

APPENDIX G: PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT MATERIALS AND SUMMARY

Dallas Fort Worth International Airport (DFW) is proposing to rehabilitate Runway 18L/36R to address drainage and structural deficiencies, ensure long-term operational reliability, and meet current FAA design standards and AC guidelines. The Proposed Action includes the construction of asphalt overlay, improvements to drainage conditions, modifications and upgrades to Runway 18L/36R information systems, and implementation of a standard maintenance cycle that aligns with previous runway rehabilitation projects.

With Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) serving as the Lead Federal Agency (LFA), an Environmental Assessment (EA) has been prepared in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) of 1969, which requires federal agencies to analyze the environmental impacts and assess the reasonable alternatives that avoid or minimize adverse effects, consider relevant and reasonable mitigation measures, and provide the public an opportunity to participate in the NEPA process.

Under NEPA, FAA has authority to review and approve federal actions and ensure compliance with NEPA, the Airport and Airway Improvement Act of 1982, as amended, and other regulations. FAA's NEPA policies and procedures are set forth in FAA Order 1050.1G, Environmental Impacts: Policies and Procedures (FAA, 2015), FAA Order 1050.1F Desk Reference (FAA, 2023), and FAA Order 5050.4B, NEPA Implementing Instructions for Airport Actions (FAA, 2006).

The purpose of this Public Involvement Summary is to document the public involvement efforts for the proposed Runway 18L/36R Rehabilitation Project, the Proposed Action. This summary includes public input gathered during the Draft EA and Draft General Conformity public comment period, from February 1, 2026 through March 3, 2026.

1. INTRODUCTION

This summary details the comments received during the Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) and Draft General Conformity Determination comment period as well as responses to those comments.

The views of communities—local residents, the general public, stakeholders, and agencies — are important to the FAA. As such, the FAA has been committed to meaningful public involvement and agency input throughout the NEPA process.

A 30 day period for submitting comments on the Runway 18L/36R Rehabilitation Project at DFW Airport began on February 1, 2026, with the publication of the document on DFW's website. The comment period closed on March 3, 2026.

Public notices announcing the release of the Draft EA, Draft General Conformity Determination, and the public comment period were placed in the *Dallas Morning News* and *Fort Worth Star Telegram* on February 1, 8, 15, 22, and March 1, 2026, for both publications. Notices in *Al Dia* were published in Spanish on February 4, 11, 18, and 25, 2026. DFW email notifications to 15 City administrative staff, including City Managers at these cities: Arlington, Coppell, Euless,

Flower Mound, Grand Prairie, Grapevine, Irving, Lewisville, Southlake, Trophy Club, and Westlake.

Thank you, Matt Gelvin	Thank you for your comment regarding the duration of the proposed closure of Runway 18L/36R and the potential for increased aircraft noise in nearby communities during construction. The full closure of Runway 18L/36R is necessary to safely and efficiently complete the extensive rehabilitation work required to maintain the runway's long-term operational safety and reliability. The scope of work includes major pavement reconstruction, lighting and electrical system improvements, and other airfield infrastructure upgrades that cannot be safely performed while the runway remains operational. The construction schedule was developed to balance several factors, including construction safety, operational efficiency, contractor productivity, and minimization of overall project duration. Performing this work under a full runway closure allows construction activities to occur more efficiently than phased or nighttime closures and ultimately reduces the total time required to complete the project. We have already accounted for a shortened runway closure during the summer peak of 2026 to reduce overall impact and maintain construction production. DFW has successfully finished Runway 17R/35L rehabilitation ahead of schedule by adopting such approach back in 2024. We have incorporated Runway 17R/35L and two previous runway rehabilitation projects' lessons learned into this project. Seasonal weather conditions are considered during project planning; however, construction schedules for large airfield rehabilitation projects must also be coordinated with airport operational demands, ongoing construction projects, contractor availability, and funding schedules. While temporary operational adjustments may occur during the closure period, the project does not involve permanent changes to aircraft operations. The runway will return to normal service once construction is complete, and any temporary changes in aircraft routing or noise exposure during construction would be short-term in nature. DFW Airport appreciates public input and will continue to coordinate construction activities to minimize impacts to surrounding communities to the extent practicable.

