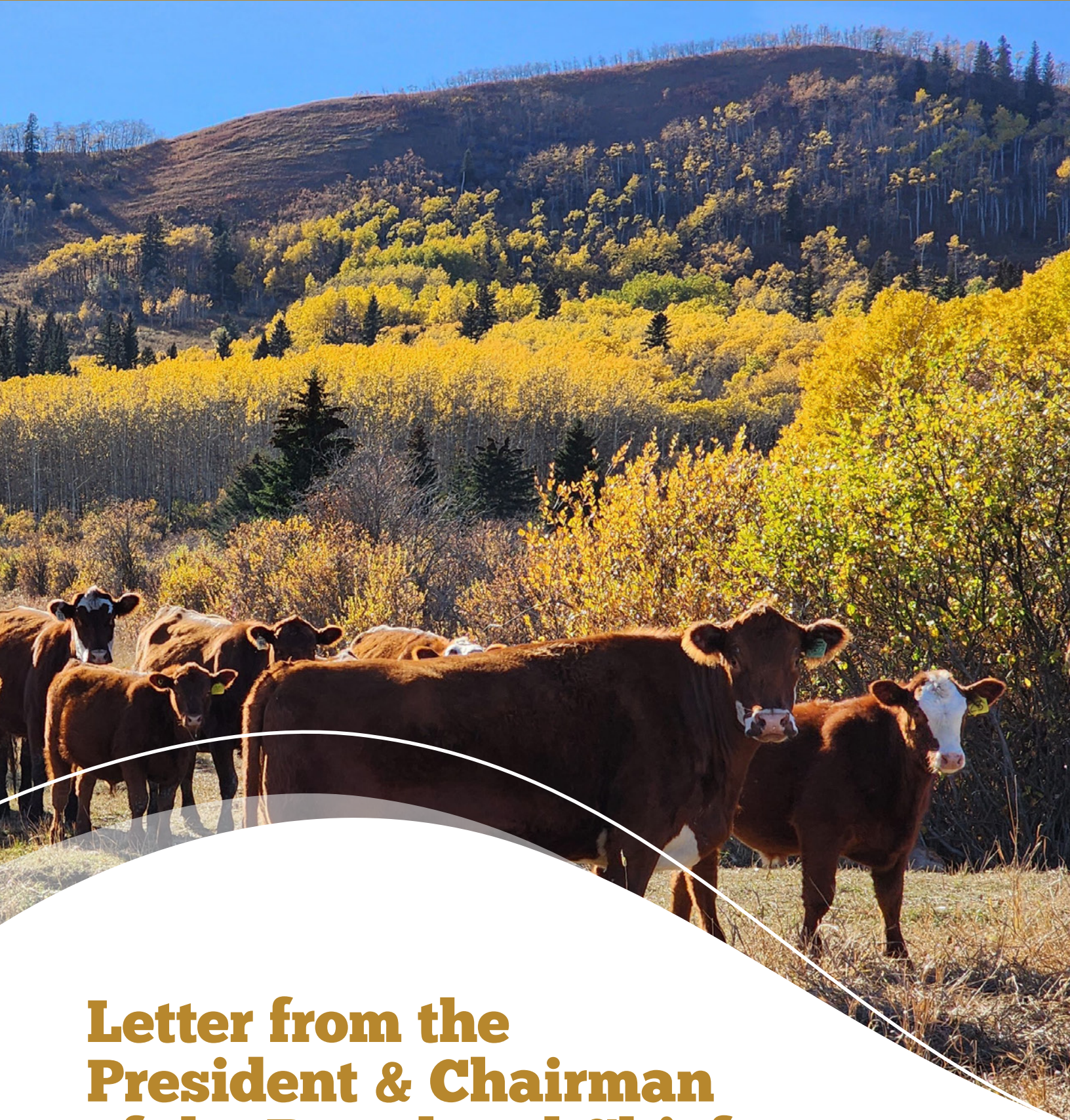

Report to the Community



Letter from the President & Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer

2022 was a year of many great accomplishments, especially after starting off with a bit of uncertainty.

As we kicked off the new year in January, we did so with volunteers conducting virtual committee meetings and many employees working from home. Fast forward five months from then, we welcomed our community back to Stampede Park with the first full Stampede in three years, a huge feat in itself.

Stampede 2022 was about welcoming the community back to Stampede Park, and bringing everyone Together Again – and together we achieved that. Across the 10 days of our annual celebration, we were joined by more than 1.2 million guests from around southern Alberta and the world. We provided a welcomed boost to the local economy, filling hotel rooms, restaurants, local businesses and more.

Beyond Stampede 2022, we hosted many major events on Stampede Park this past year. All of these fantastic year-round events are just a few of the things that contribute towards making Stampede Park a world-class gathering place for our community. We also hosted and took part in a number of Agriculture and Western Events, and continued creating stronger youth for a stronger community through our Youth Programs throughout the year.

