As we move into the final stage of our three-phase program, we are particularly proud of our achievement of gender parity and significant representation from traditionally underrepresented founder groups. This accomplishment underscores our unwavering commitment to equity, diversity, and inclusion (EDI), as we strive to create a more inclusive environment at the Accelerator Centre.

We continue to work to support local entrepreneurs while keeping our eyes on the global stage. Through our international market access programs, continued involvement in the SUV program, and collaborations with hubs from around the world, we continue to strive towards bringing the best of Waterloo to the world and the best of world to Waterloo.

#### Waterloo Region Above All

Our thriving community is a pillar of innovation and inclusivity. We offer in-person and virtual platforms that enable programs, events, funding opportunities, and access to partners, so founders are never going it alone.

This year, we've made great progress on our community roadmap including:

#### Win 1

Onboarding 60 new startups into our AC:Incubate Program, each being supported with up to 5 hours of 1:1 mentorship and our globally recognized milestone-based curriculum.

#### Win 2

Continuing to upgrade our coworking facilities to make them more flexible, accessible, and attractive to founders and the larger community. This year 28 community organizations leveraged to AC space to host over 870 hours off meetings and community events.

#### Win 3

Launching two new signature events, She Talks Tech and Innovate and Caffinate (formerly known as Build and Break-Fast), to bring the local community together and provide founders with opportunities to network, connect, and learn from each other.

### We committed ourselves to achieve goals that propel the organization towards our ambitious Vision 2025:

- ✓ Fully digitize the virtual AC programming experience, allowing entrepreneurs to work on their companies when and how it works best for them
- ✓ Open our virtual programming to startups across Canada and provide additional support to startups growing and scaling outside of Ontario; increasing our impact nationally
- ✓ Launch a co-working model that allows community members not participating in programming to access and benefit from the AC facilities and entrepreneurial community

- ✓ Launch an alumni program to better support and engage our community of Canada's top startup success stories
- Run community-based hackathons and sprints to support the generation of new ideas from industry and academia

### Aerospace Accelerator Program

Home to one of the top 20 busiest airports in Canada, the Region of Waterloo International Airport, Waterloo Region is an emerging hub for aerospace and aviation innovation.

Together, with the Region of Waterloo and NAVBLUE, we created a new home at the AC for aerospace entrepreneurs to test, grow, and scale their startups through a proven accelerator program model.

We've selected 10 startups to participate in 9 months of high-intensity programming. While in the program, they will have the opportunity to:

- Test out tech at the Region of Waterloo International Airport
- Access NAVBLUE's global network of industry experts and customers
- Leverage up to \$500,000 of in-kind perks and discounts from partners like AWS, Google for Startups, HubSpot, etc.
- Collaborate for global impact through an exclusive demo day with an international network of investors, airport operators, and corporate partners
- Elevate ideas with expert guidance through one-toone mentorship from industry experts and leaders
- Access award-winning education curriculum and investor network

### **Studio** Innovation Showcase

### AC:Studio

In early 2022, we had the vision for a new, regional-first program focused on identifying, curating, and rapidly validating high potential ideas and dramatically reducing the time it takes founders to go from idea to scale. In June, with \$10 million in funding support from the Government of Canada, through the Federal Economic Development Agency for Southern Ontario (FedDev Ontario), we launched our newest venture creation program, AC:Studio. The unique program combines the best of the AC's flagship program, AC:Incubate, with the globally successful venture studio model to create something special.

The AC:Studio program was designed to support high-potential startup founders, whether they have an existing business idea or they are looking for their next startup adventure. This hybrid accelerator/venture studio program combines the best of our award-winning AC:Incubate program with a venture studio model that funds high-impact startups, matches great ideas with talented founders, and delivers:



Up to \$100,000 in seed funding grants for startups and small business



One-to-one mentorship with our team of in-house and specialist mentors



Sales training from pros like Uvaro to build a team that delivers



Tactical support in product development, marketing, UI, and UX from industry experts and freelancers through partnerships with experienced startup builders at SnapPea and Conestoga College's Gig Lab



In-kind hours with industry experts

Access to market research, investment intelligence, and lead-generation reports



To date, the program has made a significant impact, creating more than **700 new jobs** for Southern Ontario. Collectively, the companies have also raised **\$40M in additional investment** and generated **\$21M in combined revenue.** 

In 2023, we executed on Phase 2 of the program, working with 50 incredible founders and narrowed the field to the top 25 companies. These companies represent the best-of-the-best southern Ontario has to offer for early-stage entrepreneurs.



