Ambient Lighting

Use evenly-spaced downlights & recessed lights to help create the perfect ambient light. Recessed lighting or downlights shouldn't be the only light source in a bathroom, because your face will be filled with shadows.

Task Lighting

Detailed tasks like makeup application, shaving, or skincare need a lot of light. That's why task lighting in a bathroom is often vanity lights above or on either side of a mirror.

Accent Lighting

Accent lighting is light directed toward a particular area of focus. It can draw attention to an area while also creating a mood.

Light Layers *Illuminated*

The purpose of your space can help determine which lights are right. Thinking through how you want your bathroom to be used is key to finding the right layers of light.

All bathrooms will need vanity lighting of some sort. The other lights you choose depend a little bit on your preference and a little bit on your space. If you have the space next to your mirror, sconces are a beautiful way to add bright, grooming light. If you're limited in your wall space, a vanity bar above the mirror provides a focused glow. Lighted mirrors are a great addition as well, providing you both reflection and illumination.

Wall sconces or a vanity light are the bathroom's shining star

Wall Sconces

Sconces are the preferred method for bathroom lighting when used for personal grooming. When combined with a vanity light positioned in line with the sink drain, light is delivered to the face from three directions, eliminating shadows and letting your face shine.

Vanity Lights

Determining the size and light count of vanity lights starts with the mirror. The light should measure at least 3/4 the width of the mirror and not exceed the length of the mirror.

Linear Bath Bars

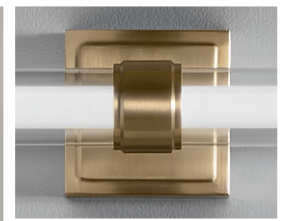
Brighten up with a linear bar fixture for even illumination that is good for wide mirrors and reflective surfaces.

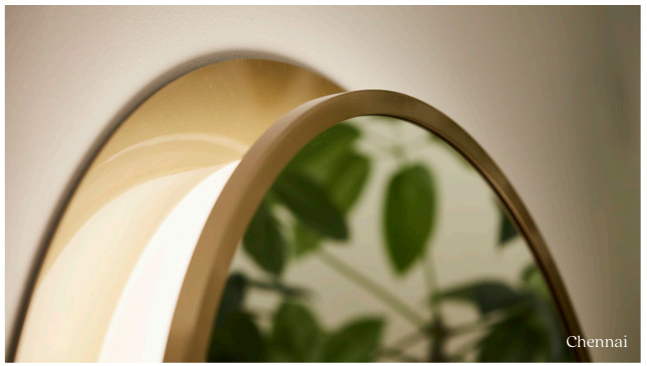

LED Mirrors

A mirror is a reflection of your style, both figuratively and literally. It shines back to you all that you love about your bath space. LED mirrors take it a step further with the added benefit of illuminating what they are reflecting. Some even offer dimming capabilities so you can get just the right amount of light.

Find Your Perfect Temperature

Color temperature is the visual appearance of the color of light, often labeled cool or warm. Selecting the right color temperature will help you set the right tone for your space.



CCT Selectable

5 CCT selectable technology allows you to switch between five hues of white light during installation. It's important to think about matching the color sources for all of the lights in your space. Think about how all the lights in your bath space shine together.



2700K | Warm White
The warm tones of this temperature give off a subtle glow of light. This is best for low-light areas where ambient illumination is welcomed.



3000K | Warm/Soft White
3000 Kelvin produces the warm and inviting color of incandescent lighting. Choose this temperature if the environment includes brown woods or warm colors like red, gold or orange.



3500K | Cool White
3500 Kelvin is a cool and vibrant color and closest to morning light. Choose this temperature for environments utilizing lots of cool colors like blue, green, or white.



4000K | Pure White
4000 Kelvin is a cool tone. It is considered a bright, clear light.



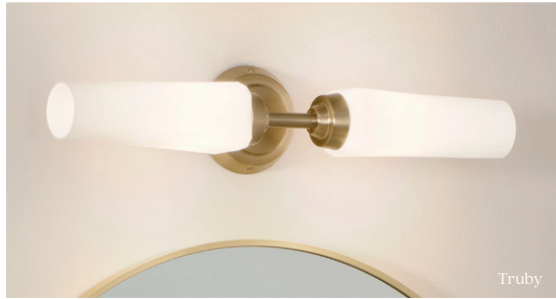
5000K | Daylight
5000 Kelvin is considered sunlight at high noon. It has an invigorating cool white or bluish appearance.



