# Dear friends,

Thank you to all of you for your support and contributions toward making 2019 a year of outstanding accomplishments for the Calgary Stampede and for our community.

**We continue to strive toward our vision of creating a world-class, year-round gathering place. And, as we embark on the final five years of our 20-year Master Plan vision, our accomplishments over the past 15 years tell us clearly that we are on the right path to achieving our goals.**

This year, the Calgary Stampede established the foundation and direction that will allow us to fulfil our Master Plan vision through the launch of our 2020-2025 Strategic Plan. Our strategic objectives aim to continue strengthening relationships with our community partners and stakeholders, building our team, and building our youth as we embark on a \$500 million expansion of our convention centre. Thanks to the funding support from all three orders of government, this expansion will see the existing BMO Centre double in size and the city of Calgary transform into a tier one convention city and international destination for meetings and conventions.

The July 30, 2019 announcement of a joint partnership between The City of Calgary, Calgary Municipal Land Corporation (CMLC), Calgary Sports & Entertainment Corporation (CSEC) and the Stampede to construct an Event Centre on Stampede Park was a great day for Calgary. With the December 2019 finalization of that agreement, the BMO Centre Expansion and Event Centre developments are expected to attract billions of dollars of private investment for our community and will transform the district into a vibrant and uniquely authentic experience for local, national and international visitors, while supporting economic diversity for Calgary and southern Alberta.





In December 2019, the Stampede announced that a recent Conference Board of Canada review assessed the annual economic impact of Stampede activities in Alberta at \$540 million. This report was commissioned in advance of the BMO Centre Expansion as a benchmark to better understand the future benefits of that initiative. We are proud to share with our community partners and the broader community how the spirit and pride of our unique brand clearly resonates as an experience that people from around the world recognize and want to participate in both during Calgary's annual Stampede celebration and year-round. These numbers and economic impact will grow dramatically with the expansion of the BMO Centre into a tier one conference facility.

We would like to thank the Government of Alberta for its continued financial contribution to the Calgary Stampede. We appreciate the government's efforts towards addressing provincial debt, and we are appreciative that our provincial partner continues to recognize the importance of the Stampede's positive economic impact to the community.

The stories shared through this report represent many of our efforts over the past year to arrive at the positioning reflected by our 2020-2025 Strategic Plan, which depicts a definitive end state with the fulfillment of the Stampede's 20-year Master Plan vision. As we reflect on all of the accomplishments achieved to date towards the Master Plan, we recognize the many opportunities and advantages that will continue to be afforded by moving forward with an outward-looking approach and continuing to build our relationships with our government, sponsorship stakeholders and community partners.

Our strategic focuses over the past year have resulted in new programs, developments, and broader support of our community partners through participation and contributions at events across the city. # Creating a world-class, year-round gathering place

2019 marked the beginning of several key milestones for the Calgary Stampede, as we continue building our vision of creating a world-class, year-round gathering place for the community.



**With the support of all three orders of government and our partnership with Calgary Municipal Land Corporation (CMLC), construction is successfully underway on BMO Centre Hall F, the infrastructure that will lay the groundwork for the construction of the BMO Centre Expansion. Hall F has a target completion of June 2020, which means it will be operational for Stampede 2020.**

The BMO Centre Expansion is a project valued at \$500 million, scheduled to open for business in June 2024, and will see the city of Calgary emerge as a tier one convention city and a world-class destination for the meetings and conventions industry. Once complete, BMO Centre will be the second-largest meeting facility in Canada, helping position Calgary for economic growth and prosperity.

“This is a tremendous opportunity for growth and development in the city – one that comes after years of focused planning and eager anticipation,” said Dana Peers, President & Chairman of the Board of the Calgary Stampede. “The Calgary Stampede is extremely pleased with the project team now in place. Their success in leading projects of this magnitude not only makes them the right team to do this work, but we know they will help us deliver on our commitment to our community and continue to provide exceptional guest experiences.”

The BMO Centre Expansion is not the only exciting park development project happening on Stampede Park. Over the next four years, Stampede Park will transform as our 20-year Master Plan is fulfilled. As part of this transformation, Stampede Park is a component of the Rivers District Master Plan, a plan that will see Stampede Park and Stampede Trail support the creation of Calgary’s Culture and Entertainment District, which will attract local and international investment in our city. Through the completion of these important initiatives – along with the ambassadors we cultivate, the advocates we engage and the relationships we build – Calgary will grow into a first-class, international destination and a major contributor to the economic diversification of southern Alberta.

