Instructions

Colour in each picture of Rosie and add in any details. You can use any colouring materials you like - why not try crayons or paint?

Once you've coloured in each picture, ask a grown up to cut around them with scissors or a craft knife, following the dotted line. Make sure your grown up cuts around the rectangle wings, as you will use these to make a ring that fits nicely around your finger.

To make the ring, bring the two ends of the wings together with the picture facing outwards. Once the ring fits perfectly on your finger, secure the ends with glue or tape. Now Rosie is ready for her next adventure! Where will you take her?

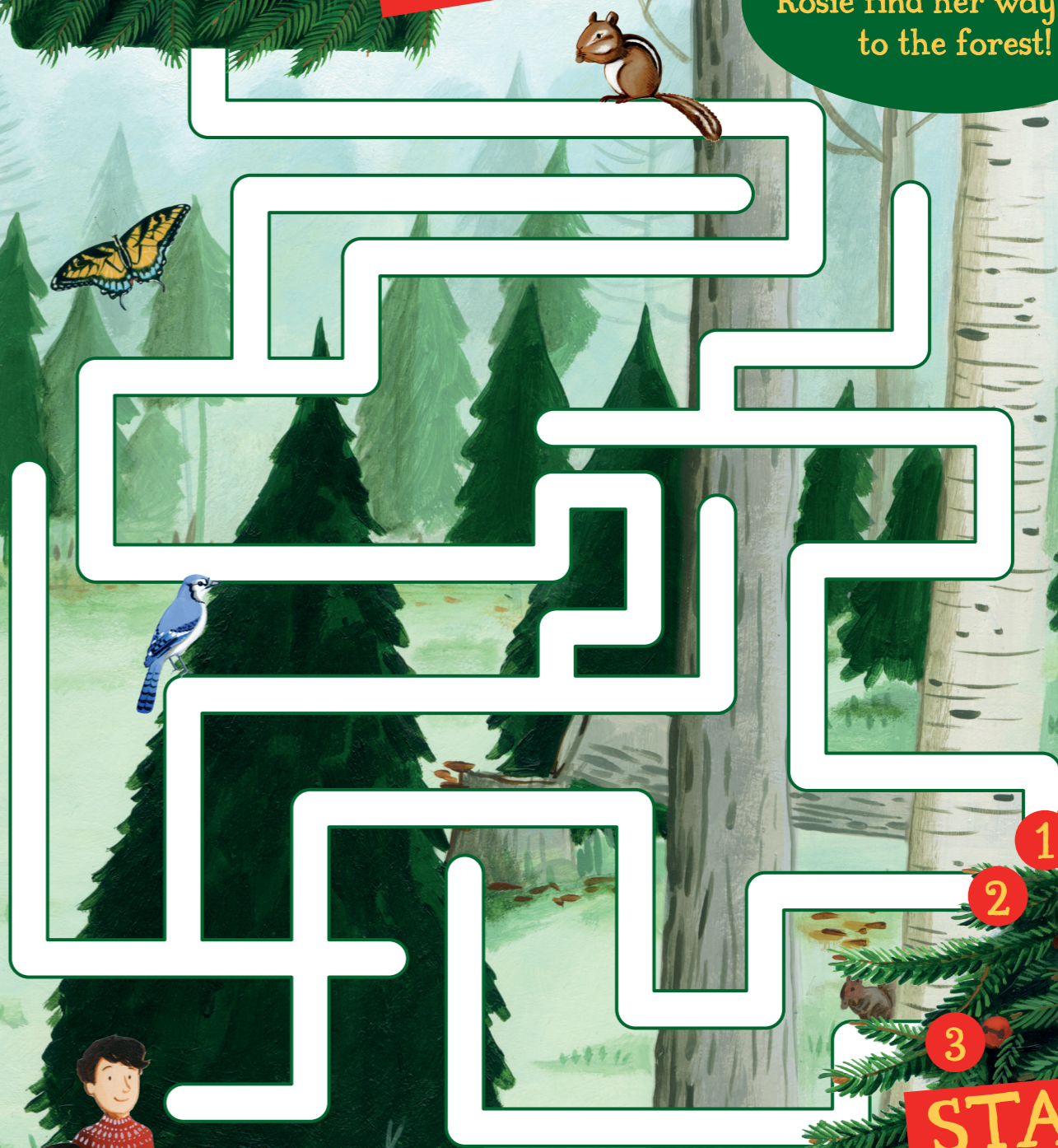

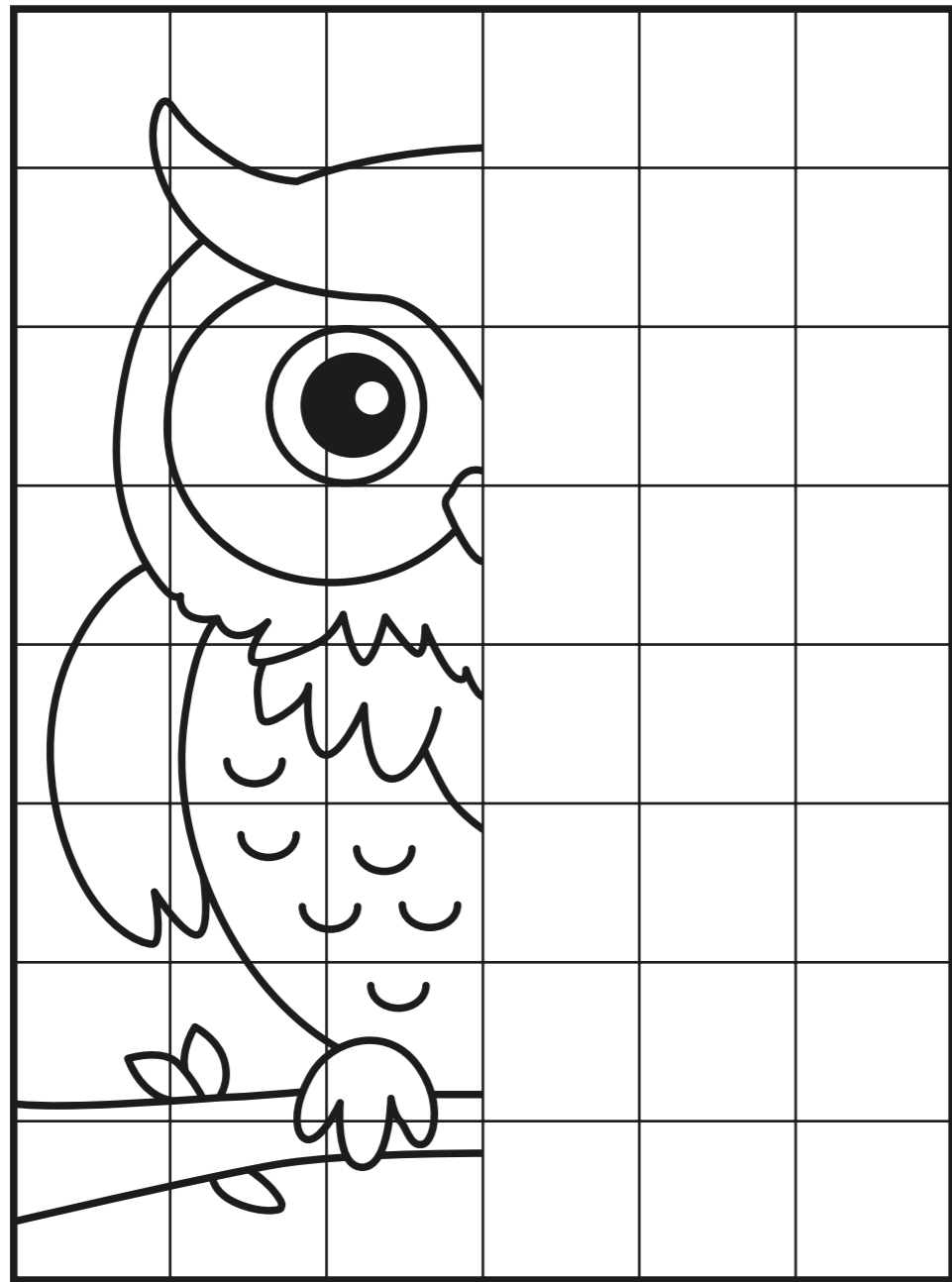
