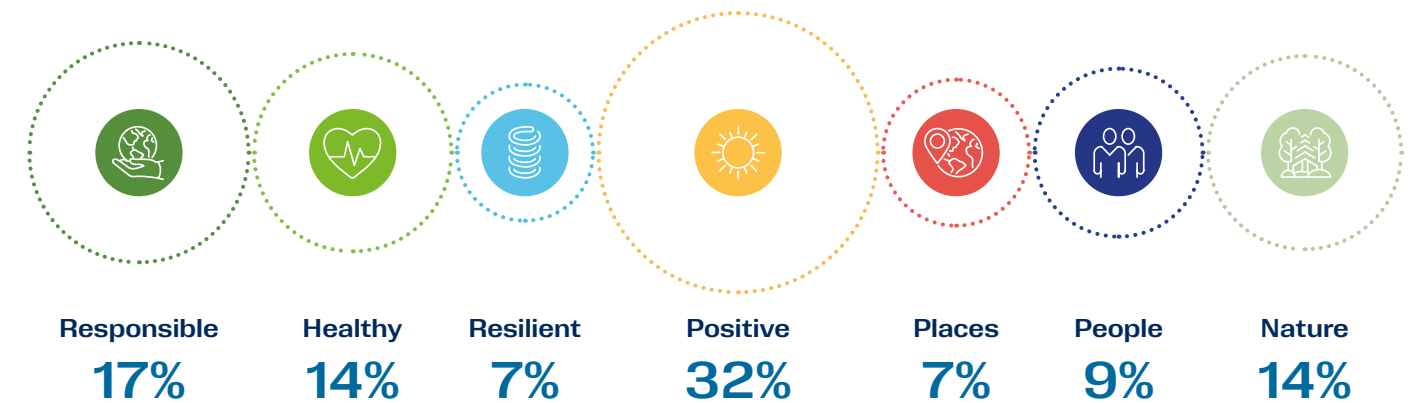

## Category weightings

A point in Green Star Buildings is equivalent throughout the rating tool. That is, a point in the *Positive* category is equivalent to a point in the *Nature* category.

**Higher reward (more points) are placed on credits within categories that deliver:**

- Guaranteed outcomes (e.g. more points awarded to delivery of physical attributes over processes).
- Larger impacts in terms of scale.
- Drive market transformation across industry.
- Long-lasting impacts (e.g. long-lasting building system over reliance on future operational maintenance).
- Value generation beyond the building owner.



## Leadership

Doesn't generally constitute part of the total percentage as it represents one-off or project-specific achievements.

## Achieving credits

**Credit:** a specific initiative with a clearly defined **outcome** within each category that improves or has the potential to improve a project's sustainability performance. Credits are weighted relative to one another by the varying number of points available.

# Responsible Products Program

With buildings and fitouts contributing to around 50% of resources used worldwide and about 10% of global greenhouse emissions, the GBCA seeks to reward the use of products that have lower environmental impact, are transparent, respect human rights, and reduce carbon content.

The Responsible Products Program recognises initiatives that certify products available for use in the built environment. GBCA relies on third party initiatives or product certification initiatives to assess the impact that a product has against five categories.



Initiatives are required to demonstrate compliance with the minimum expectations and a selection of the technical criteria. Once these have been met, an initiative will be recognised, and a Responsible Product Value will be awarded.

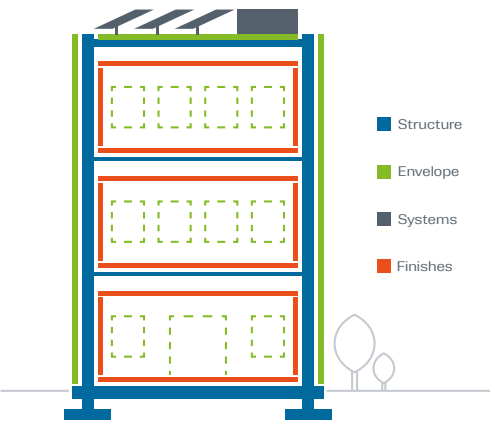
The Green Building Council of Australia assigns RPVs to initiatives and these are passed onto the products they recognise.

## What is a Responsible Product Value (RPV)?

A value calculated for a product based on the type and the number of third-party certifications that the product holds.

## What elements of the building do the Responsible Products credits cover in Green Star Buildings?

- Responsible Structure**  
Load bearing / stability components (e.g. steel, timber, concrete, stone and brick).
- Responsible Envelope**  
External shell-facade and its components (e.g. roofing, cladding, insulation and drywall).
- Responsible Systems**  
Active systems (e.g. mechanical, hydraulic, transportation, electrical and ventilation).
- Responsible Finishes**  
Internal finishes (e.g. flooring, plasterboard, paint, ceilings, partitions, doors and internal windows).

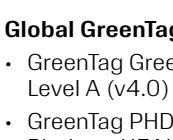

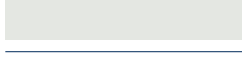
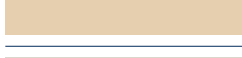

Heat Resilience

How Dulux can assist

Highly reflective facades can also form part of a heat resilience strategy. The exterior wall surface stays cooler and reduces the amount of heat conducted into the building. The paint and coatings layer of a façade contributes to the solar reflectivity and thermal emissivity of an exterior wall.

In general, lighter colours will have a higher solar reflectivity than darker colours and are often referred to as “cooling” colours. Solar absorptance is the opposite of solar reflectance and refers to the amount of solar energy absorbed by a surface. High reflectivity means lower absorptance of solar energy. Solar Absorptance is calculated as 1 minus Total Solar Reflectance. A highly reflective surface might have a reflectance of 0.85 or a solar absorptance of 0.15.

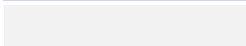
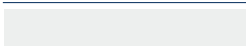
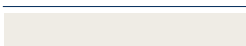
