For the first time, experienced riders from around the world are invited to take part in the Wagora MTB Ride. This exclusive event is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to ride for a cause through the iconic Serengeti, while supporting conservation efforts for the Grumeti Fund's anti-poaching scouts who protect this ecosystem's precious wildlife.

The name of the ride pays tribute to Kitaboka Wagora, an anti-poaching scout who was tragically shot and killed by a poacher while on patrol in 2008. His memory continues to inspire others to follow a path of bravery, courage and the commitment to protect and conserve Africa's wild places for future generations.

This three-day event traverses approximately 150 kilometres in the Grumeti Reserve along the western corridor of the Serengeti National Park. Breathtaking views and enthralling animal sightings are part of the journey in this landscape that is home to The Great Migration.

Participants will stay at Singita Explore in contemporary utilitarian tents designed for riders seeking an unfiltered African adventure. On completion of the day's trail - various activities are on offer including game drives and the chance to learn more about the exceptional work done by the rangers on the ground.

A collaboration between the Grumeti Fund and Singita, the aim of the Wagora MTB Ride is to raise funds and support Grumeti Fund's anti-poaching teams.



Mountain bike enthusiasts from around the world will come together in the Serengeti to ride in solidarity and support of the anti-poaching scouts who fearlessly protect wildlife in this land of The Great Migration.

Singita Explore

After a long and rewarding day, participants will return to the luxury and comfort of this stylish tented camp that embraces the true essence of a modern safari. It's pared down luxury at its best. Two Singita Explore camps - each with 6 x 1 bedroom safari tents (12 tents total) - echoing the textures & tones of the natural surrounds. It's all about getting back to basics, sharing stories around the fire and listening to the wild and restless world of the Serengeti as night descends.