Together we accomplished a lot in 2022 – and everything we accomplished would not have happened without the hard work and dedication of our volunteers and employees. Our Stampede family once again went above and beyond while the organization worked to stabilize and rebuild toward recovery from the pandemic impacts that began in March of 2020 and led to the first cancellation of the annual Stampede festival in more than 100 years.

This will be a multi-year road to recovery, but one that will prioritize taking care of our people, our Park, our community and our debt. A successful Stampede 2022 paved the way for this road to recovery, but it is important that we remain financially prudent, while still investing in our people and our tangible assets. It will take a number of years to recover, but we are on track with great optimism. We recognize from the excitement of Stampede 2022 that our community is anxious to experience the joy of gathering together again to create memorable experiences and to take in the unique adventure of the Stampede's iconic celebrations.

And of course, we have much to look forward to over the next few years with our exciting Stampede Park Development projects, which will further solidify the Calgary Stampede as a world-class, year-round gathering place for our community.

In October 2022, we put shovels in the ground, officially starting construction on SAM Centre, which will open in 2024, sharing the Stampede's stories and history with guests year-round. The Victoria Park Stampede Station also underwent major construction, with a temporary platform opening to make way for greater work on the project. The new station and extension of 17 Avenue will create an important connection between Stampede Park and Calgary's Beltline and Downtown communities, creating a key gateway to Stampede Park. In November 2022, the final steel beam was placed in the BMO Centre expansion project, completing the building's steel structure. This \$500 million project, which will see the BMO Centre become Western Canada's largest convention centre, remains on time and on budget, with doors opening in June of 2024. And in December, we announced the development of a Convention Centre Hotel on Stampede Park to complement our world-class BMO Centre expansion project.

There is truly no shortage of accomplishments we've achieved over the past year, and it is with sincere gratitude that we thank our government partners for the financial assistance as recognized on page 33 of this report.

We move forward into 2023 with great momentum and sizeable progress toward achieving our vision and look forward to continuing this progress for years to come.

A Gathering Place For the Community Taking Shape

From renderings to groundbreakings to steel beams, the future is taking shape on Stampede Park.

BMO Centre at Stampede Park Reaches Structural Steel Milestone

Along with our development partners at Calgary Municipal Land Corporation (CMLC), we marked a milestone as the final 90 ft. piece of steel was set into place on the BMO Centre expansion's steel structure in November. In just 11 short months, crews installed 9,000 metric tonnes of steel to form the structure of the BMO Centre's 565,000 sq. ft. expansion, which now stands taller than GMC Stadium and Saddledome on Stampede Park.

The \$500M expansion – generously funded in equal parts by the Government of Canada, the Government of Alberta and The City of Calgary – will double the centre's capacity for conferences, meetings and events. With more than 100,000 sq. ft. of new exhibition space, 38 new meeting rooms, two new ballrooms totaling 70,000 sq. ft., and a dramatic central gathering space anchored by Canada's largest indoor fireplace, the BMO Centre will be a state-of-the-art venue that showcases the best in both technology and western hospitality.

"This is an incredible milestone on a key project that will help the Calgary Stampede welcome the world – and our community – in 2024 and beyond," said Joel Cowley, Chief Executive Officer, Calgary Stampede.

With the structural steel complete, crews will now turn their attention to completing the building envelope and making the structure weather tight, while progressing inside the building to install drywall, elevators, escalators, electrical and mechanical systems and finishings. The BMO Centre expansion will officially open in June 2024.

BMO Centre Expansion

Supporting a World-Class Convention Centre with a World-Class Hotel

In partnership with the Calgary Municipal Land Corporation (CMLC) the Calgary Stampede announced a joint partnership for the development of a new convention centre hotel that will complement the dramatic expansion of the BMO Centre in early December.

The partnership, with full-service private real estate development company Matthews Southwest Hospitality (MSWH), will create the first hotel at Stampede Park and will connect an expected 220+ rooms directly to Western Canada's largest convention venue. Matthews Southwest Hospitality brings deep experience in hotel development befitting the world-class convention venue it will sit adjacent to.

The hotel site, a 31,000 sq. ft. parcel on the southwest intersection of Stampede Trail and 12 Avenue SE, is in a prime location in **The Culture + Entertainment District**, at the north entrance to Stampede Park and just steps away from the expanded BMO Centre, the Saddledome, Cowboys Casino and dozens of restaurants and retailers. The BMO Centre Convention Hotel will also front the redeveloped Stampede Trail, which, when completed in 2024, will serve as a vibrant retail and commercial corridor, a multi-modal connector and, for special events, a pedestrian-only space.

The hotel is being planned as a 4-4.5 diamond boutique lifestyle hotel with a minimum of 220 rooms, four food and beverage offerings and expanded amenities including a fitness centre and 11,000 sq. ft. of meeting space to support the needs of convention goers and visitors alike. The prime site also allows for the hotel to be developed with direct

interior connection into the BMO Centre. Matthews Southwest Hospitality has partnered with award-winning hospitality design architectural firm Nunzio Marc DeSantis Architects to design the hotel.

