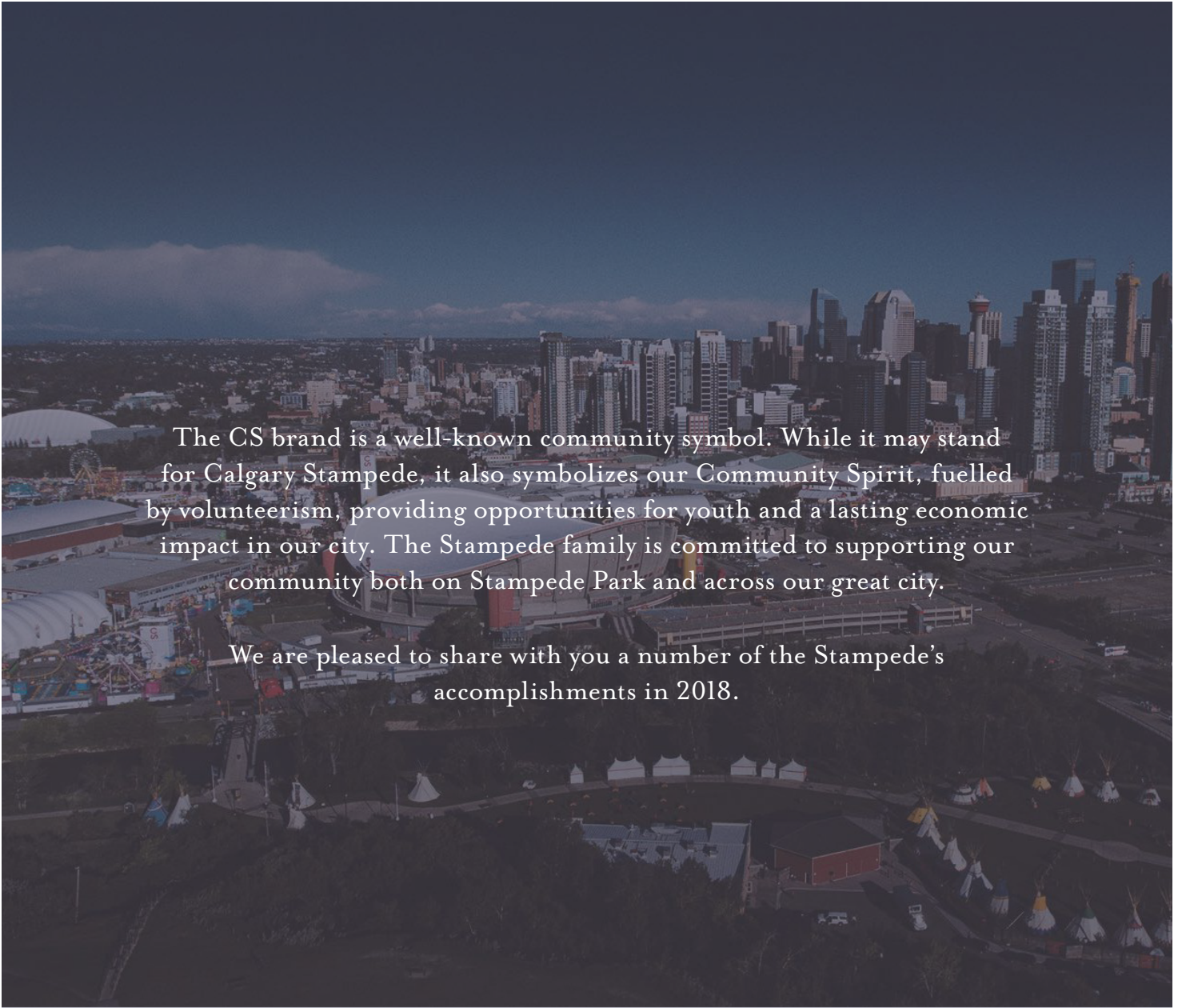

Thank you to all of you for your support and contributions toward making 2018 a year of outstanding accomplishments for the Calgary Stampede and for our community. We continue to strive toward our vision of creating a world-class, year-round gathering place, and as we embark on the final six years of our 20-year Master Plan vision, our accomplishments over the past three years tell us clearly that we are on the right path to achieving our goals.