## Event Centre

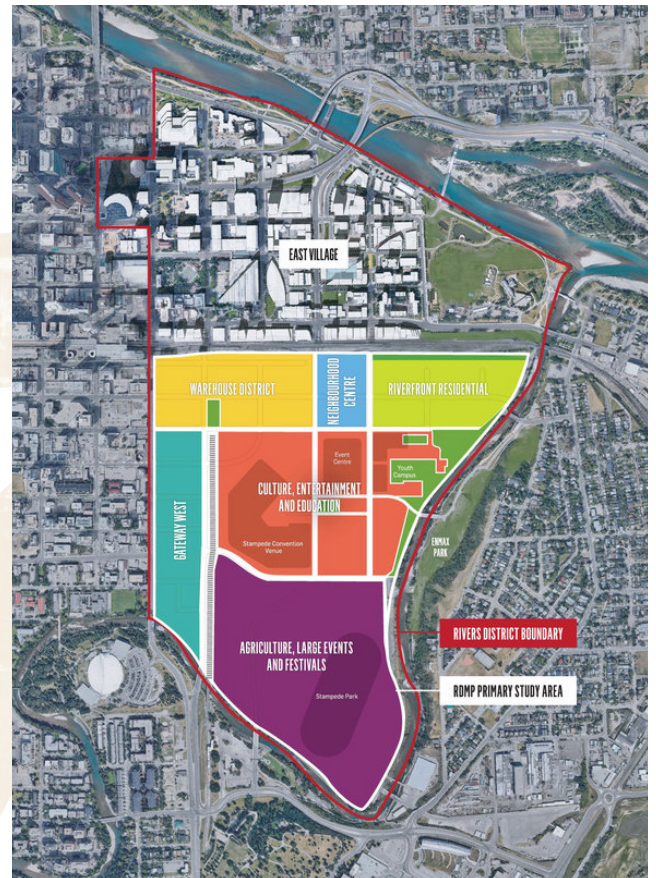
The new Event Centre and BMO Expansion will provide mutual support for each facility towards establishing Calgary as a tier one convention city and a world-class destination for meetings and conventions. While the Calgary Flames have been our neighbour on Stampede Park since 1980, we support the city’s vision for the development and prosperity of Calgary’s Culture and Entertainment District and a new Event Centre in a new location for the Calgary Flames to call home.

This year, the Calgary Stampede made an agreement with The City of Calgary and Calgary Sports & Entertainment Corporation to construct a new \$500 million Event Centre on Stampede Trail land. As part of the deal, the land that the Scotiabank Saddledome currently sits on will be exchanged with the Calgary Stampede for land just north of Stampede Park to construct a new Event Centre. This development, along with the BMO Centre Expansion, will afford the density and infrastructure for the emergence of Stampede Trail as a year-round entertainment,

## Enbridge Plaza and BURNCO Courtyard

July 4, 2019 marked the grand opening of Enbridge Plaza, just in time for us to play host to the World Association of Marching Show Bands (WAMSB) Championships during Stampede 2019. It's located in Youth Campus and will be used year-round to support campus programs and activities, including a permanent rehearsal space for the Calgary Stampede Showband and other community marching bands.

BURNCO Courtyard was also completed this year and adds to the picturesque campus built for the spirited citizens of tomorrow. BURNCO Courtyard is located just steps outside of Doherty Hall and is a tranquil outdoor space in the heart of Youth Campus.

## On the horizon ... SAM Centre

The SAM Centre development on the Stampede's Youth Campus will bring western heritage and culture to life with Stampede artifacts and immersive experiences that showcase the story behind the making of southern Alberta.

Construction is slated to begin in the fall of 2020. Diamond Schmitt Architects have been selected to undertake the architectural work for SAM Centre, in collaboration with local architecture firm, FAAS and Montreal-based Experience & Exhibit Designers, GSM. With their combined experience in cultural and museum projects, we know they will bring our vision for SAM Centre to life.

