Construction of Terminal F is officially underway! Airport officials and project partners gathered this morning to celebrate the groundbreaking at the site of the new terminal, which will become DFW's sixth terminal and deliver 15 new gates to prepare for more historic growth. DFW is Going Monumental — with modular construction! Following the revolutionary use of the innovative construction technique to rebuild five gates in Terminal C in 2022, DFW is taking the modular construction method to a new industry-leading scale with several terminal projects. For Terminal F, six megastructures will soon come to life on a separate pre-fabrication site before being moved across the airfield for installation at the final terminal

The DFW Runway 17R/35L Rehabilitation Project is complete, showcasing achievements through teamwork, safety, efficiency, and collaboration among project partners.



DFW volunteers partnered with Suffolk Construction to support the community through the USO Care Package Program, which connects troops with a piece of home.



Dallas Fort Worth International Airport CEO Sean Donohue announced his retirement in 2025 after a 40-year aviation career, including 30 years in executive roles. Since becoming CEO in 2013, he has led DFW to become the third-busiest airport globally, earned accolades for customer service, achieved carbon neutrality, and initiated a \$9 billion modernization plan, including a new Terminal F. The DFW Airport Board will begin searching for his successor.

DFW Airport proudly participates in the Hidden Disabilities Sunflower program. Sunflower lanyard signals to staff that the wearer has a hidden disability.

Travelers can request a sunflower lanyard in advance at https://www.dfwairport.com/sunflower. The preferred method is mail delivery, but lanyards can also be arranged for in-person pickup if ordered ahead. For same-day pickups, customers should allow extra time to reach their departure terminal.
