3. Overview of results

3.1. Executive summary

During this reporting period the project has suffered a small slow down due to different unexpected reasons. Nevertheless, we have managed to make significant progress regarding the data mobilization for the initial partners and the identification and engagement of new partners, biodiversity data holding institutions and datasets.

After a deeper analysis of the partner institutions situation it was decided that no IPT was going to be installed in Angola during this BID project. The irregularity of electrical energy and internet services and the lack of experienced IT personnel in the partner institutions makes wiser the utilization of an existing IPT in this stage of Angola's first steps with GBIF publication. GBIF Portugal IPT was the choice due to the language similarity and experience in Angola. INBAC has already signed a Service Level Agreement (SLA) with GBIF Portugal to use their IPT infrastructure for data publication and IIA is on the final arrangements to sign the agreement as well. The National Natural History Museum of Luanda (MNHN) has both a MoU with the project and a SLA with GBIF Portugal pending to be signed on the Ministry of Culture office and therefore we expect to have them onboard soon. The Service Level Agreement was a requirement by GBIF Portugal and was elaborated from scratch as there was no precedent for this situation. The document will be translated to English and made available as a template to GBIF for future utilization.

Regarding the data publication, INBAC will start publishing in November 2017 after the training course that is scheduled for their staff on the third week of November. A first dataset of Birds of Quiçama National Park is being prepared for training and publication purposes. Afterwards, several checklists will be prepared to be published by the Institution.

IIA Insect and Herbarium Collections are being digitized by the IIA Staff and 3 Students of the campus sharing university UJES. Progress has been made and we can count on more than 15.000 specimens digitized at the moment. From the entomological collection there is a dataset ready to be published for Odonata order (about 1000 records) and other orders such as Hymenoptera (close to 6000 records) and Lepidoptera (about 14000 records) are in



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progress of finishing the digitalization, correct or identify species when possible and being georeferenced. At the same time, the Herbarium collection continues being digitized by two employees of IIA and two students. About 10000 records have been already been digitized and are pending the quality control process and the georeferentiation. A training course to georreference scientific collections is planned for mid December 2017 at IIA in order to address this need. Several specialists in the different taxonomic areas of the IIA collections are being contacted in order to collaborate in the identification of the unidentified specimens and the digitization. Some odonata, and coleoptera specialists will be visiting the collections in December to assess their potential future collaboration.

The National Workshop will be scheduled as soon as the main partners make their first steps with GBIF publication so they can actively participate and share their experiences.

6. Beneficiaries/affiliated entities and other cooperation

6.1. Relationship with project partners

Please describe the relationship between your project coordinating team/institution and your project partners, and with any other organisations involved in implementing your BID project.

With IIA the relationship is moving forward as originally planned. The IIA direction was changed in December 2016 and therefore our main point of contact, who supported and accompanied the project since the beginning was gone. We had to start from scratch with the new direction but despite the delayed caused the project is on the right path. Regarding the IPT SLA signature, the new direction has not yet signed (since January 2017 that is ready to be signed) but significant steps have been made towards this goal. We hope it get signed soon so data can start being published.

With INBAC, the relationship remains as originally planned as well, but also the direction of the institution was changed in October 2017. We have meetings scheduled with the new direction for the end of November 2017 to move brief them about the project and we expect that the partnership will remain safe and moving forward.

We stablished new relationships with the National Natural History Museum and despite slow is moving forward. We are waiting for them to sign the MoU and SLA for the IPT utilization.

6.2. Links to other projects and actions

We have been working directly with the Portuguese GBIF Node regarding the utilization of their IPT by the Angolan Partners. For that purpose, the Portuguese node required the signature of a Service Level Agreement (SLA). Unfortunately, there was no precedent of utilization of this kind of agreements and a new one was drafted from scratch. The document is in Portuguese and it will be standardized and translated to English to serve as a template for future partnerships among the GBIF participants.

The Southern African Institute for Aquatic Biodiversity (SAIAB) was approached during a workshop that one of our collaborators attended and they kindly offered assistance in whatever necessary regarding data publication through GBIF as well as the utilization of their IPT. Due to language similarities between Portugal and Angola, we decided that GBIF Angola would be a better option for our partners to liaise with at this stage.

A SANBI (Southern Africa National Biodiversity Institute) is about to publish the 4th series of their journal SURICATA, titled "Manual of Afrotropical Diptera". Ashley H. Kirk-Spriggs, one of the main authors, contacted the project asking about potential collections hosting Diptera specimens in Angola and he will mention the GBIF-BID project in the manual. In 2017, IIA received a visit from both the Portuguese and Angolan Ministry of Agriculture as well as the Director of the Agronomic and Veterinary Research National Institute of Portugal. They had the chance to visit the Insect and Herbarium collections and the work in progress and they were briefed about the GBIF-BID project. A EU funding and GBIF/BID logo were exposed during the visit and briefing at the collections hall.