Will groundhog see its shadow?

Origin traces back to European folklore; Frisco plans event

Groundhog Day is Monday, and North Texas residents can observe the tradition through local events and regional gatherings.

Groundhog Day is a seasonal tradition that traces its origins to European folklore, according to the National Weather Service.

Around the fifth century, Celtic communities believed animals held special powers on days that fell between the winter solstice and the spring equinox.

Folklore from Germany and France later held that animals such as marmots and bears would retreat back into their dens if they saw their shadow, signaling several more weeks of winter.

The belief was later adopted by the Romans as Hedgehog Day and eventually became associated with the Christian observance of Candlemas, according to the National Weather Service.

The earliest known American reference to Groundhog Day dates to 1841 in Pennsylvania, according to historical records from the Historical Society of Berks County.

In North Texas, a Groundhog Day event is planned at Kaleidoscope Park in Frisco from 8 to 10 a.m. Monday, with activities including crafts and photos with the park's groundhog mascot, Kaleidoscope Karla, according to the city's tourism website.

The Dallas Arboretum and Botanical Garden will have an event as well, featuring "Arboretum Annie" at A Tasteful Place. The program starts around 7:15 a.m. to coincide with sunrise, offering free hot coffee, a hat contest, and photos with the groundhog until 8:30 a.m., according to the Dallas Arboretum website.

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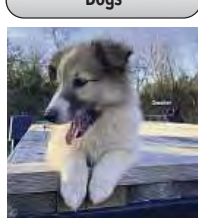

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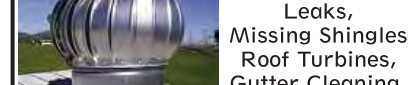

FORT WORTH STOCK SHOW

Winter woes: Attendance drops because of ice storm

City's main livestock competition saw nearly 20% fewer visitors

Five days of icy roads and freezing temperatures led to a steep downward slide for the Fort Worth Stock Show & Rodeo's attendance this year.

Although streets near the Will Rogers Memorial Center and Dickies Arena were open after Winter Storm Fern hit North Texas in late January, the city's main livestock competition saw a nearly 20% drop in visitors, according to estimated figures from event organizers.

A little more than 1 million people went to the 2026 show, a significant drop from the 1.26 million visitors who attended last year. Organizers noted winter weather also hampered attendance in 2024, but that show still drew 1.14 million after a record-breaking 2023 show that welcomed 1.27 million visitors.

"Unlike last year, we experienced five days of adverse weather," said Matt Brockman, communications director for the stock show.

Freezing temperatures, coupled with snow, freezing rain and ice hindered this year's show, Brockman said. Significant amounts of sleet occurred Jan. 23, followed by about 36 hours of freezing rain, ice and snow that ended midday on Jan. 25.

"Temperatures remained below freezing for a continuous 58 hours," he said.

Roads and surfaces did not begin thawing until Jan. 27, when the temperature finally

rose above 32 degrees. That five-day period of icy conditions led to a decline of just under 195,000 visitors, Brockman said.

"The storm's impact was significant, occurring on what is, typically, one of the FWSSR's highest-attendance weekends," he said. "The effect lingered for several more days, and attendance didn't return to normal until the last five days of the show."

Weather has been a frequent factor in show attendance since the event started in 1896 as the Southwestern Exposition and Livestock Show, Brockman said.

This year's show had 32,679 entries for shows and contests, a 2.1% increase from 2025. Last year's show had 31,983 entries, a 6.4% decrease compared to 2024.

Youth entries totaled 11,765 and included 4-H and FFA members from 232 of the state's 254 counties. Open livestock entries came from 33 states.