This year, the Calgary Stampede embarked on the final year of its 2016-2018 Strategic Plan, a

plan that has reflected a theme of community spirit, both in the pursuit of strengthened relationships with our community partners and guests as well as in the efforts we have made to support a culture of enhanced collaboration for the Stampede team. Stampede 2018 was exemplary of what is possible when we come together – this Stampede was one of the most successful Stampedes in our history with the second highest attendance ever and guest experience ratings that tell us clearly that the Stampede experience is very special for all of our guests.

The stories shared through this report represent many of our efforts over the past year to fulfill the objectives of the 2016-2018 Strategic Plan. As we reflect on all of the accomplishments achieved through that plan, we recognize the many opportunities and advantages that will continue to be afforded by moving forward with the same strategic approach and direction. To this end, we will introduce a new Strategic Plan in 2019 that continues to focus on connecting with our community, building our team, building our youth, and building our vision as a means to achieving our Master Plan goals.



When we embarked on the 2016-2018 Strategic Plan, the city of Calgary was facing and continues to face challenging economic realities. *The proposed BMO Centre expansion* has been a key focus of the Stampede over the past three years and represents a foundational component of fulfilling our Master Plan vision. The BMO Centre expansion will bring new energy to our community by establishing Calgary as a tier one convention city, creating economic diversification for our region and international renown for our community. The fulfillment of the BMO Centre development will also provide the Stampede with the financial support needed to ensure the continued sustainability and growth of our year-round contributions to the community. On December 18, 2018, both the Government of Alberta and the City of Calgary confirmed their financial support for the BMO Centre expansion as a key infrastructural enhancement for southern Alberta, and we will continue our efforts to secure Federal Government funding for the project into 2019.

Our strategic focuses over the past three years have resulted in new programs, developments, and broader support of our community partners through participation and contributions at events across the city. These accomplishments were made possible because of the community spirit that exists among the Stampede's people, partners and friends.

While we are proud of the accomplishments reflected in this year's report, we are also proud of the many efforts that have been made over the past year to enhance the Stampede's volunteer infrastructure. These efforts are the behind-the-scenes work that has been done to make it possible for the Stampede to pursue its objectives to the next level. One of these accomplishments was the realignment of our agriculture and western events areas to provide strategic collaboration opportunities as a means to maintaining our commitment toward and enhancing our agriculture and western events offerings. We also upgraded our volunteer database in order to facilitate new ways to offer volunteer participation opportunities at the Stampede. These kind of accomplishments will provide a new foundation for the goals we set through our next strategic plan and for making possible many more stories to come.

We look forward to working with you as we continue to drive forward with new opportunities to support the prosperity our community, build the spirit of our great city, and grow our year-round gathering place.

# HIGHLIGHTS

## YOUTH PROGRAMMING

The Calgary Stampede in partnership with the Calgary Stampede Foundation, provides young people with opportunities to pursue their passions through programs like The Young Canadians School of Performing Arts, Calgary Stampede Showband, Band of Outriders and Calgary Stampede Showriders.

These programs teach valuable skills and allow the opportunity to perform around the world. In addition, students in our community have access to the modern Youth Campus – featuring indoor and outdoor classrooms, world-class training and performing spaces, TransAlta Performing Arts Studios and Calgary Arts Academy.

## 2019 Poster Competition



The Calgary Stampede Poster Competition, which began in 2018, is one of the largest arts scholarships in Canada with \$20,000 distributed among the top eight finalists.

Young Albertans were invited to enter for their chance to create the 2019 Stampede Poster art and participate in a youth achievement opportunity of a lifetime. Successful applicants participated in hands-on learning and development experiences, which included one-on-one time spent with local western artists and mentors.

The Poster Competition is about more than the selection of a poster for the Calgary Stampede; the competition focuses on youth achievement and development by fostering and developing artistic skills. This program takes youth on a journey of craftsmanship and creation, an experience just as valuable as claiming the top prize.

## Youth Indigenous Programming

Five new Indigenous Youth Program days, presented by the Calgary Stampede Foundation, welcomed youth from surrounding areas. Participants gathered in Sweetgrass Lodge in ENMAX Park to explore their cultures, build new relationships and, most importantly, have fun.

