





We take members on a journey informed by evidence and expertise to become more informed and strategic philanthropists.






Why effectiveness matters

Evidence shows that some charities have tens and even hundreds of times more positive impact than others for the same amount of funding. This means that choosing a highly effective charity is equivalent to multiplying the amount donated to a less effective charity.

This is why we focus on identifying some of the very best funding opportunities for our members worldwide. Our Research team conducts rigorous analysis to find outstandingly impactful giving opportunities across a range of cause areas — making it easier to give effectively as members feel confident that their donation is doing as much good as possible.




In 2020, our members committed more of their personal proceeds to charity than any previous year.

On average, members pledged 11.8% in 2020, adding \$1 billion in new pledges for a total of \$3.5 billion now committed to the world's most pressing problems. Five members even pledged 100% of their liquidity.

BUILDING THE EFFECTIVE GIVING MOVEMENT:

Equity for Impact

In December 2020, we launched Equity for Impact to make charitable giving the norm, not just among founders, but throughout the startup community. Equity for Impact inspires employees, alumni and investors of pre-exit companies to commit to give around major exit events, and supports them to do more good with every dollar pledged. Those who qualify for Founders Pledge membership by committing \$250k+ to charitable causes are invited to join our community.

Equity for Impact launched to support the Airbnb community in December 2020 ahead of Airbnb's IPO.

A global community

We're constantly inspired by our community of 1,583 members spanning 34 countries. In 2020, 212 new members joined our coalition of innovative, ambitious philanthropists who are working together to help solve the world's biggest problems.

Learning & discovering as a community

Once a member pledges, they become part of our vibrant community of startup founders, investors and leaders committed to social good. We connect our community to learn from one another and experts in social impact, and to identify opportunities to collaborate and accelerate impact together.

Ranging from intimate dinners at members' homes to large annual forums, our events provide opportunities to exchange ideas and learn about the latest evidence-led solutions to social problems from thought-leaders in the philanthropic field.

While events looked slightly different this year, 28 events were still hosted covering climate change, mental health in a time of crisis, COVID-19 in low- and middle-income countries, psychedelics and mental health, seed-stage grantmaking, and global health and development. Events this year included:

- A briefing with David Miliband of the International Rescue Committee
- Launch events for our new Climate and Global Health & Development Funds
- A community ski retreat, followed by a virtual reunion
- A virtual dinner on effective giving hosted in collaboration with EA Israel

Introducing: The Climate Cohort

In 2020, we launched the Climate Cohort, our first cause area-specific member cohort. Through the Cohort, we aim to mobilise and empower our members to take action on climate change, utilising the unique entrepreneurial drive, problem-solving mindset, and evidence-based approach of our community to tackle one of the greatest challenges of our time.

Members have used their learnings to support the very best funding opportunities in the climate space. One member initiated a match fund for our newly established Climate Fund, catalysing donations from our community and their broader networks, and helping the Fund achieve the following success:



The Hub: Coming together in a virtual world

To foster our global community beyond our events, we began rolling out an online community platform, The Hub, in 2020.

The Hub allows members to pose questions, share resources, explore broad topics, network, community-build, and arrange meetings directly, or with the support of the Founders Pledge team.





Advising

Informed by the latest charity research, we provide tailored giving advice to our members. Our advisors work with members to identify the best giving opportunities for them based on their values and interests. Together, we design an exciting, tailored giving portfolio.

In 2020, we revamped our Advisory service based on learnings and insights from previous years. We want to ensure each of our members has the confidence to make strategic donations now and in the future.

RESEARCH AREAS:

Benefitting current generations

There are known and promising solutions to many of the most pressing problems facing current generations, with even more being continuously developed and improved. Many of the most well-evidenced and effective solutions focus on health and poverty alleviation in low- and middle-income countries, which is why this has been our main focus so far.

Improving the lives of animals

At least 75 billion farmed land animals and more than a trillion fish are slaughtered for food each year. Most of these animals live in extremely poor conditions with high rates of disease, pain and immobility, yet farmed animals receive little philanthropic support. We believe improving their conditions is a highly effective way of doing good.