White Castle, a 1,459-pound

European crossbred steer exhibited by Caiman Cody, 13, from the Hood County town of Tolar, sold for a record-setting \$550,000 on Feb. 7 at the show's annual Junior Sale of Champions.

The grand champion steer was purchased by Trico Electric, a 40-year-old commercial electric contractor based in Azle.

The stock show's previous record for the grand champion steer was 2023's \$440,000.

Cheeto, the 2026 reserve grand champion steer, was exhibited by Cash Goretska, 16, of Abilene. That steer sold to Hillwood for a record-matching \$300,000 in the Feb. 7 auction.

The annual auction of champion steers, barrows, goats and lambs exhibited by youth raised more than \$10.1 million in total proceeds for the exhibitors of the auction.

FAA and DFW Airport have prepared a Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) and Draft General Conformity Determination (GCD) to evaluate the potential environmental impacts of the Proposed Runway 18L/36R Rehabilitation Project. The Draft EA has been prepared in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) of 1969 as well as FAA Order 1050.1G: Environmental Impacts: Policies and Procedures, and FAA Order 5050.4B: NEPA Implementing Instructions for Airport Actions. Additionally, in compliance with the Clean Air Act (CAA), a Draft General Conformity Determination has been prepared for the Proposed Project and is being made available for public review under Section 176(c) of the CAA and Amendments of 1990.

What is the project?

DFW Airport is proposing to rehabilitate Runway 18L/36R. The project includes:

- Pavement rehabilitation and construction of an asphalt overlay
- Shoulder and blast pad pavement reconstruction
- Northwest holding pads rehabilitation
- New electrical infrastructure
- Lighting, signage, and drainage improvements.
- Navigational aid (NAVAID) improvements

What is the purpose of the project?

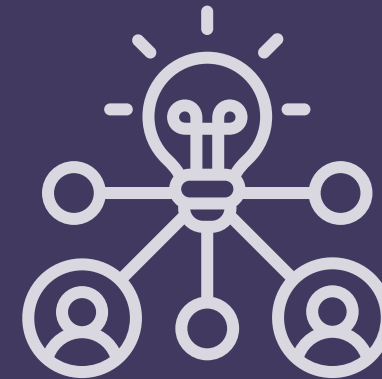

Environmental Analysis

The Draft EA evaluates the potential environmental effects of the Proposed Project, in accordance with NEPA, FAA Order 1050.1G, and FAA Order 5050.4B. The Draft EA includes an analysis of reasonable alternatives, potential environmental impacts, and mitigation measures.

Air Quality and General Conformity

The Clean Air Act has National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) to protect the public from the effects of air pollution. Areas that do not meet the NAAQS are designated as nonattainment. The Dallas-Fort Worth metropolitan area is designated nonattainment for ozone; therefore, general conformity regulations apply.

The Draft General Conformity Determination evaluates whether the project conforms to the applicable Texas State Implementation Plan (SIP). FAA and DFW are coordinating with the Texas Council on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) as part of the General Conformity Process.

Estimated pollutant emissions from the project include Nitrogen Oxides (NOx) and Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs), also known as Ozone precursors. The estimated project-related NOx would exceed the de minimis threshold of 25 tons per year (tpy). Estimated VOC emissions would be well below the 25 tpy de minimis threshold (see table below).

On December 17, 2025, TCEQ completed their review of the air quality analysis and the Draft General Conformity Determination and concurred with the findings stating that the project conforms to the Texas SIP.