"Our vision for AC:Studio was to create a regional-first program that could swiftly transform high-potential ideas into scale-ready companies. With the support from FedDev Ontario, we've built a unique venture creation program that has already seen remarkable success. As we enter Phase 3, we are excited to collaborate with these dynamic startups, driving rapid scalability and significant local economic impact. The initial outcomes and enthusiastic response from founders affirm the power of our model, and we are eager to continue this journey."

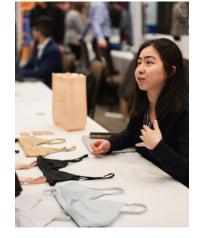

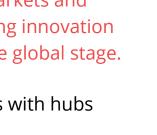

# **EDI** Action Plan



### Equity Diversity and Inclusion Action Plan

It is well known that diversity drives innovation and diverse teams perform better.

However, from the lack of funding for women-led startups to the underrepresentation of founders from racialized and marginalized backgrounds, the innovation ecosystem has room to improve on creating inclusive opportunities that make entrepreneurship accessible to everyone. We believe that inclusive communities like the AC foster the entrepreneurial drive that propels the innovation economy and we're committed to being a local and national leader for EDI in the innovation ecosystem by ensuring our programs, services, and community are welcoming to entrepreneurs from all backgrounds.

Through the 50 – 30 Challenge, we committed to working towards achieving two aspirational goals over time:

- Gender parity (50%) on our Board, senior management, and mentor teams and;
- Significant representation (30%) on our Board, senior management, and mentor teams of other diverse groups including racialized persons, people living with disabilities (including invisible and episodic disabilities), and members of the LGBTQ2 community.

To turn our commitment into action, we launched our 2-Year EDI Action Plan, our roadmap to making the AC the most inclusive innovation hub in the world and committed to sharing our progress.

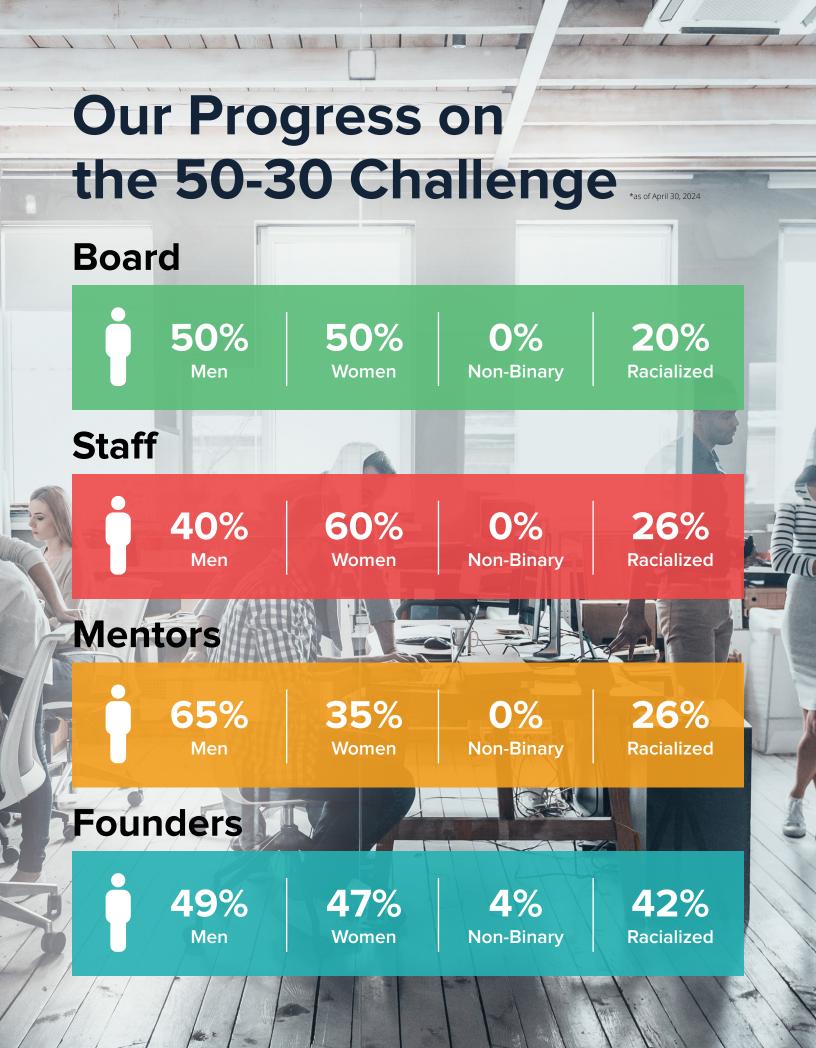
