Council Decision Process

If card slot A is still empty, then place this chapter face-down on card slot B and don't read on!

A formal decision rule also comes with a need of voting rules. These define when and how to cast a vote and normally include rules about what part of the process is secret. Secrecy of (a part of) the decision process enhances the independence of those who vote.

All players receive their set of voting cards.

Council Decision Process

When the council takes decisions each council member must choose their option by secretly placing the corresponding voting card (A/ B/ C/ D/ Postpone/ Abstention) face down in front of them. Once everyone chose an option the cards are revealed and the votes counted.

Place this chapter face up on card slot B showing this card on top. This rule must now be applied during the decision sequence in the 3rd step "decision".