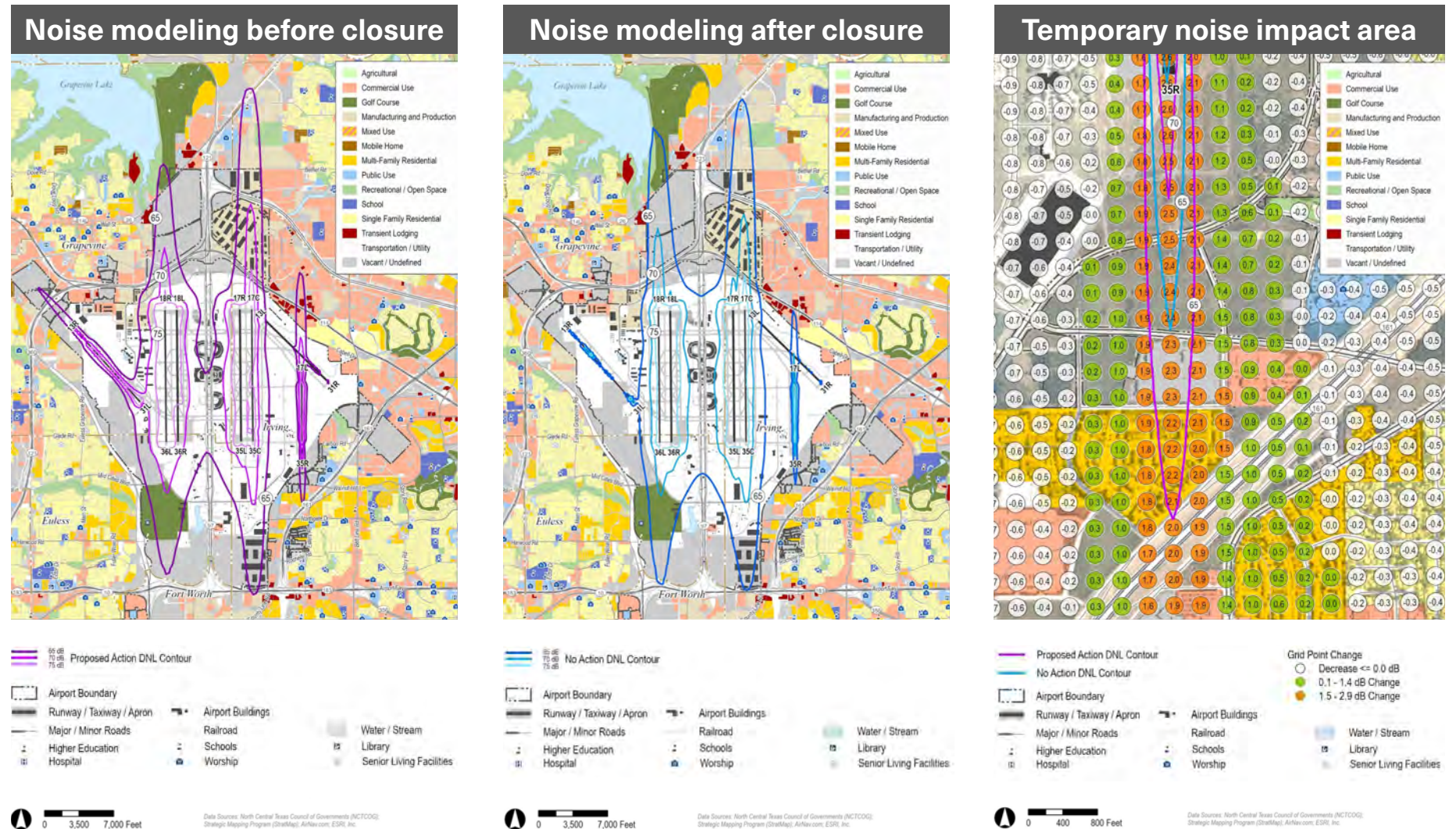

What are the noise impacts?

Surrounding communities may experience an increase in noise within their neighborhoods from the effects of the change in operations during a runway closure. DFW modeled the temporary change in noise exposure with and without the planned closure, as required by FAA. Noise modeling is done to determine if the project would create a noise "significant impact", defined by the FAA as a 1.5 dB increase in the 65 Day/Night Level (DNL) noise exposure contour, over a noise-sensitive land use.