Integrated LED

These are fixtures that combine the light source and housing into a single, shining unit. Eliminating the need for a separate bulb and using LED light technology, they consume less energy, last longer and result in lower utility costs than standard bulbs.

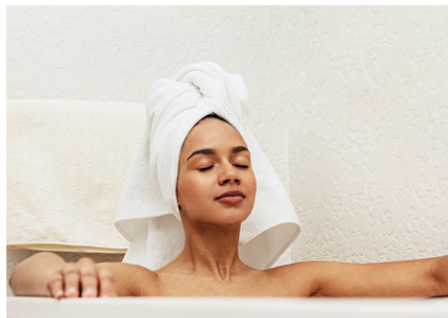

- If there are any accessibility needs that need to be taken into consideration

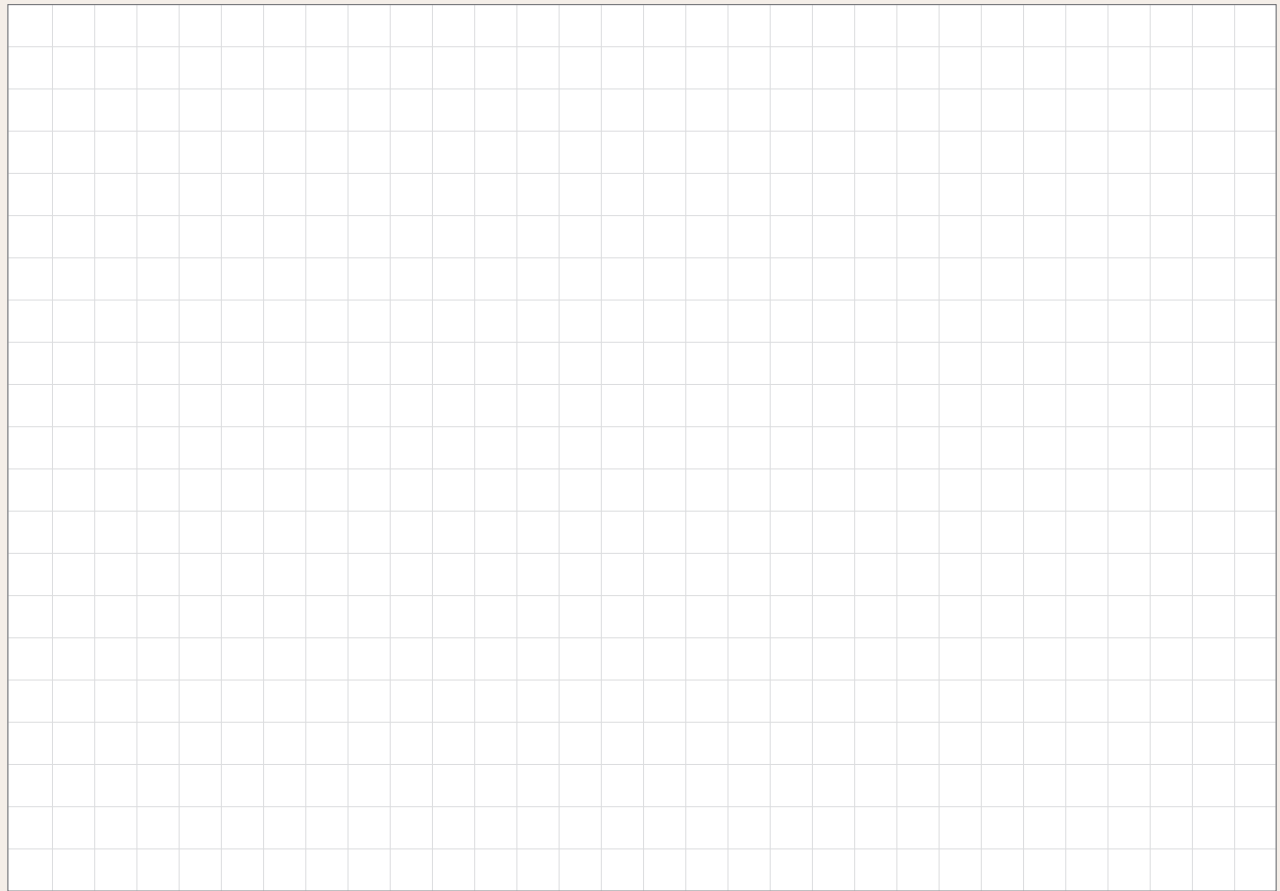