Benefitting future generations

The interests of future generations are important to many people, yet relatively little effort is spent protecting them. Technological progress has brought us great benefits, but also exposed us to emerging risks such as nuclear war and engineered pathogens. Mitigating these is a promising option for donors open to high-risk, high-return philanthropy.



Recent research

In 2020, our researchers recommended 19 new funding opportunities, published four new research reports, made three major updates to existing research, and continued to improve our data-driven methodology to identify great causes and charities.

Accelerating our members' impact on COVID-19

When a 'once-in-a-hundred-years' pandemic spread worldwide, we moved quickly to provide guidance to our members on high-impact ways to invest time and resources in the COVID response.

COVID-19 IMPACT & INNOVATION FUND:

Supported by Silicon Valley Bank, our researchers built upon our prior pandemic preparedness research, rapidly aggregated learnings from across the philanthropic sector to identify top funding recommendations, and curated a pooled COVID-19 fund to respond to the immediate crisis and prepare for the next pandemic. In total, our members directed \$4.6m through this fund or directly to charities responding to COVID-19 or focused on pandemic preparedness.

EDUCATION:

Our briefing events and recommended resources on COVID-19, including blogs and podcasts by Founders Pledge, introduced sources that conveyed the heart of the global issue.

Many of our members took action against COVID-19 through their own initiatives. We shared these projects with our community to raise awareness and boost support. Examples include:

- Kristen Ablamsky helped launch the Freelancers Relief Fund to support struggling freelance households
- Jess Mah led efforts to get PPE to US hospitals through the C19 Coalition
- James Monico co-founded Testing For All to make COVID testing accessible and affordable to UK workers
- Sam Barnett & Sebastien Blanc initiated the world's largest online art class to raise funds for COVID relief charities selected by the Founders Pledge Research team



Our Donor Advised Fund

A majority of members use our Donor Advised Fund (DAF). DAFs function like charitable bank accounts and enable donors to give to charity in a tax-efficient way, and to consider investing their charitable resources so that more is available to give in the future.

Our DAF is global first and giving to international or fledgling nonprofits is barrier free. We're unique in that we charge no administrative fees for up to \$5 million assets under management, and offer a competitive suite of investment options. Our aim is to ensure that as much money as possible goes directly to the charities our members choose to support, wherever they are.

95% of members with liquidity chose to fulfil their pledge using our DAF in 2020.

Our research, which is shared on our website and was featured on vox.com last year, informs the giving decisions of not only our members, but the public at large. As a result of our research, \$3.4m has been donated to charity by non-members.





Rita's story

In 2020, our members donated ~\$400k to Bandhan, a charity that supports and empowers women living in extreme poverty in India to build a sustainable source of income.

Rita is just one of the women Bandhan helped 'graduate' out of poverty in 2020. She lives in the village of Baburhat in West Bengal, India with her two young girls. But when her husband left her for another woman, they fell into poverty. Working as a maid, she was earning about \$16 each month, well below the threshold for extreme poverty and not enough to provide for herself, her daughters and her mother, who she also supports.

Today, as a result of working with Bandhan, Rita runs a successful door-to-door garment store and has full sustained employment for the first time in her life. She sells her garments across a number of local villages and is in a better financial position than ever before, meaning better education and healthcare for her daughters.

With the support of the Founders Pledge community, Bandhan supported 1,000 households like Rita's in 2020.

This is just one example of the tremendous impact of our high-impact charity recommendations.





Launching our funds

In 2020, we made giving even easier through the launch of three themed funds.

In addition to our COVID-19 Response Fund, we launched a Climate Fund and Global Health & Development Fund. Through these Funds, our members can boost their impact by pooling their resources. Fund contributions are granted to high-impact charities by our expert fund managers.






Our funding

2020 OPERATIONS INCOME BY SOURCE:






2020 Expenses