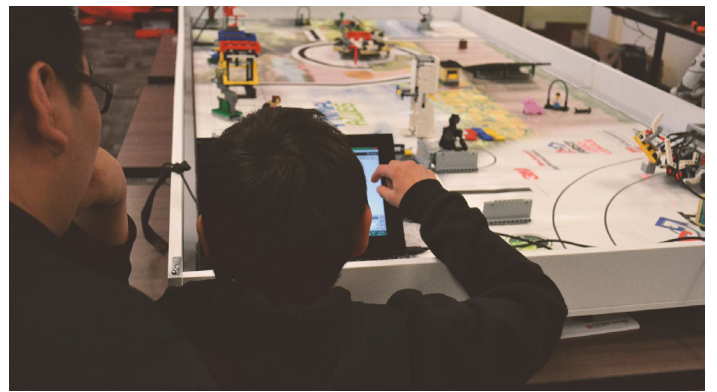
The program days were all led by several Indigenous facilitators from various backgrounds and specialties. The facilitators' roles in the community gave participants a way to believe in the possibilities of their future while feeling inspired to follow their dreams. The facilitation team shared traditional teachings through fun and interactive games, while engaging participants using dance, art, robotics and more.

*"I was so very blessed to grow up with my family and learn about my culture, but so many Indigenous children didn't. A lot of my friends who [were Indigenous but didn't grow up in an Indigenous family] asked so many questions about their culture and what everything meant - like why we smudged and why it was just as important to give back just as much as you take. If there [were Indigenous Youth Programs], or people who actively went out of their way to explain why the recognition of culture is so important, I think it would have made a real transformation."*

The Indigenous Youth Programming days were created in part by a generous donation from Mel Benson to the Calgary Stampede Foundation. Benson is president of Mel E. Benson Management Services Inc. an

international consulting firm working in various countries with a focus on First Nations/Corporate negotiations, and is a member of Beaver Lake Cree Nation, located in northeastern Alberta. He is a member of several charitable organizations and prides himself on being active in his community.