Moving forward on the approximately \$80 million development, the team will advance the project into the design, financing and permitting phases. As part of that process, a hotel brand flag will be selected. Construction on the hotel is anticipated to begin in 2024.

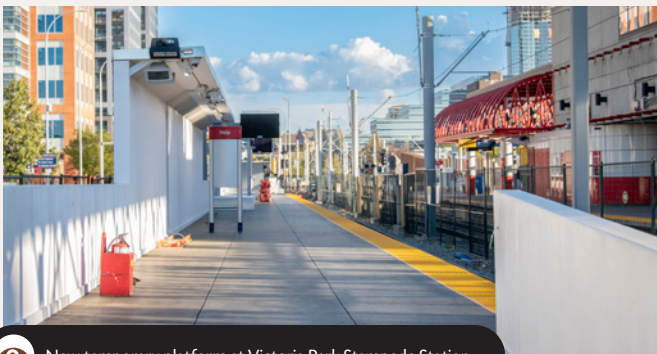

Creating a Key Gateway - 17 Avenue Expansion & Stampede Station Rebuild

It has been 40 years since our community has been able to access Stampede Park directly from 17 Ave. Once the main entry point to the annual Stampede, it will again open to both pedestrian and vehicle traffic as we continue to work with our development partners at CMLC on the exciting 17 Ave extension and Victoria Park/Stampede Station rebuild.

Demolition of the old Victoria Park/Stampede Station took place in 2022, and crews have started construction on the new, modern and more accessible station, which will be operational in late 2023.

The Victoria Park/Stampede Station rebuild will help provide a key gateway to Stampede Park as we prepare to welcome the world with the completion of the 17 Ave extension and BMO Centre expansion in 2024.

SAM Centre - Building the Future, Celebrating the Past

With a rich history that spans more than 100 years, there are thousands of stories of the Calgary Stampede that are waiting to be shared. The Calgary Stampede Foundation, together with the Calgary Stampede, marked a milestone as we broke ground in July on SAM Centre – a new destination that will share Stampede’s stories of culture and spirit, immersing visitors in the extraordinary peoples, cultures, histories, knowledge and artifacts that have shaped not only the history of the Stampede, but Calgary and southern Alberta. SAM Centre is currently under construction, with the building foundations already complete.


Building the future while celebrating the past, SAM Centre will bring Stampede stories to life through highly interactive and immersive experiences, fueled by technology, compelling story-making, western hospitality, and of course, fun.

When SAM Centre opens in spring 2024, it will feature 30,000 sq. ft. of space comprised of a permanent gallery, a changing exhibits gallery, an immersive digital experience, exciting programs, indoor and outdoor public gathering spaces, and an artifact and archival collection space. Named after the father of Calgary entrepreneur and philanthropist Don Taylor, who made a transformational gift of \$15 million towards the project, and supported by Canadian Heritage, Alberta Culture and the generosity of many philanthropic community members and volunteers, SAM will be a gathering place for Calgarians and visitors from around the world. 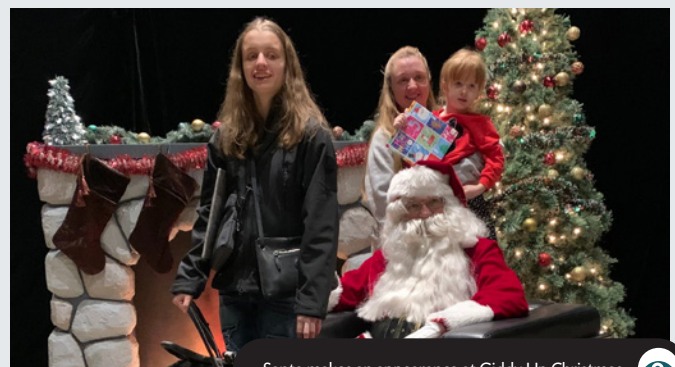

Stampede Showband Shines Brightly at Drum Corps International

It was the adventure of a lifetime for the Calgary Stampede Showband as they travelled nearly 3,000 kilometres to compete at Drum Corps International (DCI) World Championships in Marion, Indianapolis in August. Our 140-member marching band performed in the open class final, earning a banner as International Class Champions. This was the first time the Showband has travelled or competed since 2019 and their first time, ever, competing at Drum Corps, one of the most prestigious stages for marching arts competition.

"You come to the Cowboys Rangeland Derby and watch the chuckwagon racing, for example, and it's the best of the best," said Robin Fulbrook, Team Lead, Youth Performance. "That's what DCI is in the marching band world. To be competing on that level is mind-blowing for our musicians, and they all left the competition as better people because of it."