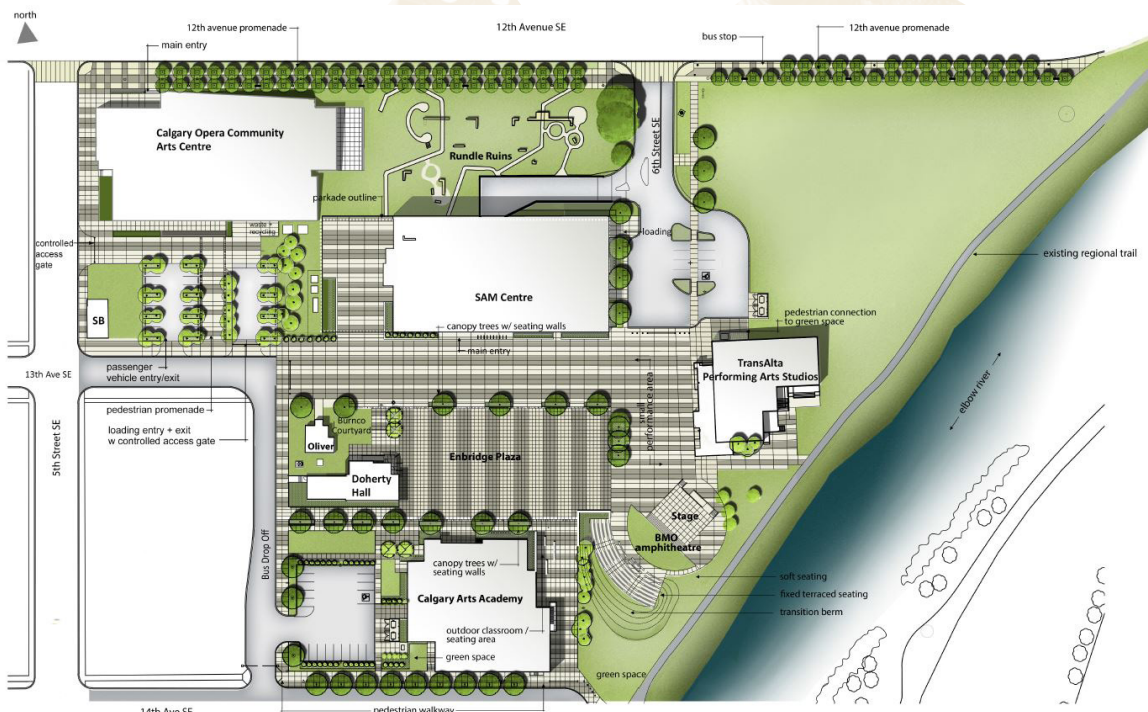

## Breathing new life into the No. 1 Legion

The Legion is a building that has been part of the historical landscape of our city for more than a century. In its prime it was a place of celebration and remembrance for our veterans and their families but, as the city changed, the interior of the No. 1 Legion remained the same. In 2018, Calgary Stampede volunteers had an idea that would breathe new life into this important community gathering space, and that idea came to life in 2019.

“This was a project close to the hearts of many Stampede volunteers, who wanted to give back to the Legion,” said Todd Hawkwood, Chair, Community Projects & Development (CPD). “It’s an important space in our community, and for many of our volunteers, it’s a home base during the 10 days of Stampede.”

The project, which involved refreshing and updating the interior of the main floor, had been in the works for the past few years. Both the municipal and provincial governments had to approve the project, due to the building’s historical designation.

In December of 2018 and into the first few months of 2019, volunteers from the CPD, Downtown Attractions, Historical and Public Art committees rolled up their sleeves and removed the old carpet on the main floor of the building. Stampede employees from the Park & Facilities department also pitched in to help out, as well as local interior designer, Sheila Wappel-McLean, who volunteered her expertise to the project. When the project was finished, the legion gleamed with fresh new

paint on the walls, new carpet, clean murals, and an organized and meaningful historical display.

“It was a big job, but it had to be done and it was great to see both volunteers and employees work together on such an important project,” said Brian Johnston, a member of the CPD committee and the Project Manager.

## **The Field of Crosses – a community initiative, celebrating and honouring our fallen soldiers**

The Field of Crosses is a unique community initiative that celebrates and honours southern Albertans who gave their lives to make our freedom possible. Every year, more than 3,600 white crosses line Memorial Drive to signify the ultimate sacrifice so many made fighting for the freedoms we enjoy today.

