THE ULTIMATE MONEY20/20 CHECKLIST TO PLAN YOUR TRIP

- Ensure you check entry requirements to the Netherlands and whether a Visa is needed for your trip.

- If you are new to the show or traveling solo and eager to meet fellow attendees search 'First Timer' in the App to join our dedicated meetup for first time attendees.
- In town early? Get ahead and collect your badge on Monday 1st June before the show opens (look out for the Badge Pick Up barcode email released a few days before the show, also available in the Connect App).
- Tell us if you have any special requirements by updating your preferences on your online pass registration form or by emailing accessibility@money2020.com - we're here to help!
- Share your experience on social media and connect with other delegates using the hashtag #Money20/20EU.
- Still need to secure your pass? Head to our pass picker page or you'll also have the option to purchase onsite.
