Stand-Up Paddle Boarding in the Midnight Sun


Open tour | 3-4 hours | ISK 79900 per person (min 2 people)

Private tour | 3-4 hours | ISK 249900 (1-6 people)

Glide through shimmering waters on a paddle board as you explore Iceland's natural treasures under the euphoric radiance of the Midnight Sun. The precise location of our journey will be determined by the weather, the water conditions, and your own particular desires. While paddle boarding is an easy, beginner-friendly activity, we set the tempo of each tour according to your preferred level of comfort and cardio workout. Whether you seek a relaxing excursion or a challenging expedition, Paddle Boarding In The Midnight Sun is calibrated for individuals and small private groups who wish to experience an amazing night that will bring forth a lifetime of memories.

Snorkeling in Kleifarvatn / Geothermal Snorkeling Tour

Open tour | 4 hours | ISK 15990 per person without pick-up
Private tour | 5-6 hours | ISK 200000 (1-6 guests) with pick-up

Snorkel in a caldera among the newly discovered subaquatic hot springs at Kleifarvatn lake. With bubbles rising all around you, the sensation has been described as snorkelling in a glass of champagne. The tour starts with an 800 meter walk to the lakeshore where you put on your dry suit, followed by a 50 meter swim across the caldera to the lake's geothermal area—an extraordinary location teeming with mineral deposits and hot springs.



Sea Kayaking

2 hours | ISK 12000 per person without pick-up
Additional ISK 10000 for transfer (up to 5 people)

A two-hour sea adventure that takes you to the shores of Vatnsleysuströnd—a 15 km beach on the north coast of the Reykjanes Peninsula. Experience the area's spellbinding lava fields and idyllic farms from the unique perspective of the ocean as frozen-in-time magma formations reveal themselves in the tide.

Midnight ATV

1.5 – 2 hours | ISK 24900 | per person for 2 people on a bike

1.5 – 2 hours | ISK 31900 | per person for single bike

Tour starts at 20:30

During the season of the Midnight Sun, the fleeting boundary between sunset and sunrise becomes a magical moment where the sun dips below the horizon for only a few surreal minutes. The Midnight ATV tour takes you to the peak of Mt. Hagafell to bear witness to this unforgettable solar display. On the journey to the mountain, you will traverse a landscape of historic lava fields, abandoned shipwrecks, and the ruins of ancient settlements.