In its first year, there were only 340 crosses and, since then, it has become a nationally recognized memorial, growing with the support of the community and volunteers. The Field of Crosses is the inspiration of Calgary businessman and philanthropist, Murray McCann, who in 2018 took home a Western Legacy Award in the category of Sustained Contribution – Individual, which is awarded to an individual who has exhibited extraordinary community support over time.

This year, Stampede volunteers from the Community Projects & Development committee, with support from the Stampede's event volunteers, were honoured to help straighten the 3,600 crosses in preparation for daily sunrise ceremonies.

"This is a great community initiative that we felt honoured and compelled to be a part of; it's an opportunity to remember the fallen, while honouring all of those who have served our great country," says Todd Hawkwood, Chair, CPD committee.

## **The Downtown Attractions breakfast program brings Stampede spirit to classrooms!**

Each spring as the snow begins to melt, volunteers from the Downtown Attractions committee gear up to bring Stampede spirit to local elementary schools.

"We do our best to focus on areas where we can bring the community together. Sometimes it surprises us what a pancake breakfast, a couple of mascots and a little country music can do to bring people together," said Brian Reimer, Chair, Downtown Attractions.

The committee works to make sure that at least half of their school breakfasts are held at higher-needs schools, visiting a total of 14 schools per year. The program starts in May and runs until the end of the school year in June, with the cost of the breakfasts covered by the committee and its sponsor, Fluor.

This year the committee launched a new program with Fluor and Stampede School called Let's Talk Science.

"We piloted this initiative at four schools this year, with the goal of helping students learn about Stampede and the science behind agriculture," added Reimer. "It was a big success, and we are excited to expand the program in 2020."

## Stampede Park welcomes the 2019 Grey Cup Festival!

Stampede Park welcomed the community and the 2019 Grey Cup Festival, November 20 – 23.

The festival welcomed thousands, sparking excitement and igniting a sense of pride that could be felt throughout our city.

The Calgary Grey Cup committee has long been involved in the Grey Cup festivities, formed in 1948 by a group of passionate Calgarians. They boarded a train to Toronto to see their beloved Stampeders win their first Grey Cup and forever changed the festivities. A dozen horses, a chuckwagon and more than 250 western-dressed fans danced, paraded, celebrated and served pancakes, creating what is known today as the Grey Cup Festival.

We were thrilled to have this year's festival come to Stampede Park. Our volunteer committees also pitched in, displaying their western hospitality by hosting pancake breakfasts on Stampede Park each morning of the festival and participating in the events.

In addition, the Calgary Stampede Showband, along with Young Canadian member Lindsey Kelly, had the honour of performing the national anthem at the 107th Grey Cup game at McMahon Stadium on November 24, 2019.

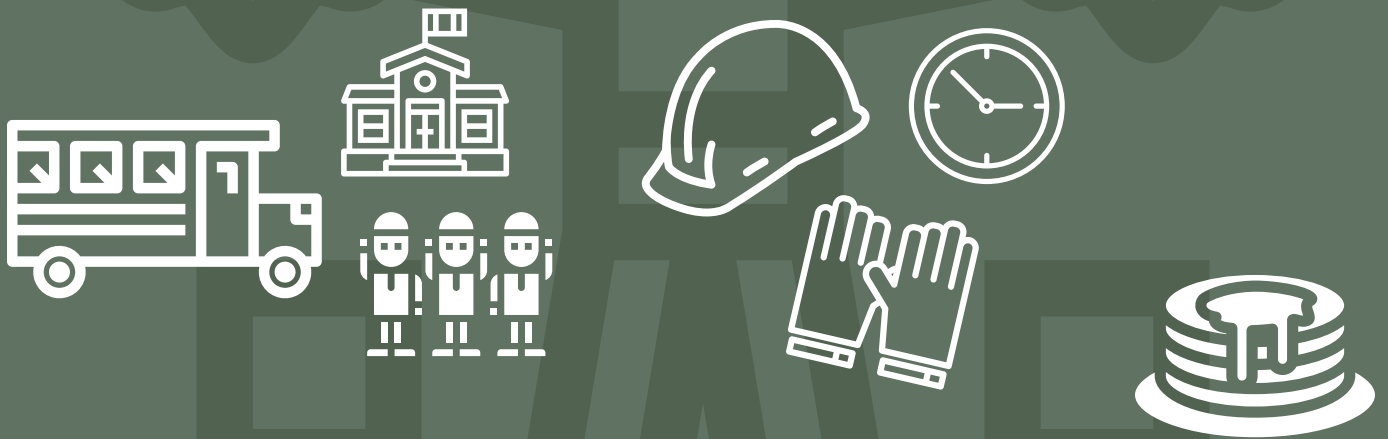
The Showband members and Lindsey arrived early the day before the big game to begin rehearsals.

