Focusing on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion

Current family-building offerings, intended as a DE&I solution, actually ignore critical LGBTQ+, BIPOC, and global considerations. FertilityIQ is the solution for all diverse, equitable, and inclusive family-building education. Here's some highlights:

Race/Heritage

Data shows referral rates to specialists differ depending upon a person's race. In the field of fertility, these delays impact the odds of success. What's more, specific races tend to encounter specific challenges (e.g. fibroids in Black patients, PCOS in South Asian patients.) Swiftly addressing underlying issues can often improve fertility. Finally, rates of IVF success vary by race, and tactics to improve outcomes can be tailored for each group (e.g. frozen embryo transfers for patients of East Asian heritage.)

Orientation

First, most LGBTQ+ families are built via adoption and foster—having dedicated courses for these groups is critical. What's more, when it comes to conceiving, LGBTQ+ and unpartnered people blaze a unique path as they additionally need third party resources (e.g. donor sperm, donor eggs, or a gestational surrogate.) This magnifies the cost, the length, and the complexity to the family-building process and requires a much more bespoke educational offering.

Gender Identity

For transmasculine or transfeminine individuals, the process to conceive often involves a discussion of whether a person has begun their transition. If not, fertility preservation is an important topic. If transition has begun, addressing the complexity of stopping hormones (which has medical/emotional considerations) is a priority. Acknowledging the discomfort in momentarily losing the identity one's fought so hard to surface needs a dedicated resource. Few clinics are trained to meet the needs of trans patients so specific courses are even more critical.



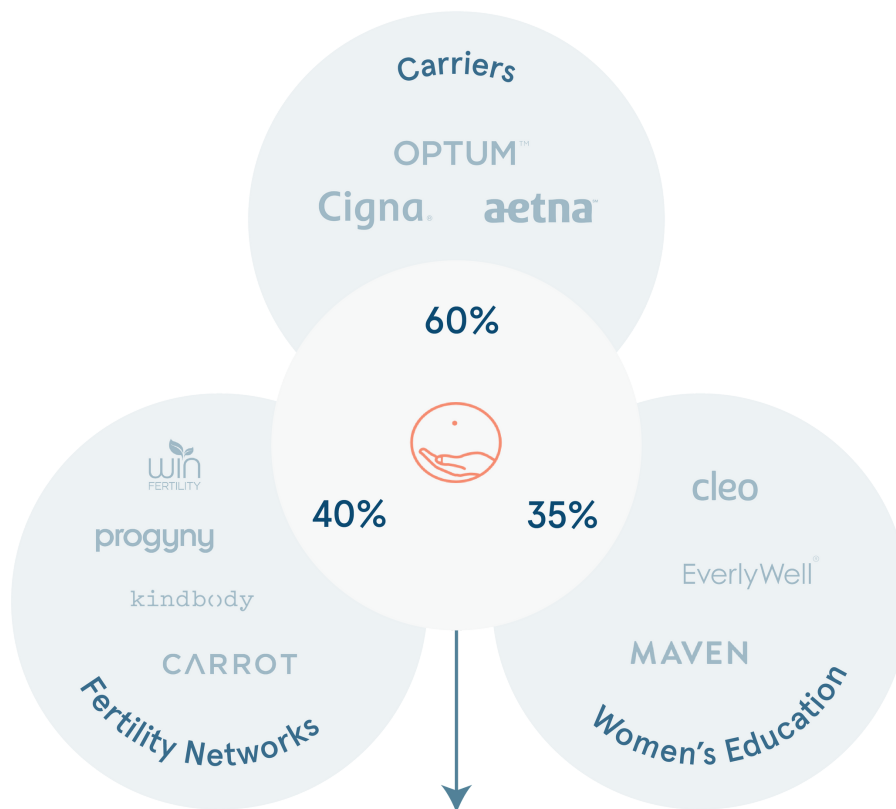

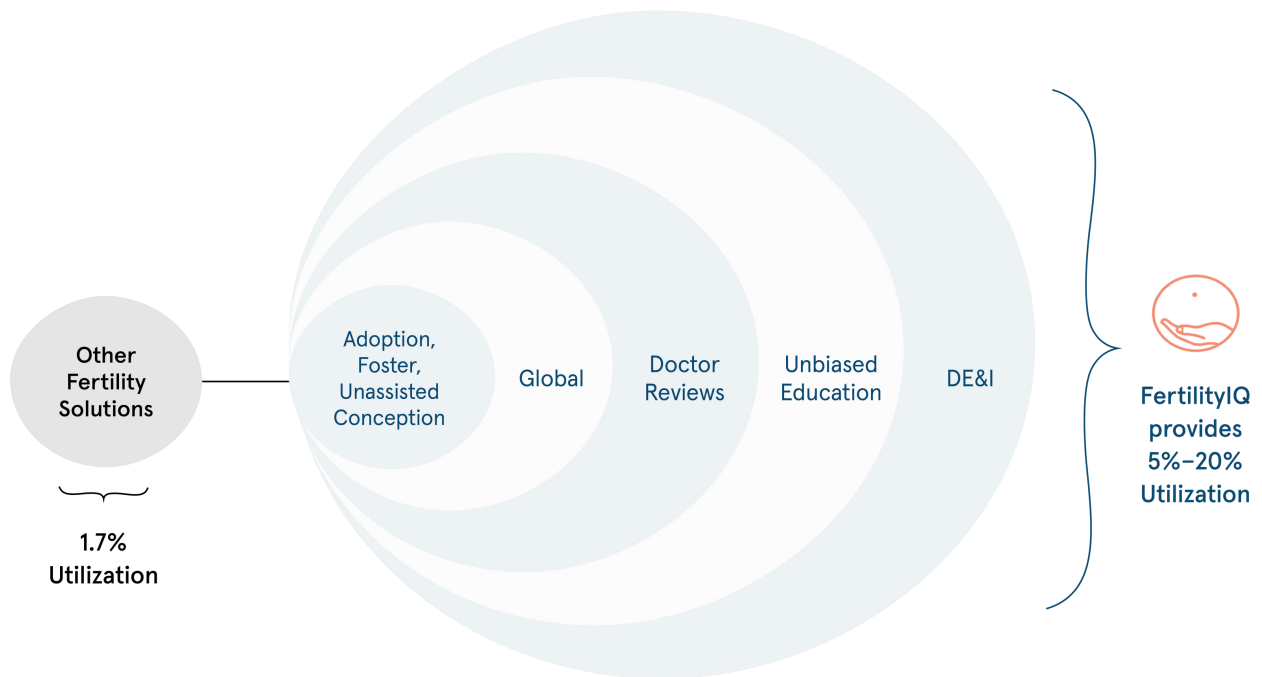
