

CURRENT STATUS

Iðunn H2 has secured the best possible site for hydrogen production in Iceland, at an industrial harbour with easy access to the future domestic market. The company has secured MoUs for power supply and is in dialogue with the appropriate parties for transmission and sustainable water supply. The project construction will be financed using a long-term offtake agreement with a reliable industrial-scale user of hydrogen in one of Iðunn H2's target offtake markets. To get there, **Iðunn H2** now seeks seed funding to finance project development costs.