# Building stronger youth and a stronger community

Our youth achievement and education programs are world-class, and through the Journey 2050, OH Ranch Education, Stampede School, Stampede Summer Camp and our performing arts programs, we are shaping talented ambassadors of our great city today and engaged spirited citizens for tomorrow.



**2019 was another year of resounding accomplishments and successful programming, where youth from both rural and urban communities came together to learn and grow alongside one another.**

### **Showband on the World Stage**

During Stampede 2019, Stampede Park played host to the 2019 World Association of Marching Showbands (WAMSB) World Championships. More than 20 marching showbands from around the world competed in competitions over the course of the first weekend of Stampede, including a Drumline Battle and feature performances each night. The top bands went head-to-head in the highly anticipated Championship Finals on Monday, July 8, with the Calgary Stampede Showband claiming the title of World Champion for the sixth time – a new record!

On New Year's Day, the Calgary Stampede Showband, along with the Showriders, marched the streets in Pasadena, California for the fourth time in the Tournament of Roses Parade.

"Performing live for more than 75 million people internationally was an opportunity that our members were eager to experience," said Ryan Hancock, Manager of Bands at the Calgary Stampede.

To prepare for the exciting performance, 180 members spent four months rehearsing in preparation for the 8.9 km parade route, nearly twice as long as the Calgary Stampede Parade route.

"We were fortunate enough to be one of 19 bands in the parade and the only Canadian musical entry. Our Showriders were also one of 18 equestrian entries and the only Canadian entry in that category as well," added Hancock.

Leading up to the Rose Bowl Parade, the Showband performed at Bandfest, an event hosted by the Tournament of Roses and REMO Inc. that allowed participating bands to showcase their performance skills. The Showband entertained the crowd with an upbeat performance that conveyed the community spirit of the Calgary Stampede. This performance allowed the Showband to showcase the musicianship and showmanship that led to them being invited to represent Canada at this prestigious event.

### **2019 Youth Poster Competition welcomes the first youth artist to create the Calgary Stampede Poster**

2019 was the first year an Albertan youth created the iconic Calgary Stampede poster through the Youth Poster Competition, the vision of Dana Peers, President & Chairman of the Board of the Calgary Stampede.

"We began this program in 2018, in search of the 2019 youth poster artist. We engaged youth from across Alberta in a unique learning and development opportunity to find and celebrate young artists and create the iconic Calgary Stampede poster and one of the largest art scholarships in Canada. I am proud to

say that the poster competition will continue past my presidency to include the 2021 and 2022 posters," said Peers.

Rebecca Shuttleworth was the talented young artist whose work was chosen for the 2019 poster, which saluted women in western culture. The inspiration came from a photograph captured by Samantha Callioux, a talented photographer.

"It captured the essence of women in western culture and the life I live on my family's farm and my roots," said Shuttleworth.

Young artists from across Alberta submitted their artwork and vision for the opportunity to become 2019 poster artist. From there, the top 30 were chosen to participate in a Masterclass and receive mentorship from local artists.

"The Masterclass was helpful, because not only did you receive critiques from a talented artist, but you got the chance to learn about all the things that are considered from a branding perspective when the poster is chosen and printed," said Shuttleworth.

The Youth Poster Competition will continue throughout 2020 – 2022.

## **Indigenous Youth Programming – building connections, while learning about First Nations traditions and cultures**

It's a Saturday afternoon and laughter echoes throughout the halls of Sweetgrass Lodge as Indigenous youth gather to make crafts, learn traditional First Nations dances and about the traditions and cultures of their ancestors. They are participants in the Calgary Stampede Foundation's Indigenous Youth program, which focuses on connecting Indigenous youth between the ages of 9-14 years old in a safe and inclusive space.

"This program is important because it provides opportunities for Indigenous youth to learn about the cultures and traditions of their ancestors, while forming connections with other Indigenous youth," says Stephanie Big Plume, Administrative Assistant, Indigenous Youth Program at the Calgary Stampede Foundation.