The proposed Project may cause short-term, temporary changes in noise levels during construction as aircraft operations are temporarily shifted to east side runways. The temporary noise changes may affect one multi-family development in the City of Irving. The apartment buildings located directly south of Runway 35R may be temporarily exposed to noise exceeding the significance threshold of 1.5 dB in the 65 DNL noise exposure contour. After construction, aircraft will resume use of Runway 18L/36R.

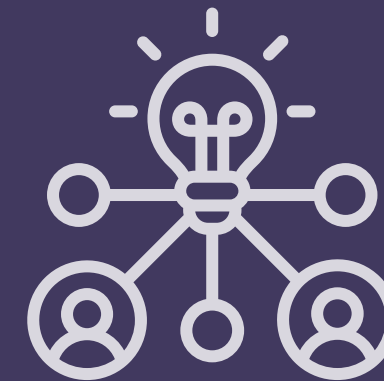

Análisis Ambiental

El Borrador EA Evalua los efectos ambientales potenciales del Proyecto Propuesto, en conformidad con la NEPA, la Orden 10501G de la FAA y la Orden 5050.4B de la FAA. El Borrador EA incluye un análisis de alternativas razonables, impactos ambientales posibles y medidas de mitigación.

Calidad del Aire y Conformidad General

La Ley de Aire Limpio establece Estándares Nacionales de Calidad del Aire Ambiente (NAAQS) para proteger al público de los efectos de la contaminación del aire. Las áreas que no cumplen con los estándares NAAQS son designadas como áreas de incumplimiento. La área metropolitana Dallas-Fort Worth está designada como área de incumplimiento por ozono; por lo tanto, las regulaciones generales de conformidad aplican.

El Borrador de Determinación General de Conformidad evalúa si el proyecto se conforma al Plan de Implementación Estatal de Texas (SIP). La FAA y DFW están coordinando con la Comisión de Calidad Ambiental de Texas (TCEQ) como parte del Proceso de Conformidad General.

Las emisiones de contaminantes estimadas del proyecto incluyen óxidos de nitrógeno (NOx) y compuestos orgánicos volátiles (COV), también conocidos como precursores de Ozono. Las emisiones de NOx estimadas relacionadas con el proyecto superarían el límite mínimo de 25 toneladas por año (t/año). Las emisiones de COV estimadas estarían muy por debajo del límite mínimo de 25 t/año (vea la tabla a continuación).

El 17 de diciembre de 2025, la TCEQ completó su revisión del análisis de calidad del aire y del Borrador de Determinación de General de Conformidad y coincidió con las conclusiones, afirmando que el proyecto cumple con el SIP de Texas.