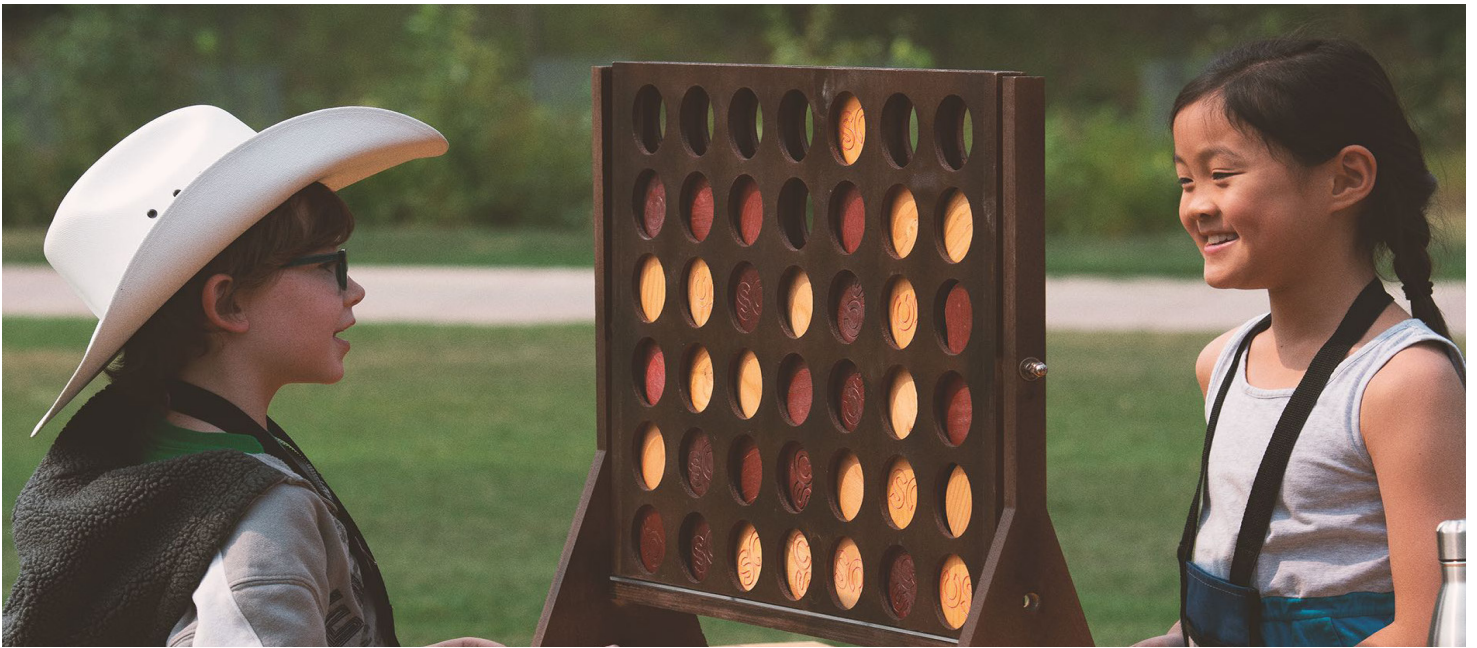

## Calgary Stampede Foundation Summer Camps

Youth explored Rodeo and Chuckwagon artifacts, met First Nations' leaders, took part in Blackfoot hand games, and built a tipi together. They also worked with local western artists to create their own masterpieces and show their Stampede spirit.

Students came together to participate in sport and food related activities. Through partnerships with Nutrition Students Teachers Exercising with Parents (NSTEP) and Stampede Catering, students learned about food preparation and nutrition, while experiencing common local foods as well as foods from around the world. Students also had fun playing sports including hockey and soccer.

The Summer Camps were held in collaboration with the Centre for Newcomers, CS Indigenous Youth programs and its partners to welcome and reach community members from various backgrounds.



In August 2018, the Calgary Stampede Foundation welcomed students from grades three to six to Stampede Park for a brand new summer camp initiative. The summer camps were for young community members to experience an engaging and interactive learning opportunity. Summer camp participants felt a sense of belonging, had an opportunity to learn about First Nations, Alberta, Stampede history, and foster citizenship and community values.

## WESTERN HERITAGE

The Calgary Stampede is a broader experience for our community with both new and expanded urban and rural programming. The annual Stampede and our year-round community celebrations reflect our agricultural roots, western values and the cultural identity of Calgarians.

### Elbow River Camp

On Sunday, July 15, the Tipi Owners of Indian Village and the Calgary Stampede announced the joint decision to change the name of Indian Village to Elbow River Camp. For the past 106 years, Indian Village has

been a place and a name with great historical significance. For many of the participants, it honours the relationship of the Tipi Owners with the Stampede and Guy Weadick from the very beginning.

How was the new name selected? Even though the languages of the five nations of Treaty 7 differ, one thing has always been consistent: the site is referred to as the Elbow.

For generations, when tipi owning families came to the Stampede, they would point to their elbow to communicate where they were going. In Dene, Stoney and Blackfoot the word for Calgary refers to the bend in the Elbow River – the elbow.

This new change also brought the renaming of the first, First Nations Princess, Cieran Starlight.

## 2018 Western Legacy Awards Chairman's Award

On Tuesday, November 20, three dedicated community members, one inspiring community group and a special relationship were honoured at the 14th annual Western Legacy Awards on Stampede Park.

The presentation of the Chairman's Award by David Sibbald honoured the long-standing relationship between tipi holding families from Treaty 7 nations in Elbow River Camp and the Calgary Stampede. This is only the fourth time this unique award has been presented since the awards began in 2005.

The 2018 Chairman's Award recognized family members – past, present and future – for their significant contributions to the legacy and treasured partnership that allows us to gather together and celebrate at Elbow River Camp.

Since 1912, this unique partnership has been built upon a shared dedication to preserving and promoting western heritage and cultures and sharing them with visitors from around the world.

The prestigious Chairman's Award highlighted the many contributions of tipi holding families to the success of Elbow River Camp and acknowledged their hard work and dedication over multiple generations.

## Agriculture Zone, presented by McDonald's

From showcases to competitions, the Agriculture Zone presented by McDonald's was a go-to for many families that visited Stampede Park and provided not only an educational but also an exciting experience that cannot be replicated anywhere else.

During Stampede 2018, guests were able to experience the Calgary Stampede's Agriculture Zone in a whole new way. For the first time, all agriculture programming was showcased at the state-of-the-art Nutrien Western Event Centre with day-long and evening programming that offered guests an immersive agricultural experience.







## PARK DEVELOPMENT

The Calgary Stampede continues to build our vision as we develop Stampede Park. Creating expanded infrastructure and a central gathering place for Calgary and southern Alberta. We continue to move forward with the development of Youth Campus projects, with many completed and activated, in addition to the overall Master Plan. Developing Stampede Park, means diversifying the economy for our city and our community.