Not only has the program helped youth build connections, but it's a chance to learn from the facilitators, who are also First Nations, and gain insights from positive influential role models.

"For our facilitators, this program is extremely meaningful, as it allows them to make a positive impact on Indigenous youth," added Big Plume. "Personally, working with the facilitators and the participants has made me a better person and has taught me that hard work pays off. I know that we are making a difference in the lives of the youth who participate in the program and seeing the smiles on the kids' faces makes it worth it."

In 2019, more language components were added to the curriculum through traditional storytelling and illustration.

"The program has been an extremely rewarding experience for all involved, and we hope to continue to inspire Indigenous youth, provide them a safe space to learn about their cultures and help them grow into successful and capable community leaders of tomorrow," said Big Plume.



## Stampede School – facilitating student growth beyond a traditional classroom setting

Every year, students from both urban and rural communities board a yellow school bus with excitement as they embark on a five-day journey of learning and growth in a unique way.

As the school bus travels across the Saddledome Bridge and makes a right turn into Sweetgrass Lodge and the pristine setting of ENMAX Park, you can hear laughter and excitement.

One by one, the students get off the bus and meet their Stampede School educator for the week – Andrew Morrow.

“It’s always refreshing to see the excitement on the students’ faces on their first day,” he shares.

No, this is not a field trip, it’s a chance for students in Grades 1 to 12 to build on the curriculum they’re currently learning and apply it in different ways through inquiry-based learning, a technique that teaches students to problem solve and ask questions to seek answers.

“The classroom activities that we offer engage students in a different way and help develop character and community values, while connecting to what they are learning already in their regular classroom,” he adds.

Andrew works alongside the students’ teacher to make their five days on Stampede Park both impactful and enriching.

“We cover a variety of topics throughout their five days, including agriculture, the history of Calgary, First Nations culture, environmental stewardship, the Big Four Stampede founders and so much more,” said Morrow.

This year, some students examined their community through a performing arts lens, meeting Calgary Stampede Showband members and learning about making a difference and the impact they can have on their own community.

## OH Ranch Education – giving youth the opportunity to experience an authentic working ranch

The OH Ranch is an 8,000-acre working ranch, situated west of Longview, along the Highwood River. It was generously donated to the Calgary Stampede in 2012 by Bill Siebens and is one of the many historical ranches that make up the scenic landscape of southern Alberta.

The OH Ranch is a real working ranch, and students in the program get the opportunity to learn first-hand the inner workings of a cattle ranch, including ecosystem management, environmental stewardship, Alberta's history, herd management and more.

This year's new initiative consisted of introducing a teacher orientation as a regular part of the program. In April, 22 teachers participated in an orientation and had the chance to explore the ranch and work with an OH Ranch Educator to plan their upcoming visit with their classes.

## 4-H programs – bringing rural youth and agriculture to urban communities

Agriculture has been an important part of the Calgary Stampede since the late 1800s, before the first Stampede in 1912. Our roots stem from the agriculture community, which is why it's important to continue providing learning opportunities rich in agriculture and dynamic programming, while supporting youth to learn and grow with experiences that will enrich their lives.

As a proud supporter of 4-H clubs of Alberta, we were once again pleased to help bridge the gap between rural and urban youth by hosting both 4-H on Parade and the 4-H Rodeo at Stampede Park. At 4-H on Parade, youth have an opportunity to showcase and compete with the projects they have been working on, while 4-H Rodeo is a true celebration of the sport of rodeo, engaging youth to compete in events at their respective skill levels.

In recent years, the clinic portion of the 4-H Rodeo has been elevated by having youth learn from Canadian champions, who teach them the various rodeo events and skills required.

By providing youth with these unique experiences, we are helping build the agriculture industry's future leaders.

# Stampede 2019 highlights

We were proud to show off Calgary's unique sense of community spirit for 10 days of authentic and memorable experiences as we welcomed close to 1.3 million guests from throughout Canada and around the world as we hosted the 2019 edition of The Greatest Outdoor Show on Earth.



Calgary's annual Stampede celebration was one for the record books in 2019. New attendance records were set for the first Friday of Stampede – Parade Day – and on Tuesday – McDonald's Community Day. Overall, 1,275,465 guests attended Stampede 2019, which set a record for the second-highest attendance, next to the Centennial Stampede in 2012.