The 2022 Stampede Poster - Showcasing the Spirit of Competition

Showcasing the spirit of competition, with a nod to the Stampede's proud and longstanding relationship with Indigenous peoples, the 2022 Calgary Stampede Poster features the fierce determination and competitive spirit of the Relay Races. The winning artwork in the 2022 Calgary Stampede Foundation Youth Poster Competition is the work of 19-year-old Kane Pendry of Edmonton and features Relay Racer, Kal Jackson.

As the winning artist of the Youth Poster Competition, Pendry received the \$10,000 Dustin Peers Memorial Scholarship, generously funded by the

Brandon Flock Foundation. The Brandon Flock Foundation provides an additional \$10,000 in scholarships to the top eight in the competition annually. As part of the Calgary Stampede's commitment to youth achievement, the Youth Poster Competition has provided mentorship to young artists since the program was created in 2018. Kane Pendry is the fourth Alberta youth whose artwork has graced the Stampede Poster through the program.

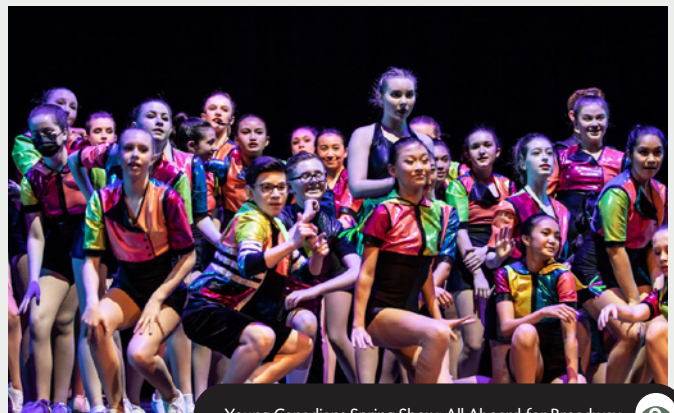

Agriculture, Education & Farm Fun Returned at Aggie Days

Aggie Days was back at the Calgary Stampede for the first time since 2019, celebrating the event's 35th anniversary of providing insight into life on the farm, right in the city.

Across three weekdays in April, thousands of students in grades 3-6 from Calgary and surrounding area came down to Stampede Park to learn more about agriculture and the farm-to-table process.

And then on the weekend, the doors of the Nutrien Western Event Centre and Agriculture Barn opened to the public to experience this free, educational event, with added Stock Dog demonstrations and the thrilling action of Extreme Cowboy Racing.


Both the school and public event included hands-on activities, agricultural demonstrations and the opportunity to get up close with real farm animals. Guests also learned where their fruits and veggies are grown, right from the farmers who grow them.

Teaching Beyond the Classroom


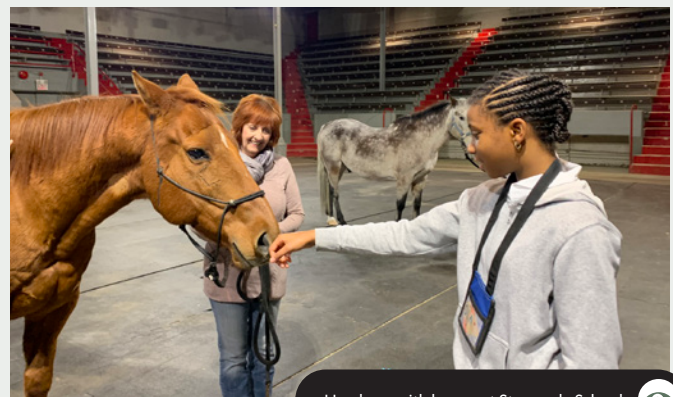

Stampede School continued to share an immersive educational experience for many young Albertans in grades 1-12, who learned about history, agriculture, Indigenous traditions and cultures, and western heritage and values. In 2022, we hosted 24 classes, which totaled 622 students.

With restrictions still in place in early 2022, Stampede School got creative and hit the road, bringing its experience to two Calgary schools that got to experience goats in the school yard, a blacksmith in the parking lot, and an Elder on the smartboard.

Spring 2022 also saw the full return of the OH Ranch Education program. One of Alberta's most historic properties, under the stewardship of the Calgary Stampede, the OH Ranch remains an authentic working cattle

ranch, located in the foothills of the Rocky Mountains. Reaching 40 classes and 933 students, the OH Ranch Education program engaged and empowered students to think deeper, develop connections to their community and understand their impact on the world around them.

Closing out the year, grade one students got a hands-on experience, digging their boots into the dirt in the Nutrien Western Event Centre, learning what it feels like for horses and rodeo contestants. They also caught a glimpse of the future 2023 Calgary Stampede Royalty, as contestants rode their horses, preparing for the final night of their competition. The students ended their day learning about the Royalty Program, meeting the contestants and petting their horses.