## Rivers District Master Plan



The Calgary Stampede has embarked on an exciting project in partnership with the Calgary Municipal Land Corporation (CMLC) called the Rivers District Master Plan. The Rivers District Master Plan will connect our planning efforts to the larger community in the years to come.

In 2018 we worked with CMLC to engage community members across the city to listen to their feedback on the plan, find out what matters most to them and share the vision for this new mixed-use development.

The Rivers District Master Plan includes Stampede Park and the BMO Centre expansion initiative and has long stood as the city's entertainment epicentre. CMLC imagines east Victoria Park as a vibrant, high-density, mixed-use community that draws on the spirit of entertainment that resides in its DNA, as well as its natural surroundings. Some of the Rivers District Master Plan's most important goals are integrating the existing urban fabric - including several heritage buildings, Stampede Park and the Elbow River - and reshaping east Victoria Park as an active, walkable, accessible community with enhanced connections to adjacent neighbourhoods.

## Doherty Hall

The Calgary Stampede Foundation, along with the Doherty family, the Government of Canada and the Government of Alberta proudly opened the doors to Doherty Hall in fall of 2018.

Doherty Hall is the most recent addition to Stampede Park, and is envisioned to be a hub of professional arts activity and educational training.

Doherty Hall is a heritage replica of Westbourne Church, which honours the history and contributions of Calgary's early communities. With special care some historical materials, most notably the brick cladding, were restored to their original state and incorporated into the replica building.

Artists at all levels and disciplines will come together in an inspiring, inclusive and creative environment where they can create, explore and enjoy arts and culture. Doherty Hall has been specifically designed to showcase a broad range of disciplines and engagement types; it will accommodate workshops, rehearsals, musical performances, art exhibitions and more.

## The Big Four Roadhouse

In 2018, the Stampede's Big Four was transformed into the Big Four Roadhouse, a new event venue that offers a unique experience for our community's celebrations.

At one time, the venue boasted being the world's largest curling rink. It also spent time as a casino. The Big Four is a building with many stories to tell and the legacy will live on as a perfect venue to enjoy live music and events year round, including special programming during the Stampede festival.

The Big Four Roadhouse features 60,000 sq. ft., a permanent stage, built-in bars, capacity for up to 4,000 people and a state-of-the-art in-house sound and lighting system.

With the Canadian Finals Rodeo (CFR) moving from Edmonton to Red Deer for the first time this November, fans, athletes and organizers experienced the 45-year-old event in a whole new way. One thing that didn't change was the strong contingent of Calgary Stampede bucking horses and bulls selected by the cowboys of the Canadian Professional Rodeo Association to compete in Red Deer October 30-November 4. Two Bareback horses each captured a trophy buckle for go-round wins, while one Saddle Bronc also earned the honour.

The City of Calgary is a long-time partner of the Calgary Stampede. Along with

providing our 100-year lease and support for our credit facilities, collaboration furthers outreach into the community to enhance initiatives from year-round civic events and celebrations to our annual 10-day celebration. Various programs and initiatives at Stampede Park and across the city engage citizens year-round, contributing to the cultural, social and economic well-being of the greater community. As well, City Council approved a commitment to fund one third of the BMO Centre Expansion project.



## The Government of Alberta

The Government of Alberta, through Alberta Culture and Tourism, support a number of Stampede programs and facilities through an operating grant of \$7.674 million. This support helped: create opportunities for youth to learn about agriculture and sustainability through programs like OH Ranch and Stampede School; entice visitors from around the world to experience iconic events like the 50th Anniversary of the Grandstand Show, our signature rodeo and chuckwagon races, agriculture demonstrations and competitions and First Nations culture presentations; and enable 2,500 volunteers to contribute their time and talent to share community spirit year-round through the city and southern Alberta. As well, \$250,000 was specifically directed to enhanced security and safety on Park for the 1.2 million guests during Stampede through the redesign of the main gates and perimeter access points.

And on December 18, 2018, the Province of Alberta announced support for the BMO Centre Expansion project as a one third funding partner.



## The Government of Canada

The Government of Canada, through Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada's AgriMarketing program, committed \$29,540 to enhance our international agriculture initiatives including business to business engagement, publication and distribution of Profile magazine, and showcasing Canadian producers and practices. The Canada Alberta Job Grant (CAJG) and Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ) programs contributed \$70,541 and \$7,419 to enable additional employment opportunities to support activities year-round and for Stampede 2018.

