

Anatoly is the creator of Solana. He led development of operating systems at Qualcomm, distributed systems at Mesosphere, and compression at Dropbox. He holds 2 patents for high performance Operating Systems protocols, was a core kernel developer for BREW (100m+ devices), and made Project Tango (VR/AR)

This discussion will cover the core innovations of the platform, recent developments (including Project Serum), and the unique relationship between Multicoin Capital and Solana over the past two years.