Journey 2050 Champions Sustainability

2022 also saw students back at Stampede Park for Journey 2050. This free, inquiry-based agriculture education program challenged 4,870 students and 189 classes to answer, "How will we sustainably feed nearly 10 billion people by the year 2050?", giving them a better understanding of what it means to be sustainable.

The Journey 2050 Community Spirit Community Action Wall was also completed in 2022. This installation, outside the Journey 2050 classroom in the Nutrien Western Event Centre, showcases stories of student changemakers in the community.

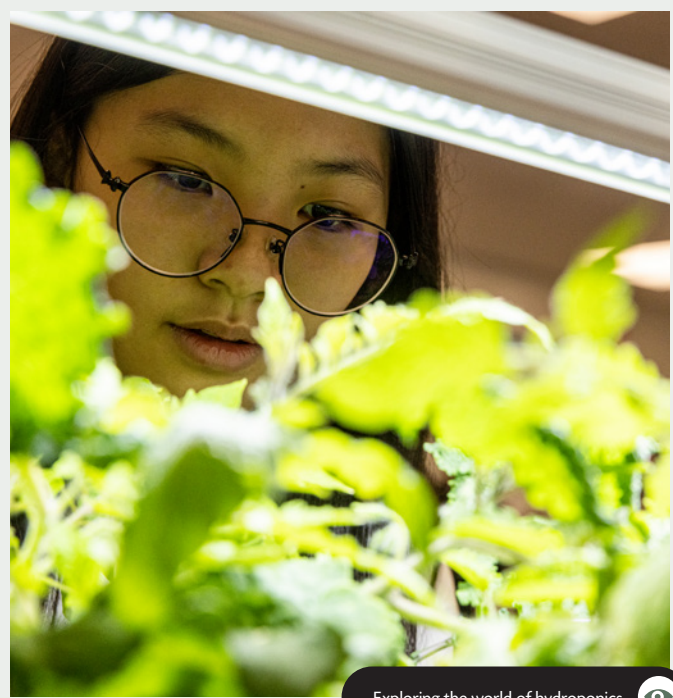
In the summer, the Journey 2050 team also partnered with the Calgary Public Library to continue educating about sustainable agriculture by hosting sessions in libraries all over the city.

4-H Programs - Celebrating Youth in Agriculture

Agriculture has always been an important part of the Calgary Stampede, which is why we were thrilled to bring our two 4-H events back on Stampede Park in 2022: 4-H Rodeo and 4-H on Parade presented by Brandt.


The Calgary Stampede 4-H Rodeo welcomed the brightest young rodeo stars to learn and compete this fall at the Nutrien Western Event Centre. For well over 20 years, the Calgary Stampede 4-H Rodeo has been showcasing the abilities of 4-H members in Alberta from ages nine to 20.

Approximately 75 4-H youth members representing 25 Alberta 4-H clubs learned from the best through a series of clinics taught by industry-leading experts, including Calgary Stampede and Canadian champions.

During these sessions, the next generation of competitors learned new skills and had the opportunity to listen and participate in sessions about cow riding, breakaway roping, basic and advanced riding, rodeo skills and ground roping.

As Western Canada's largest 4-H gathering, 4-H on Parade presented by Brandt celebrated year-round youth involvement in agriculture and offered an opportunity to showcase animal husbandry and other life skills in the spring.

This popular long-time Stampede event showcased the achievements, dedication and hard work of nearly 400 youth members of 28 Calgary-region 4-H clubs and included more than 400 animals, such as horses, canines, sheep and cattle that moved into the Nutrien Western Event Centre and Agriculture Barn.

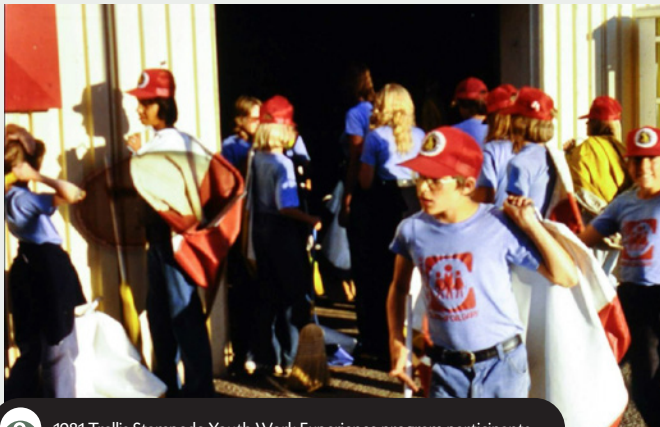
Trellis Society and the Calgary Stampede Celebrate 50 Years

"Stampede work experience provides an employment experience in a safe and supportive environment where vulnerable youth are able to build connections with their community, gain valuable lifelong skills such as teamwork, and develop a sense of self-sufficiency that they can build off of for their future," said Robyn Yon, Program Manager with Trellis Society.

