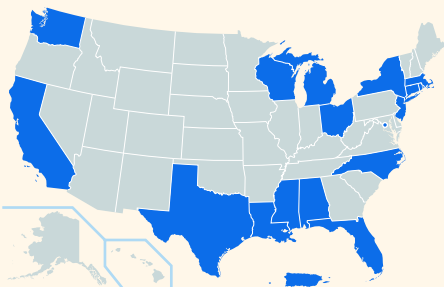

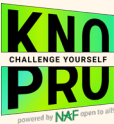


71% of students who completed a work-based learning experience said it helped them understand what skills they need for a future career.
