STAGE ONE

MAY - JULY

Complete the application form which is designed to determine whether this is the right time for you to become an Acumen Fellow.



STAGE TWO

AUGUST

We dig deeper into the work you do. This stage requires 2 video submissions and answers to short essay questions.



STAGE THREE

NOVEMBER

A Selection Conference for the finalists. Finalists are assessed through elevator pitches, group activities, and a panel interview.



DECEMBER

Selected Fellows will be sent Offer Letters WHAT ADVICE WOULD YOU GIVE BEFORE I APPLY?

BE PERSONAL

Your application is our first glimpse into who you are and the experiences that have made you the person you are today. Be