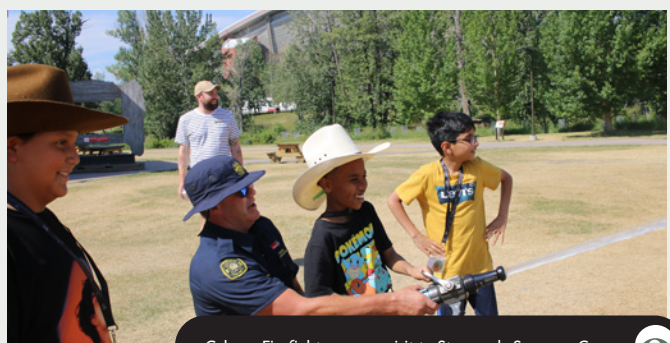

Back in the Saddle for Stampede 2022

Stampede 2022 was about welcoming the community back to Stampede Park. Across the 10 days of our annual celebration, we were joined by more than 1.2 million guests from around southern Alberta and the world.

The Return of Iconic Experiences

Stampede 2022 brought back the iconic events our guests know and love, and shared some new and exciting experiences.


Stampede opened with a bang on Friday, July 8, bringing more than 305,000 spectators to the streets with the return of a full Calgary Stampede Parade after three years. 2022 Parade Marshal, Kevin Costner, led the Parade, drawing in large crowds to what we estimate as one of the highest-attended Parades in Stampede history. Later that day, back on Stampede Park, the community let us know they were ready to ride again by “parading to Park” and breaking a daily attendance record for opening day.

Stampede also wouldn't be complete without music across our four iconic stages: the Coca-Cola Stage, the Virgin Plus Stage at The Big Four Roadhouse, Nashville North and the the Virgin Plus Stampede Concert stage in the Saddledome. These stages saw more than 100 music acts

across the 10 days of our annual celebration. The Coca-Cola Stage was also notably relocated to the south end of Stampede Park, near the Erlton Entrance, allowing for excitement right as guests entered.

Chucks were back – we saw the return of this fan-favourite event as part of the Evening Show. We also brought on a brand-new sponsor for the event, proudly naming it the Cowboys Rangeland Derby, taking place in GMC Stadium.


Stampede 2022 also saw the return of Elbow River Camp presented by Enbridge, welcoming guests back to experience and learn about the cultures of the Treaty 7 First Nations. The dedication and work of the Tipi Holders and their families who put on the programming in Elbow River Camp were on full display, creating a safe space for them to celebrate and practice their cultures and for non-Indigenous people to engage, appreciate, and understand.

A major part of Stampede is sharing and celebrating our western heritage, and it wouldn't have been a full Stampede without our Agriculture & Western Events programming.

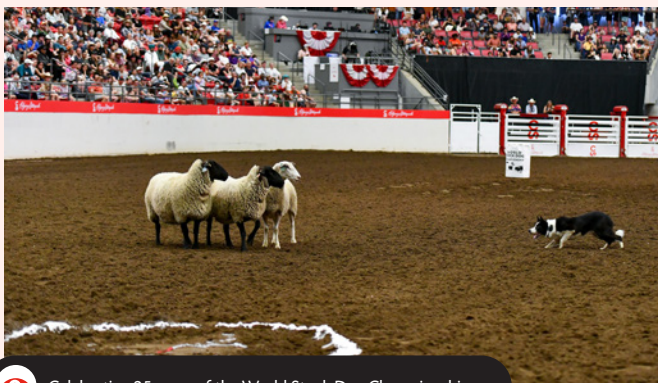
The Rodeo made a full return, featuring the world's best competitors and animals across six events every day during our 10-day celebration, handing out more than \$1.5 million in prize money.

Celebrating its 25th anniversary, the World Stock Dog Championship was a fan favourite, as incredibly agile and intelligent dogs moved sheep through a challenging course and into a pen in less than four minutes.

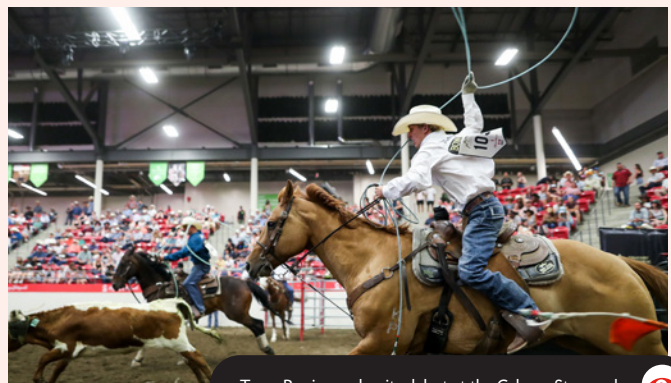
The top 12 dogs and their handlers competed for the \$10,000 top spot and title of Grand Champion.