## Women in western culture

Women have played an important and prominent role in western culture throughout history and, for this reason, we decided to shine the spotlight on women in western culture and recognize their contributions.

It began with the Calgary Stampede Poster Competition and artist, Rebecca Shuttleworth, who was the first youth artist to create artwork for the Calgary Stampede poster. The inspiring piece of artwork not only depicted what it meant to be a modern woman in western culture, but Shuttleworth herself also had a fantastic story and roots in western culture, growing up on her family's farm just outside of Calgary.

Amber Marshall of CBC's hit TV drama, *Heartland*, was selected as the 2019 Calgary Stampede Parade Marshal. Amber was chosen not only for her portrayal of a devoted horsewoman on *Heartland*, but also for the authentic cowgirl lifestyle that she leads in her day-to-day life. Amber truly represents what it means to be a woman in western culture and is a genuine role model for youth.

So many other women were also celebrated at the 2019 Calgary Stampede, from the fierce Side Saddle Racers who returned again for Side Saddle Racing demonstrations during three nights of the Evening Show, to the talented competitors in Barrel Racing and the Cowboy Up Challenge, to our own Stampede Royalty, who are year-round ambassadors of western culture and values, and so much more.

## Record-breaking

During Coca-Cola IgNITES the Night on Monday, July 8, the famous Nik Wallenda took his daredevil high-wire act to the Calgary Stampede Midway. Spectators gathered below and couldn't keep their eyes off the sky as he began his 40-minute trek across the wire, stretching 1,703 feet from the Kids' Midway to Rotary House. Upon completion, Wallenda had officially broken the record for the longest unsupported urban high-wire walk, adding the Stampede Midway to the top of his impressive resume. Sixty Stampede volunteers and approximately 12 employees supported the record-breaking walk by holding the wire steady across the Midway. Wallenda also had daily performances on the Midway, thrilling audiences with high-wire walks and sway pole performances.



## A new name for a special Stampede gathering place dedicated to First Nations traditions and cultures

The Calgary Stampede has held a strong relationship with First Nations Treaty 7 People since the first Calgary Stampede in 1912, making 2019 the 107th year since the first camp gathered at the Calgary Stampede. 2019 also marked a moment in history, as it was the first year that the program went by its new name – Elbow River Camp – which was announced by Tipi Owner Michael Meguinis in the camp at the end of Stampede 2018.

