EFC Executive Leadership Programme (ELP)

in collaboration with Harvard Business School Executive Education

What is it?

The newly launched EFC Executive Leadership Programme (ELP), in collaboration with Harvard Business School Executive Education, offers elite leadership development tailored for top professionals in the football industry. Combining Harvard Business School's (HBS) renowned educational approach with a customised curriculum, the programme addresses the specific challenges faced by football leaders and incorporates insights from the broader sports and entertainment sectors. Participants will engage with HBS case studies, gaining practical strategies and real-world perspectives

essential for excelling in top leadership roles within football.

What are the benefits?

- Programme Wrap-Up: Conclude with a high-impact two-day, inperson leadership development session in Europe, delivered by Professor Anita Elberse, offering hands-on learning and real-world application.

The EFC CMP is designed for those seeking

a deeper understanding of professional football club management. The programme emphasises strategic development and management, with a focus on current and future industry trends. Taught by a diverse group of academics, industry experts, and thought leaders, the curriculum reflects the latest in football, equipping participants to navigate market shifts, capitalise on opportunities and drive success at their clubs.

What are the benefits?

- Online Sessions: Complementary sessions that top up on key areas of knowledge, featuring insights from distinguished speakers.
- 12-Month Mentoring Programme: Personalised guidance from a former or current football club executive, providing insights into their role and network.

The EFC CTMP is designed for driven, passionate young professionals within clubs who seek an opportunity to advance their careers. Participants will come from various specialisations and areas of club football, looking to gain a broader understanding of what it takes to run a successful club.

EFC Women on Board Programme (WOBP)

What is it?

The EFC Women on Board Programme (WOBP) is an educational initiative designed for women in senior-level football roles who aspire to advance into more senior decision-making positions, such as board roles within their clubs or influential bodies in football. Addressing the significant gender gap in football administration and executive roles, where women currently represent only 18% of C-level executives, the EFC WOBP provides tailored tools, strategies,

skills and a supportive community to empower women to step into higher decision-making roles. Developed in coordination with the EFC Sustainability team and aligned with EFC's broader governance reforms – which aim to increase female representation on its Board to at least 25% by 2027 and 35% by 2030 – this programme is a key part of EFC's commitment to driving diversity and inclusion in football's decision-making landscape.



What are the benefits?

Participating in the EFC WOBP offers several key benefits:

- Leadership Preparation: Gain the skills and competencies needed to navigate the football landscape, identify opportunities and take on higher decision-making roles.

What is it?

The Sporting Director Programme (SDP) is a key initiative designed to enhance the capabilities of Sporting Directors at EFC Member Clubs. Recognising the growing importance and influence of this role, the programme is tailored to address its complex demands and equip participants with the up-to-date knowledge, skills and tools necessary to excel in a dynamic and evolving industry.

What are the benefits?

The Sustainability in Football Compact Course (SFC) gives clubs and football organisations the tools to act on one of the game's biggest challenges: building a sustainable future. Developed with UEFA and SDA Bocconi, this four-day programme in Milan equips professionals to make sustainability a central part of football.

What the Course Offers

Across four immersive days, participants take part in expert-led workshops on the issues that matter most: cutting environmental impact; strengthening communities and shaping football's approach to sustainability. Every participant leaves with a tailored action plan, ready to deliver practical results for their club, league or association.

Who Should Join the Sustainability in Football Compact Course?

The SFC is designed for sustainability managers in clubs and national associations. It also welcomes professionals from leagues, confederations and other football bodies who want to lead meaningful change in their organisations and across the game.