Canada's richest day of Team Roping made its debut at the 2022 Stampede, with 30 of North America's best teams vying for a share of \$100,000 in prize money. Fans packed the Nutrien Western Event Centre for a chance to see Team Roping at Stampede for the first time.


The Nutrien Western Event Centre hosted more than 100 hours of Western Events programming over the ten days of Stampede. In addition, there were more than 17,000 animal interactions as part of Agriculture & Western Events programming, supported by the efforts of 4,700 exhibitors and competitors.

New Thrills Reach New Heights

Stampede 2022 introduced a number of new experiences on Stampede Park, including a competition Powwow held for the first time in the Saddledome. This brand-new event saw three days of competition, featuring nine drum groups and more than 250 competitors from Treaty 7 First Nations and across North America. More than 13,000 guests enjoyed this new program, which was hosted in the Saddledome.

Another new attraction that was not-to-be-missed was the Stampede Superwheel. Standing at 150 feet tall, Canada's Largest Travelling Ferris Wheel, the Superwheel, made a stop on the Stampede Midway. This eight-minute ride provided a unique birds-eye view of the Midway and a fantastic lookout for the nightly Fireworks Finale.

For the first time ever, the Calgary Stampede hosted the inaugural Drag Brunch presented by Mott's on the final Sunday of Stampede 2022. Bringing opulence and elegance to Nashville North, this event served looks, death drops and flapjacks to guests.

The Bell Grandstand Show was also reimagined for 2022, with Amplified, featuring Canadian country music icon, Dean Brody, a spectacle of song and dance from The Young Canadians of the Calgary Stampede, and trick roping by Loop Rawlins.

During his visit, Mr. Trudeau spoke with the University of Calgary's Dr. Renaud Léguillette about his research on Chuckwagon horses; learned about the Chuckwagon track and the science behind its safety; met with the Coleman family, whose team of heavy horses won the World Champion Six Horse Hitch at Stampede 2022; and greeted guests on the Midway.

And on Monday, July 11, we welcomed 26 new Canadian Citizens, originating from nine different countries at the first in-person Citizenship Ceremony in more than two years. At the end of the ceremony, the new Canadians sang along as The Young Canadians Soloist, Emma Mountain, and the Stampede Showband performed O Canada. The ceremony then closed out with the Stampede Showband and Colour Guard giving a lively performance of You Can Call Me AI, which saw some of the new Canadian audience members joining in to dance along. The new Canadians also spent the night being hosted at the Evening Show and were recognized in a shout-out from the Grandstand stage, along with the new Calgaryans who were involved in the Community Projects & Development Committee's Pop Up Stampede events out in the community in June.

One of the largest and most prestigious events of its kind in Western Canada, the Cutting Horse Futurity draws many of the best horses and trainers in the sport.

More than 170 horse and rider pairs took part in this year's event, vying for a share of the more than \$250,000 in prize money and awards. This year, the Canadian Cutting Horse Association (CCHA) Finals and National Cutting Horse Association (NCHA) Aurora Circuit finals also took place in tandem with the Stampede Cutting Horse Futurity competition.

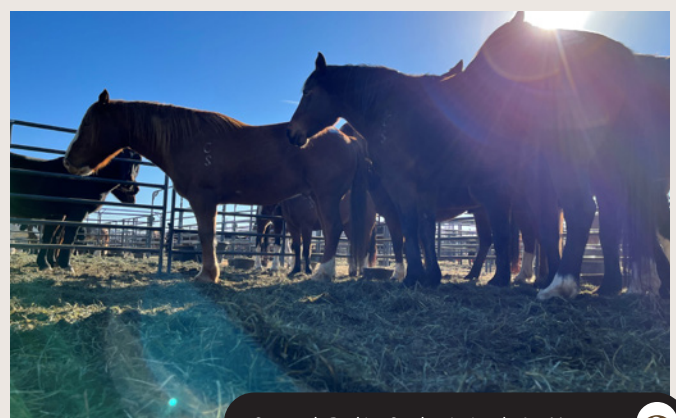
Only the best bucking stock make it to these two high-profile rodeos, selected and recognized by the contestants for their world-class performances throughout the year, and ability to give the top cowboys at these events a high-scoring ride.

The Calgary Stampede sent 27 horses and four bulls to CFR, which took place in Red Deer, Alberta, November 2-6, and they came home with some serious hardware! Tokyo Bubbles carried Zeke Thurston to a huge 91.75 point ride to win a buckle in round three of the Saddle Bronc Riding. Another Calgary Stampede horse, Redon Acres, captured round five in partnership with Thurston. In Bareback, Bigtimin Houston matched up with Orin Larson for the win in round four and Xplosive Skies lit up round six for a buckle with Ty Taypotat on board. Tyler Kraft, Manager of the Calgary Stampede Ranch and Stock Contracting Operations was also selected by his peers as Pick Up Man for the prestigious event.