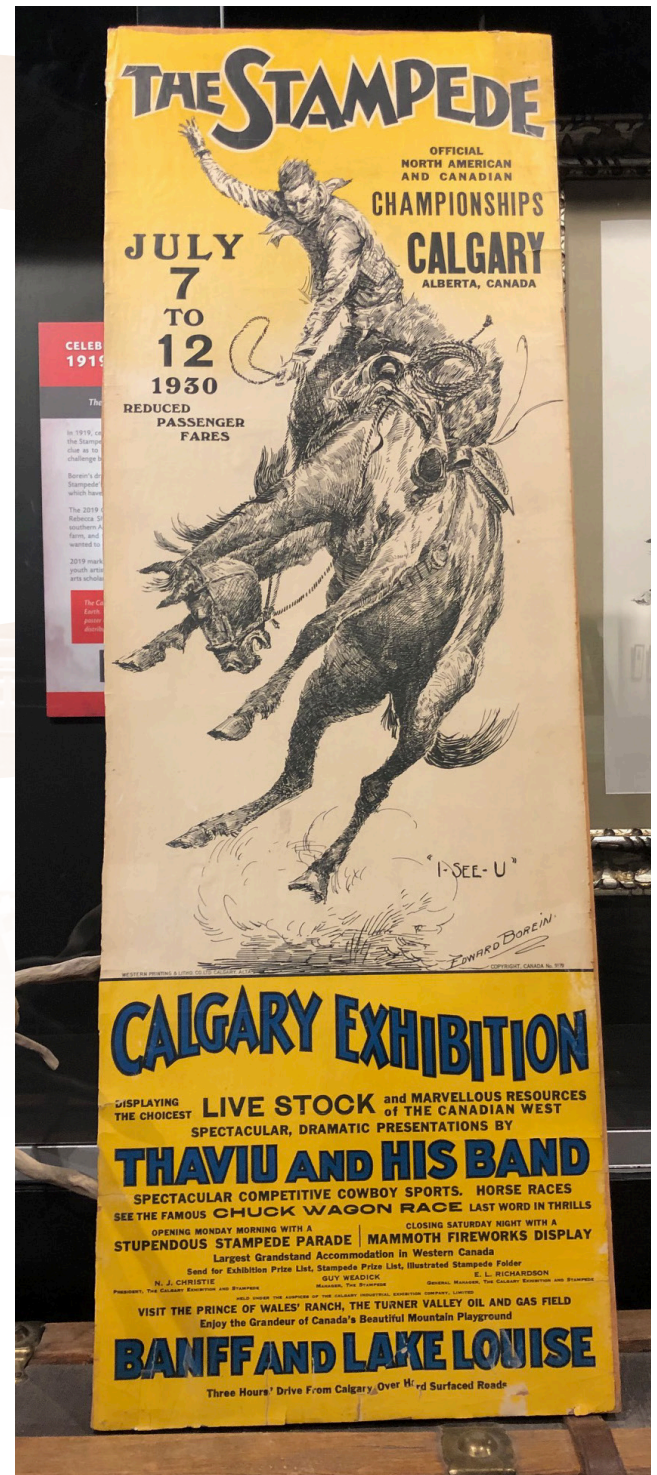

## Anniversary of the 1919 Victory Stampede

2019 also marked the Centennial celebration of the 1919 Victory Stampede, which brought the community together after the conclusion of the First World War. We were proud to commemorate this piece of Stampede and Canadian history in a number of ways.

On Sneak-A-Peek, Thursday, July 4, 2019, The Royal Canadian Mint unveiled a special, commemorative \$20 coin that paid tribute to the 1919 Victory Stampede and the First World War Canadian soldiers. We were honoured to host the unveiling ceremony on Stampede Park, with Brigadier General Stephen Lacroix, Commander, 3rd Canadian Division/Joint Task Force West and Ms. Michelle Grant, Victory Stampede Coin Designer, on hand.

To pay homage to the Victory Stampede, we were honoured to invite Brigadier General Stephen Lacroix, Commander, 3rd Canadian Division/Joint Task Force West to ride in the Parade with Amber Marshall as the 2019 Honorary Parade Marshal.

Also as a special surprise, one week before Stampede, one of the three missing Calgary Stampede Posters was found and generously donated to the Calgary Stampede Archives by Darlene and Bill Mowat. The 1930 poster was the last poster to feature I-See-U, a sketch by artist Edward Borein, showcasing a saddle bronc rider, mid-buck, which was the design famously first used on the 1919 Victory Stampede Poster.

## New and iconic

Every year, the Calgary Stampede looks to bring new experiences to guests, and 2019 was no exception. The new and iconic attractions helped bring close to 1.3 million guests to Stampede Park.

On Friday, July 12 and Saturday, July 13, rock n' roll met rodeo at the first-ever Bulls After Dark event on Stampede Park. The Nutrien Western Event Centre transformed into the Stampede's newest party destination, complete with musical entertainment, competitive bull riding, bull freestyling, strobe lights and indoor fireworks. This brand new, ticketed event proved to bring thrills to our guests, as both nights saw sold-out crowds.

The shopping space in BMO Centre was also reimagined in 2019, with the introduction of The Market, a dynamic retail and entertainment space, complete with mood lighting, adult and kid-friendly entertainment, photo stations, plenty of seating and unique retail offerings. For the first time, Stampede guests could also stock up on fresh, local produce at The Farmers Market, located right next to Kitchen Theatre.

The Stampede Corral also saw two new shows, in addition to the popular *Dog Bowl – Light Balance* and *Dundu Giants of Light*. From July 4 – 9, *Light Balance*, from the popular television show *America's Got Talent*, dazzled audiences with a mesmerizing dance and acrobatic performances, combined with hi-tech neon and LED light technology. *Dundu Giants of Light*, from the show *World's Best*, took over the Stampede Corral for the second half of Stampede, with their larger-than-life puppets of light and a pinch of imagination and magic.

The announcement by Infrastructure Canada in March as the final funding partner to the expansion of BMO Centre enabled construction to move forward in April, 2019.





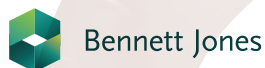

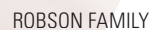