In the Dene language of Tsuut'ina, Cieran's name is ʔikoeza Tsik'a, or Spirit Woman. Her parents are Anthony and Frances Starlight, tipi holders in Elbow River Camp.

### Sharing a Beat

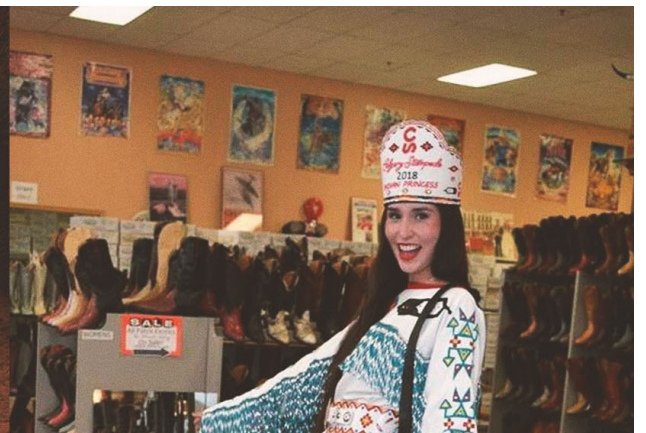
This year, the Stampede collaborated with the University of Calgary to hold their annual Campfire Chat at ENMAX Park on National Indigenous Peoples Day. Cieran performed and was part of a panel during which she shared her experiences growing up in a tipi holding family in Elbow River Camp. She also spoke about challenges she faced as she pursued her creative passions, switching schools and starting at the Alberta University of the Arts to develop her artistic skills. Her message to youth attending was very clear: don't let anything stop you from pursuing your dreams. Later, when she performed a fancy dance, a young girl from the audience began to dance and wander close to Cieran. In response, Cieran changed her steps to dance with the child, whose smile quickly widened ear-to-ear. The shared dance demonstrated all that Cieran had just spoke about and provided a collective heartwarming moment at the event.

### Fancy Dancing at the Brandenburg Gate

ITB Berlin is the world's leading travel trade show, with approximately 180,000 people attending each year. Stampede Royalty was once again fortunate enough to attend in 2018. While there, Cieran met people from around the world and shared the stories of Elbow River Camp and the historic relationship between the Stampede and the tipi-owning families of Elbow River Camp. As a special highlight this year, Cieran was selected for an additional performance. In an event planned to highlight Indigenous cultures of Canada, Cieran joined two other Indigenous dancers from other parts of Canada to dance under the Brandenburg Gate. There, many people stopped to enjoy the performance and meet the dancers afterward. It was a once-in-a-lifetime experience for Cieran.

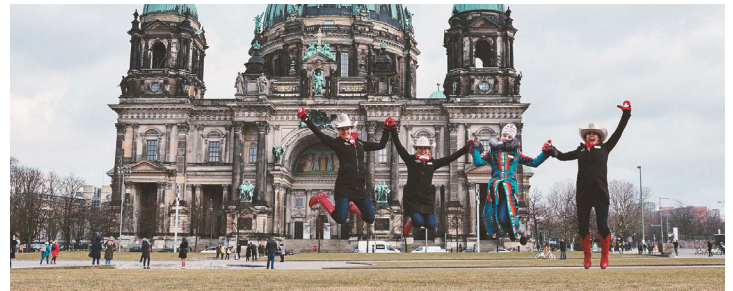
### Inspiring Youth

Throughout her reign, Cieran connected with thousands of young people across southern Alberta. She has four brothers and two sisters and her passion for engaging youth was a mainstay of her platform. She visited classes in Stampede School, answering questions about her regalia, what life is like as part of a tipi owning family at the Stampede, and about Treaty 7 First Nations cultures. She travelled to Kainai nation to present prize belt buckles to youth participants in the A'sitapiiks Rodeo Club, encouraging them to keep working hard as young rodeo athletes. Cieran also led a session in the Calgary Stampede Foundation's Indigenous Youth Program in which young participants were asked to create art that showed what they thought an ideal future world would be. The participants were inspired to see First Nations Princess Cieran Starlight sharing her artistic talents with them and it was a day that no one would soon forget.