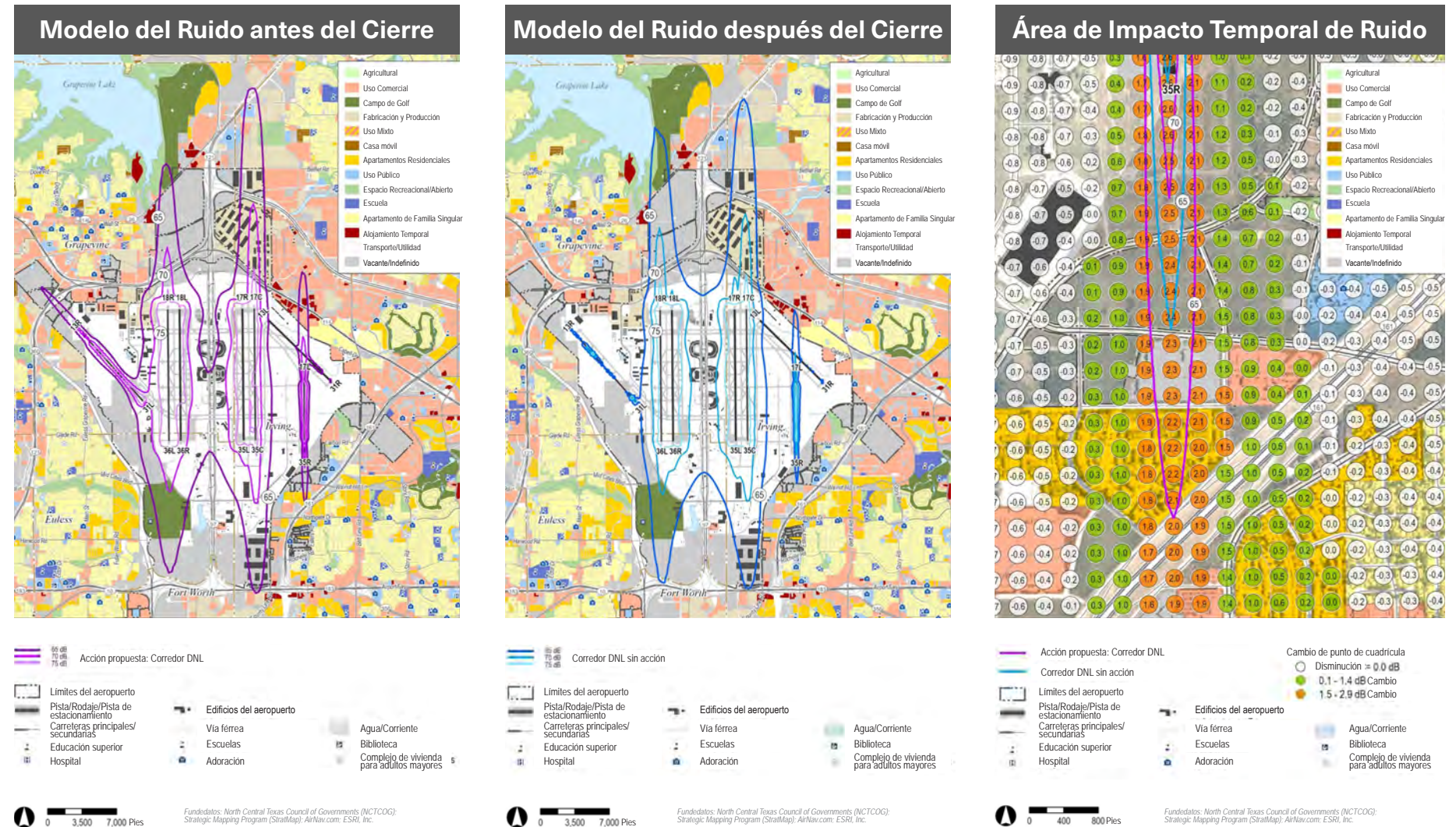

¿Cuáles son los Impactos de Ruido?

Las comunidades circundantes podrían experimentar un aumento del ruido en sus vecindarios debido a los cambios en las operaciones durante el cierre de la pista. El aeropuerto DFW modeló el cambio temporal en la exposición al ruido con y sin el cierre planificado, según lo exige la FAA. El modelo del ruido se realiza para determinar si el proyecto generaría un "impacto significativo" en el ruido, definido por la FAA como un aumento de 1,5 dB en el contorno de exposición al ruido del Nivel Día/Noche (DNL) de 65 dB, sobre un área con uso del suelo sensible al ruido.

El proyecto propuesto podría causar cambios temporales a corto plazo en los niveles de ruido durante la construcción, ya que las operaciones aéreas se trasladarán temporalmente a las pistas del lado este. Estos cambios temporales en el ruido podrían afectar a un edificio de departamentos en la ciudad de Irving. Los edificios de apartamentos ubicados directamente al sur de la pista 35R podrían estar expuestos temporalmente a niveles de ruido que superen el límite de significancia de 1,5 dB en el contorno de exposición al ruido de 65 DNL. Una vez finalizada la construcción, las aeronaves reanudarán el uso de la pista 18L/36R.