The Calgary Stampede's horses were also showcased once again December 1-10 in Las Vegas, Nevada at NFR, where 13 of our equine athletes were selected to compete. The Calgary Stampede was also nominated for the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association (PRCA) award for Large Outdoor Rodeo of the Year.

A Special Thank You to our Government Partners



The City of Calgary

The City of Calgary is a long-time partner of the Calgary Stampede. Along with providing our 100-year lease and support for our credit facilities, collaboration enables outreach into the community to enhance and support civic activities throughout the year. Various initiatives at Stampede Park and in the city engage citizens and guests, contributing to the cultural, social and economic well-being of the greater community.

The City is providing one-third of the funding for the expansion of the BMO Centre, which has progressed on budget with construction toward becoming the largest convention facility in Western Canada.

The Government of Alberta

The Government of Alberta, through Alberta Culture, supported several Stampede programs and facilities through an operating grant agreement of \$6.055 million. These funds provided opportunities for youth to learn about Indigenous culture and history, agriculture and sustainability, and to develop performing arts skills, along with 1.2 million guests from around the world to experience a full Stampede with iconic events like our chuckwagon races, agriculture competitions and First Nations cultural presentations in Elbow River Camp. Further, the investment enabled 2,500 volunteers to contribute their time and talent to build community and spirit year-round, while \$250,000 was specifically directed to complete repair work on the roof of The Big Four Building to ensure the safety of our guests using this public venue.

The Province is a one-third funding partner of the BMO Centre Expansion Project. Phase three construction continued on schedule with the final steel beam placed in November, the exterior roofline and features taking shape, and steady progress toward the June 2024 opening of the new tier-one conference facility.

The Government of Canada

The Government of Canada provided support through COVID-19 pandemic income and wage subsidy relief and a one-time contribution of \$10 million from the Major Festivals and Events Support Initiative announced in June for the annual July celebration. The Calgary Stampede appreciates this support, which helped sustain employment opportunities and deliver a full presentation with Stampede 2022. The Canada Alberta Job Grant (CAJG) contribution of \$46,717 enabled additional employment opportunities during the year.

The contribution by Infrastructure Canada of one-third matching funds to the \$500 million-dollar expansion of the BMO Centre enabled completion of the main steel frame and the majority of the exterior work, to enable the interior construction to move forward on schedule in the coming year.

Sikapinakii Low Horn, a Traditional Dancer from the Siksika Nation, attends the University of Calgary as a Fine Arts graduate student. She was a role model and utilized her platform by telling stories of her people, her family, the land and the history of Treaty 7.

As a member of Calgary's corporate community, Jenna Peters balanced her reign with a full-time job and was excited to inspire others through her role as 2022 Stampede Princess – a once-in-a-lifetime experience. As a former Stampede Showrider, Jenna felt her involvement in the Calgary Stampede as a youth shaped her into who she is today.

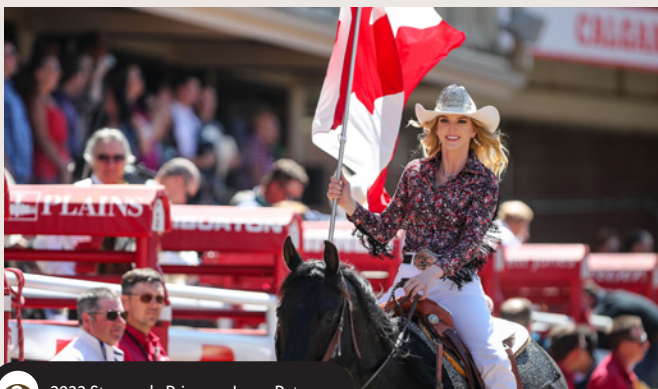
The Stampede was fortunate to have two passionate and engaging ambassadors who connected the community and the Calgary Stampede throughout 2022.

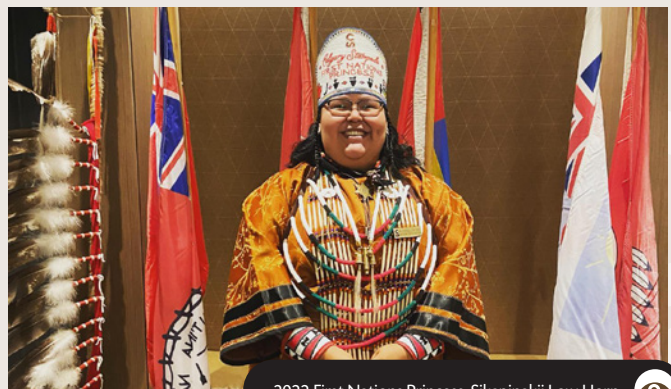

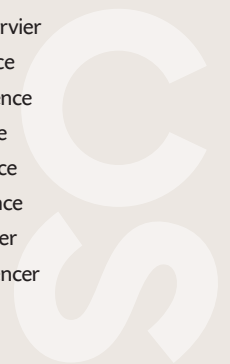
