Vehicle thefts in India

more than doubled last year.

In September 2022, we launched the first edition of Theft & City where we sat down & analyzed data at ACKO to discover the most theft prone cities and areas in India during for 2022. We found out, for example, that white cars were more susceptible to theft than other colours.

This year, we've doubled down on our data to deliver more insights on vehicle thefts, which have only increased drastically as thieves get more tech savvy and notorious. We've dug deep to understand the reasons behind vehicle thefts, as well as the vehicles that are most likely to be stolen.

NO CITY SAFE FOR VEHICLES: NEW DELHI NEW TINUES CONTINUES CONTINUE



New Delhi continues to be the reigning city for vehicle thefts, with 80% of car thefts in India happening in New Delhi.



However, it's overall share of vehicle thefts in comparison to other cities in India has come down from 56% to 37%.

- Chennai on the other hand, has seen a sharp spike, with vehicle thefts doubling from 5% in 2022 to 10.5% in 2023.
- Bengaluru comes a close third at 10.2%, a marginal increase from 9% in 2022.
- The **safest cities for vehicles** continue to be **Kolkata, Hyderabad and Mumbai**, registering the lowest number of thefts.






The capital continues to be the hub for vehicle theft in India, with 105 cases of vehicle theft reported every single day in 2023. To put that into perspective - a vehicle is stolen every 14 minutes in the capital.

DID YOU KNOW?

In 2023, the Delhi Police received 7,328 calls reporting violent disputes over parking on neighbourhood roads? Official data shared by the police shows that this number is more than the cumulative number of such calls received in the 2021 and 2022. This is a serious problem, symptomatic of a city that has maximum number of registered vehicles but very few organised parking spaces.

Our Data has revealed the most frequently stolen cars to be as follows:



The cars with the highest demand

(and consequently, longer delivery timelines) continue to be favourite among thieves, with a strong preference for Maruti Suzuki, followed by Hyundai.

These cars are always visible on roads, which, interestingly enough make it easier to blend in while stealing the vehicle and escaping!



BIKE ME AWAY:

BIKES ARE STOLEN 9.25X MORE THAN CARS

India's top selling motorbike, the Hero Splendor continues to be the top stolen bike in the country. The Honda Activa comes next, followed by the Honda Dio and the Hero Passion. The Royal Enfield Classic 350 also makes a repeat appearance in 2023 as a favourite among thieves.

According to data provided by the Gurugram police, Hero Splendor, Splendor plus, Hero CD deluxe and Hero HF deluxe constitute over

60%

of the total two-wheelers stolen in Gurugram. And our data makes it clear that the nation mirrors the same trend.



thefts on Hero branded bikes, according to the police, can be attributed to the higher resale value of these motorcycles in comparison to other bikes in the same segment. The lucrative market for Hero bikes' spare parts are a major draw for vehicle thieves, who're constantly looking to cash in!






The most number of vehicle thefts during 2023 took place on Tuesdays, closely followed by Sundays and Thursdays. What was interesting to note was the equal distribution of thefts across all seven days of the week. You may be working hard - but thieves are working harder.

DON'T PANIC!

HERE'S A GUIDE ON WHAT TO DO WHEN YOUR VEHICLE GOES MISSING.

Step 1:

If your car or two-wheeler has been stolen, immediately inform the police and your insurance company.



Along with the F.I.R, submit a copy of your vehicle documents such as registration certificate, your driving license, etc. to your insurer. You might also have to submit the original vehicle keys.



Step 3:

The police will issue a non-traceable certificate if they fail to trace your vehicle within a reasonable time frame.



Your insurance company will then settle your claim as per the terms and conditions of your insurance policy. Phew!

THESE DAYS: VESTING TECH

AS CARS GET MORE HIGH-TECH, SO DO THIEVES.



New-age cars also have advanced safety features such as **keyless entry** which operates on barcodes that are embedded on windshields. Thieves are now scanning these barcodes & sending them offshore to unlock these cars, change the codes and even grant remote access!

The Delhi Police recently caught a sophisticated vehicle selling scam where a group of fraudsters would pretend to buy a car listed on a second-hand site, pay a token deposit to obtain vehicle details like chassis number etc. and then use these details to sell stolen cars of the same make and model in a different state!

Vehicle thief gangs constantly do "recces" in public places where vehicles are parked without any security to make notes for future theft. If you want to keep your vehicle safe, make sure it's parked under surveillance or inside your compound at all times!

We created this report to shed light on some of the most common reasons for theft and to help vehicle owners in India be more vigilant.
